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Significant Activity – June 22-23

Significant Events:

- Flooding – Central U.S. *(Updated weekly on Wednesdays)*

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Eastern Pacific – Disturbance 1: **High (70%)** – No threat to U.S. interests
- Central Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

Significant Weather:

- **Severe Thunderstorms Possible** – Southern Plains to Middle/Lower Mississippi valleys
- **Heavy Rain and Flash Flooding Possible** – Southern Plains, Mississippi Valleys, and Great Lakes






Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

National Weather Forecast




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Precipitation Forecast


Excessive Rainfall – Lower MS Valley



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Significant Rainfall Forecast for Today:


- Scattered showers & thunderstorms expected in portions of the Southern Plains and Lower Mississippi Valley

Severe Weather Outlook




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
Fire Weather Outlook




Long Range Outlooks – Jun 28 – Jul 02



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6-10 Day Temperature Probability





6-10 Day Precipitation Probability
