- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Medium (40%)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Central Pacific: No significant activity affecting U.S. interests
- Western Pacific: No significant activity affecting U.S. interests

Significant Weather:

- Moderate risk for severe thunderstorms (Monday) Texas and Oklahoma
- Severe thunderstorms possible Ohio Valley to Great Lakes and Mid-Atlantic
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Lower Mississippi Valley; Upper Mississippi Valley to Great Lakes

Space Activity: None




Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

Disturbance 1 (as of 1:00 a.m. EDT)

- Expected to form several hundred miles SW of Bermuda during the next couple of days
- Moving N or NE
- Could gradually develop into a tropical or subtropical cyclone through Tuesday; conditions are forecast to become unfavorable for further development by the middle of the week
- Does not pose a threat to U.S. or U.S. interests
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)









Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Disturbance 1 (as of 1:00 a.m. EDT)

- 200 miles SSW of the Mexico-Guatemala border
- Environmental conditions expected to be only marginally conducive for development during the next few days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)






Severe Weather Outlook









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Severe Weather Outlook – Monday









National Weather Forecast











Precipitation Forecast







6 - 10 Day Temperature Probability




6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability





- FCO is Benigno Bern Ruiz






