


National Weather Forecast






Excessive Rainfall Outlook











Severe Weather Outlook





Hazards Outlook – June 20-24










 - Hazard Mitigation statewide






Declaration Approved



FEMA-4446-DR-Ponca Tribe of Nebraska

- The President approved a Major Disaster Declaration for the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska on June 17, 2019
- For severe storms and flooding that occurred March 13 to April 1, 2019
- Provides: Public Assistance and Hazard Mitigation for the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska
- FCO is Constance C. Johnson-Cage


