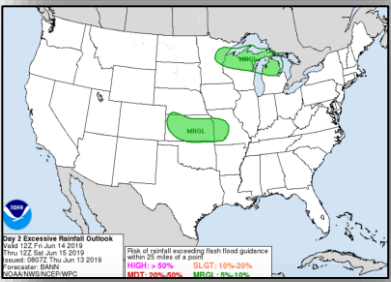
Precipitation Forecast



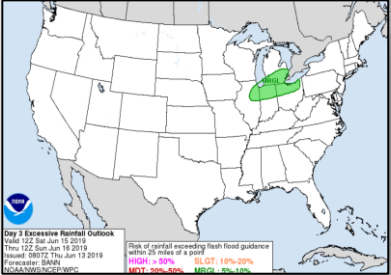

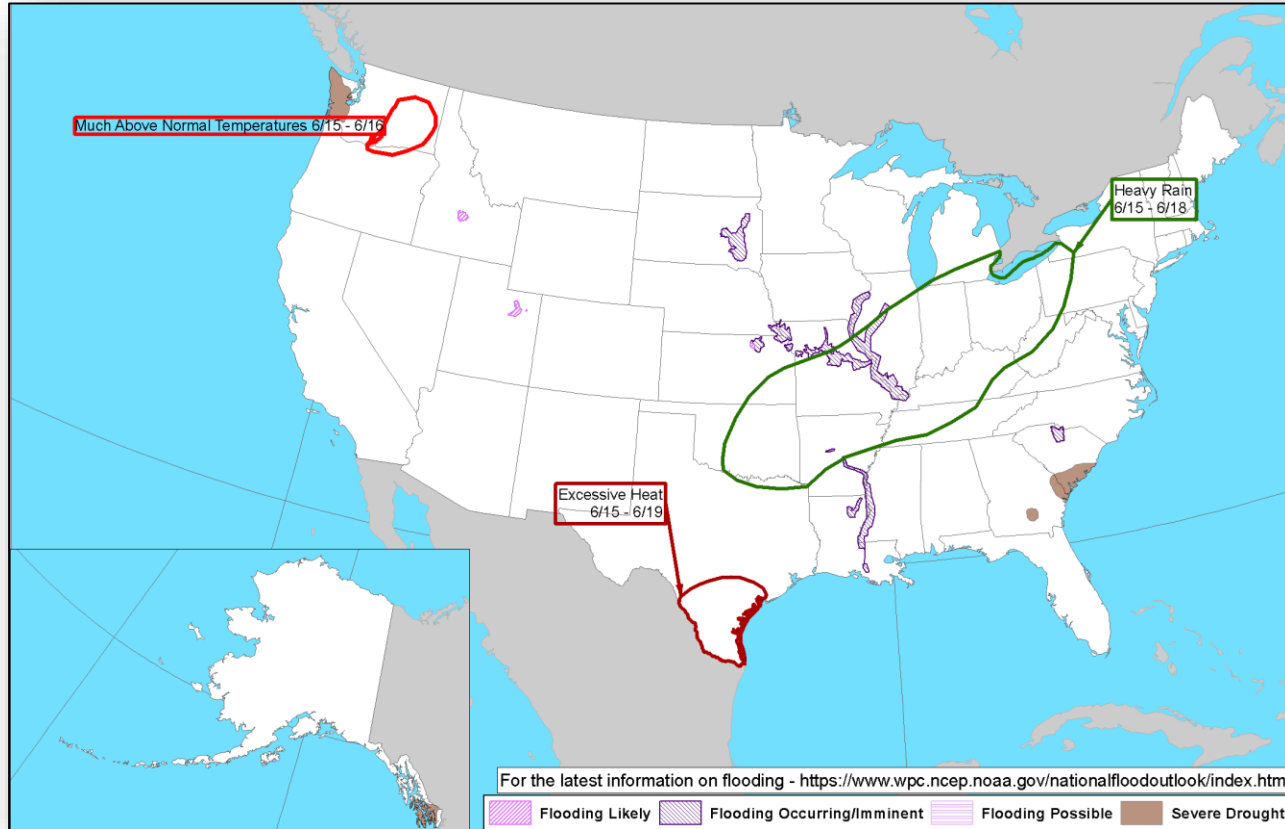
Severe Weather Outlook

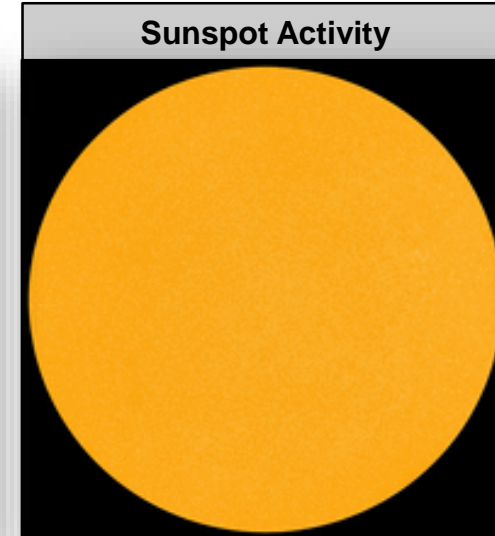
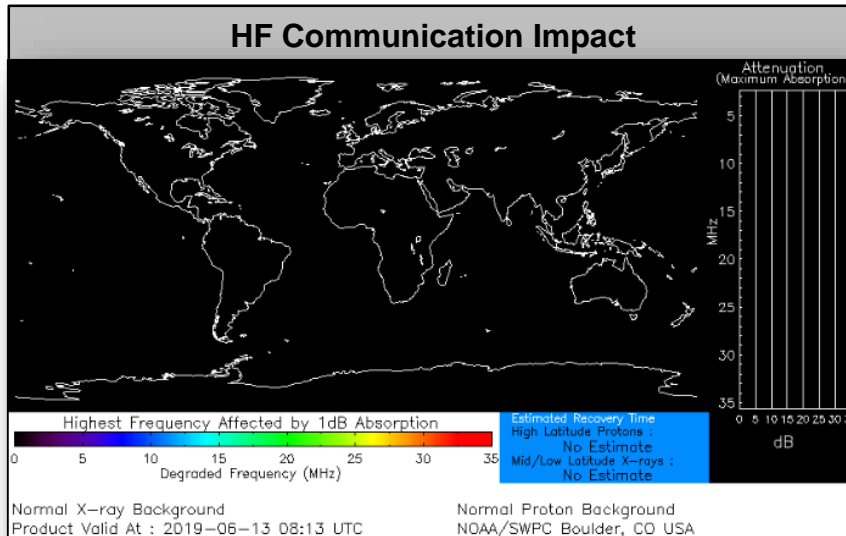

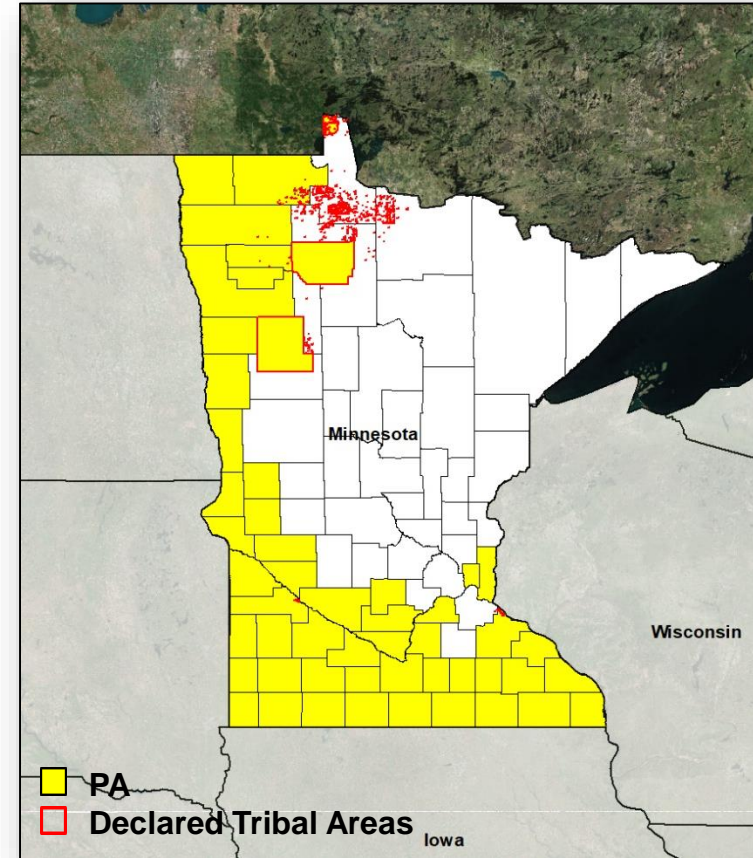

- FCO is Steven W. Johnson



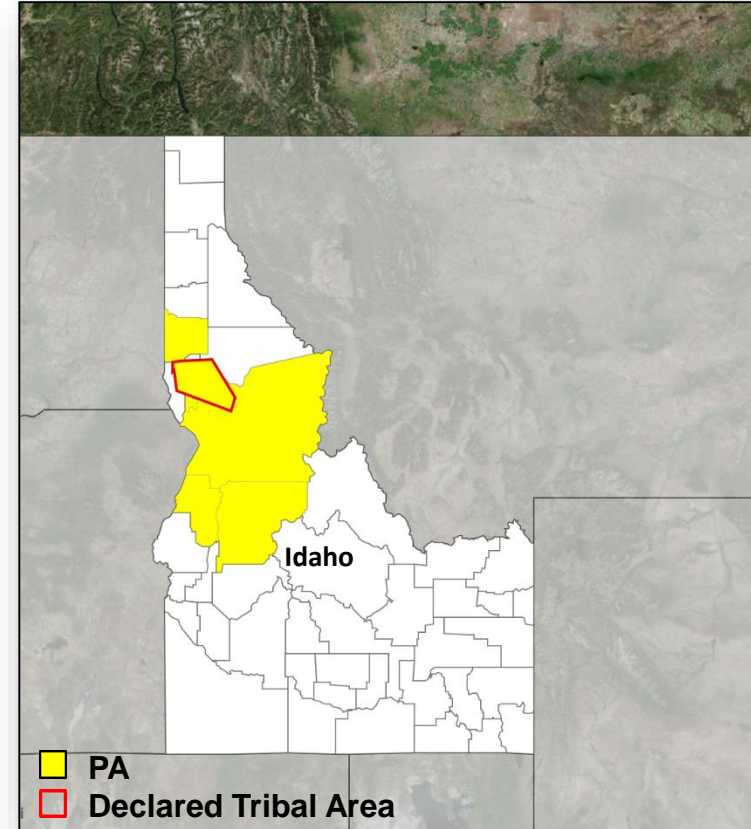

- FCO is Dolph A. Diemont



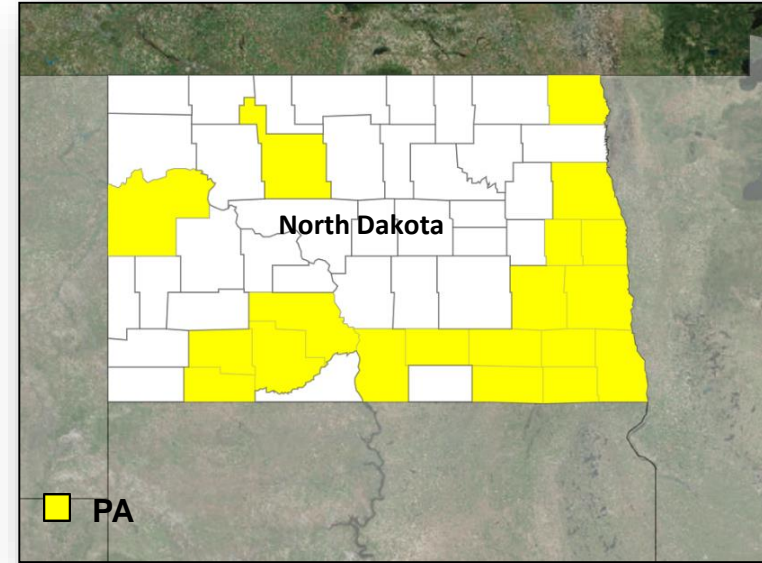
