- Flash Flood Watches in effect – Middle Mississippi Valley to the Mid-Atlantic

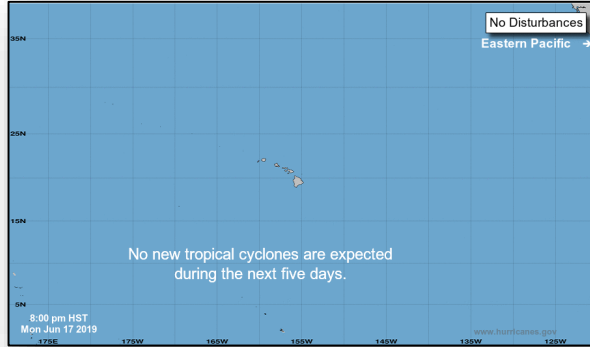

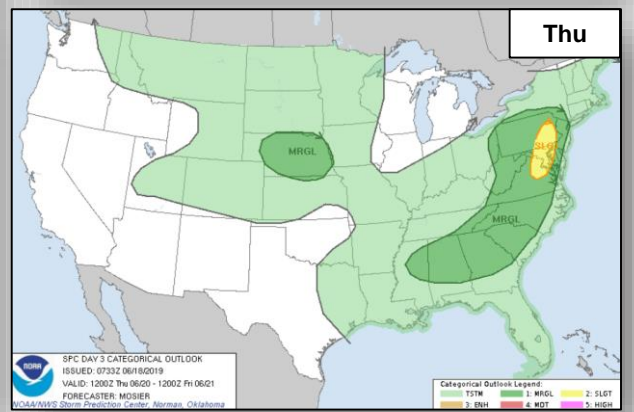
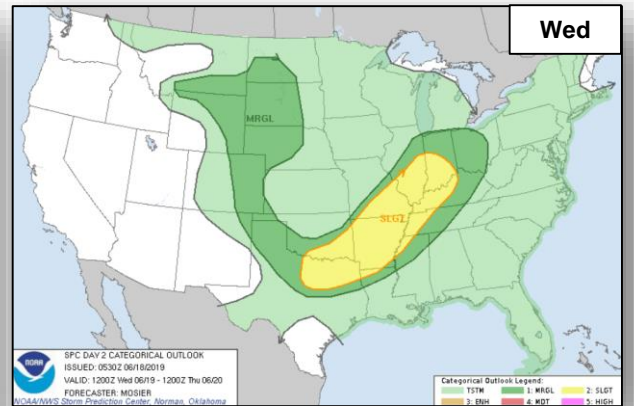
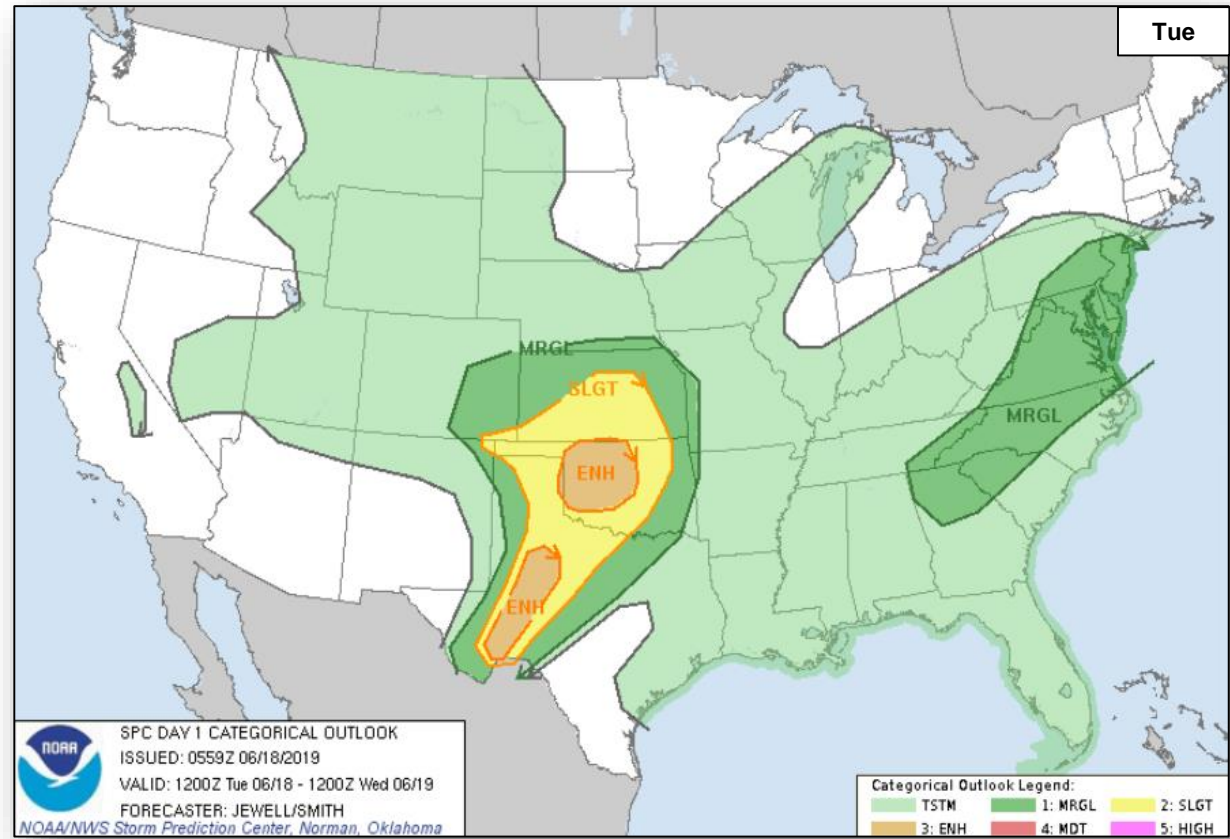


# Excessive Rainfall Outlook





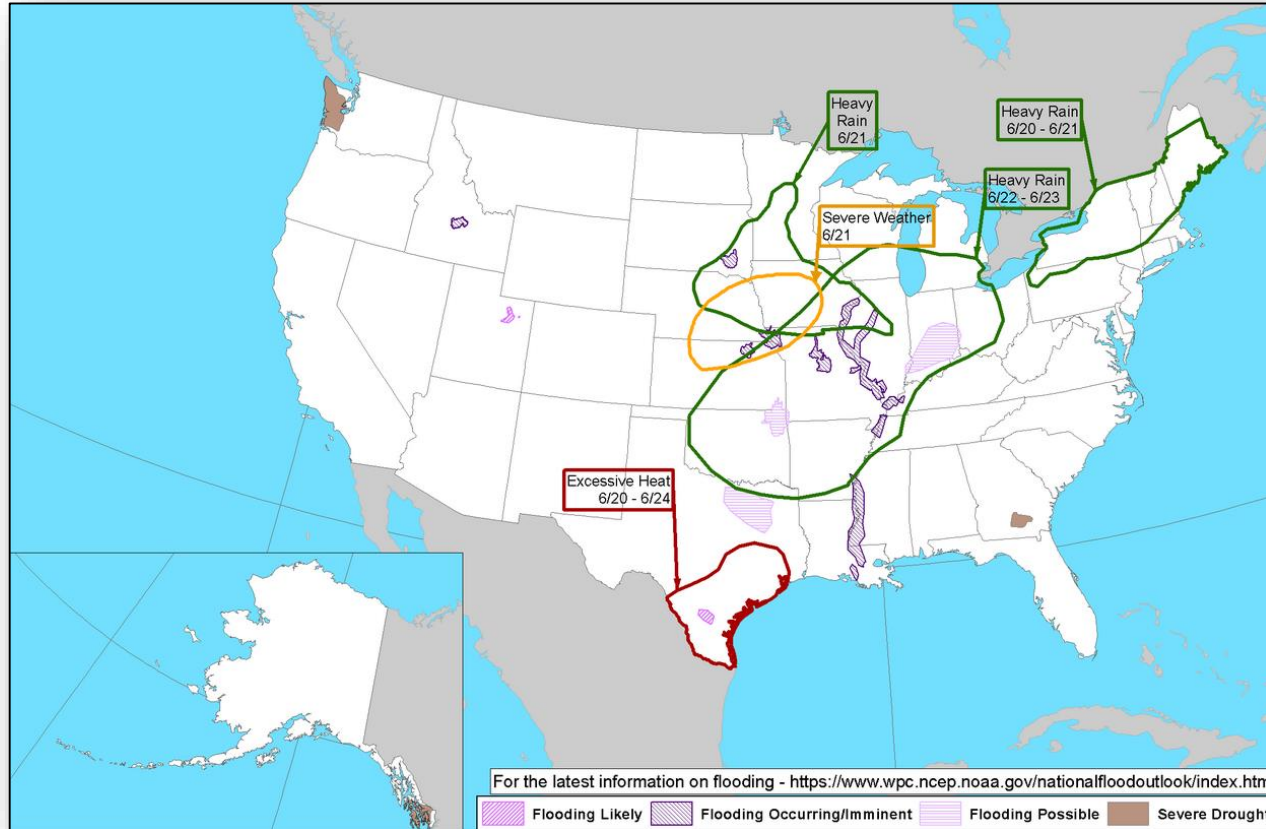

  - Hazard Mitigation statewide



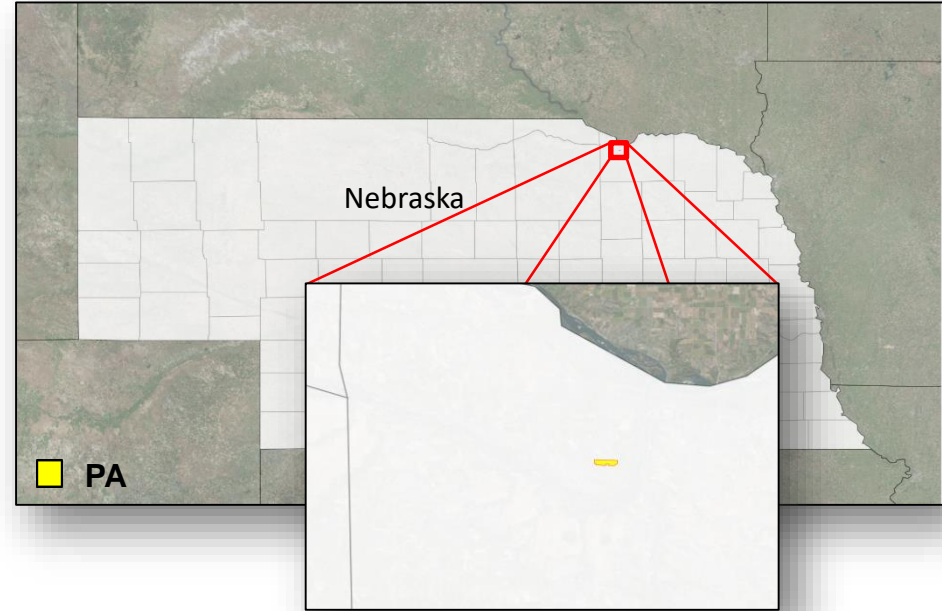
