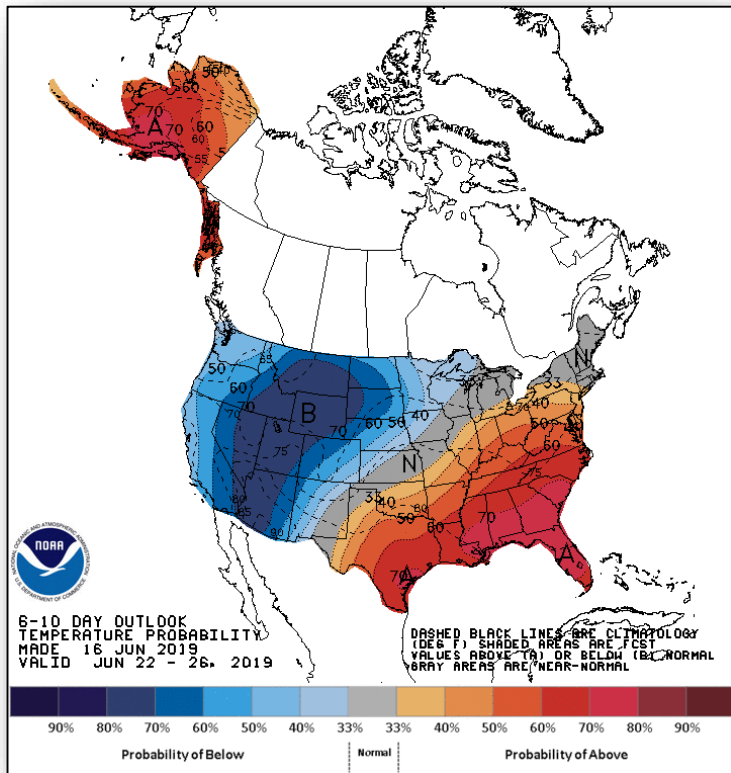

**6-10 Day Precipitation Probability**

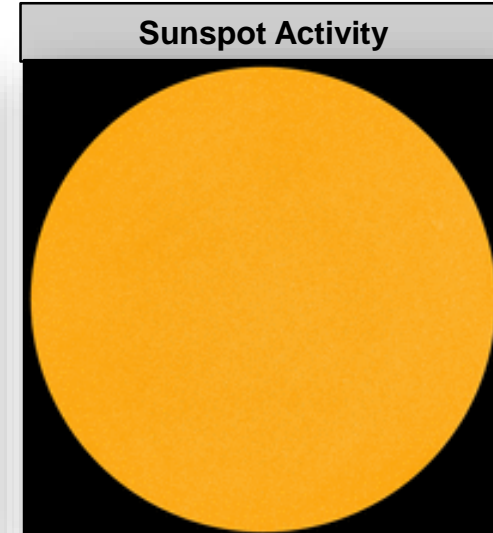
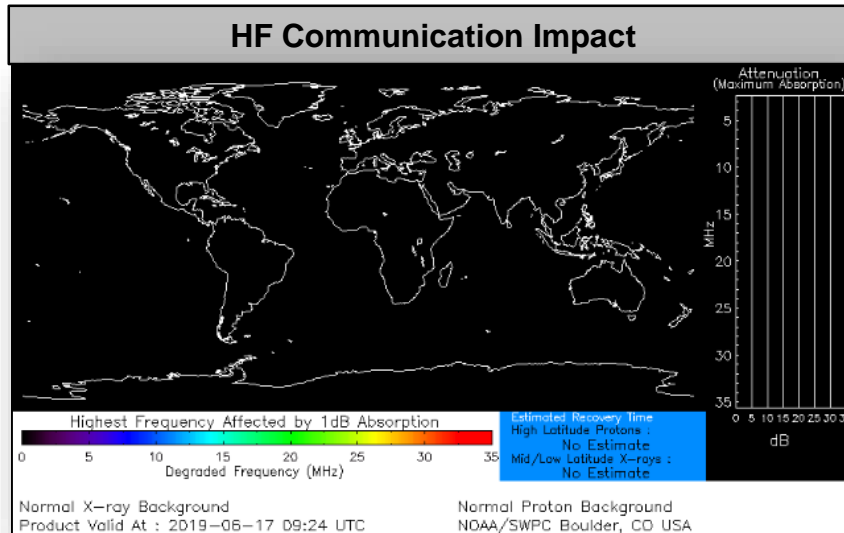

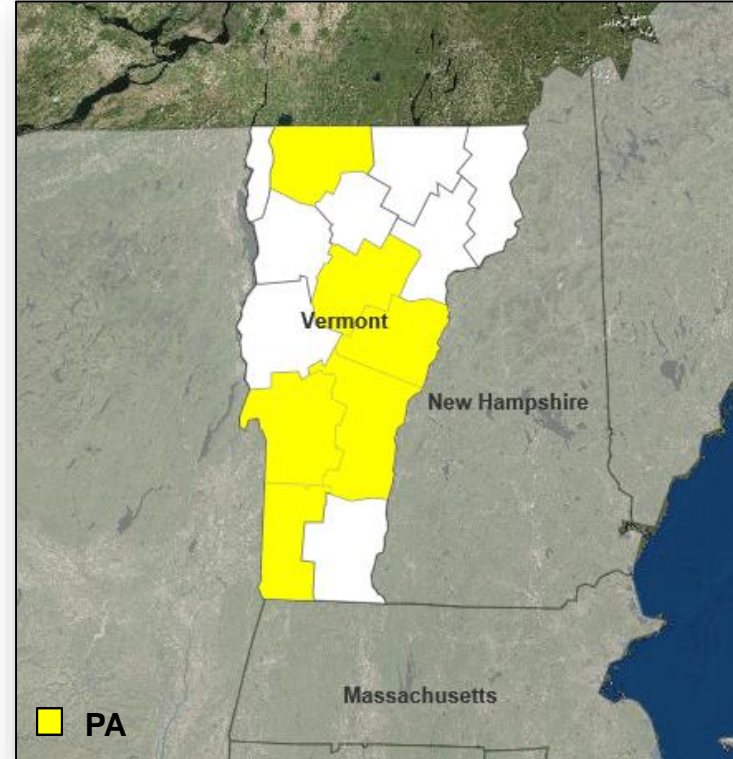
# Declaration Approved

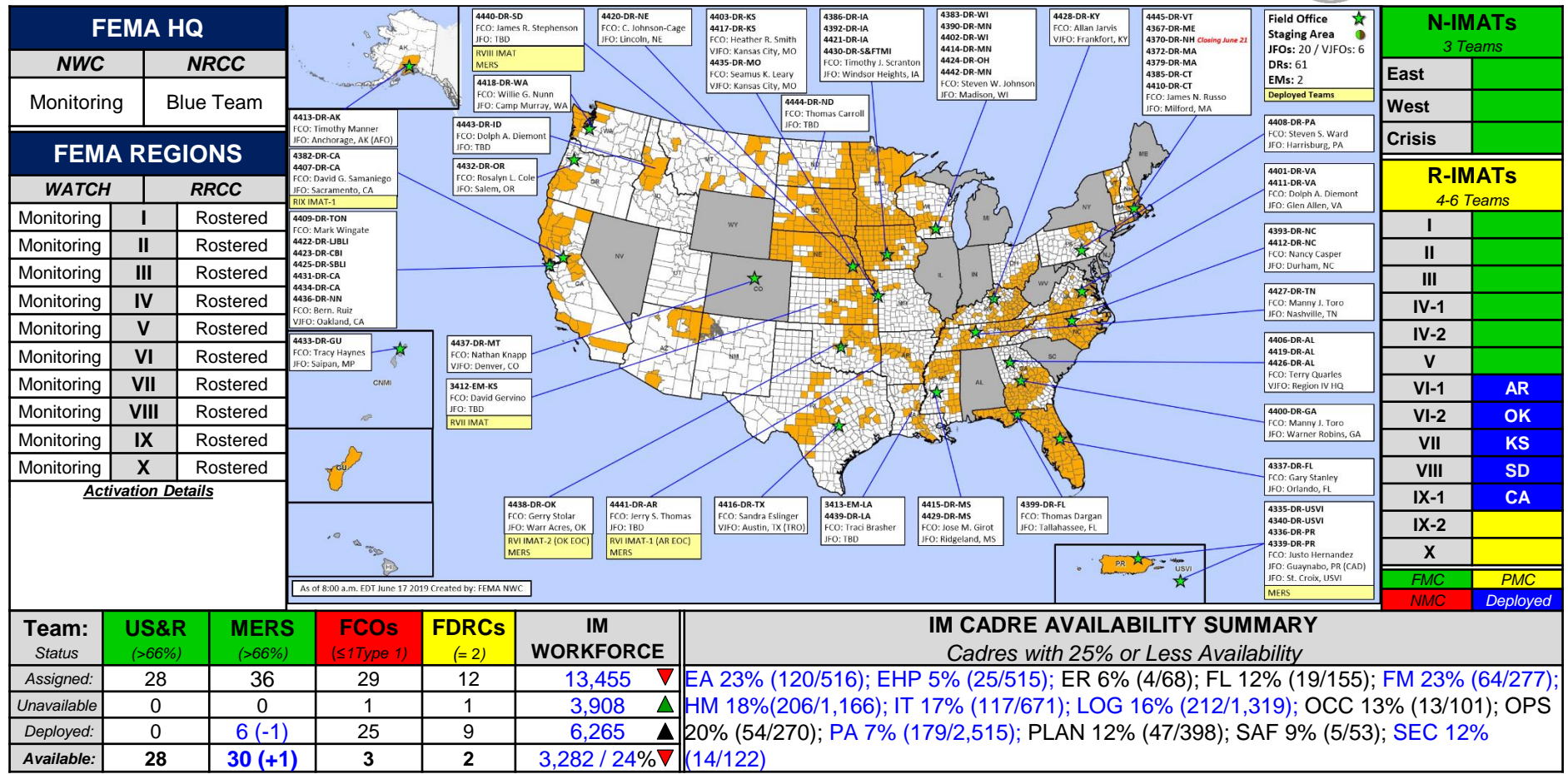
