Tornadoes – AL and GA



<u>Current Situation</u>: Multiple tornadoes touched down in Lee County, AL and western GA. Local fire, police and EMAs are still assessing impacts. Currently there are no active tornado watches or warnings for the area.

- Shelters: (ARC Midnight shelter count as of 5:57 a.m. EDT)
 - o AL: 2 open w/ 4 occupants
 - o GA: 1 open w/ 15 occupants

 - o AL: 23 confirmed fatalities
 - o GA: No reported fatalities
 - o 40-90 injuries reported across AL, GA and FL


- Power Outages minimal (EAGLE-I as of 7:30 a.m. EDT)*

- Local damage assessments scheduled to begin today





Severe Weather – Southeastern U.S.


















Precipitation Forecast




Significant River Flood Outlook





Winter Precipitation Outlook








Forecast Snowfall


Forecast Ice Accumulation


6 - 10 Day Temperature Probability




6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

U.S. Monthly Drought Outlook











