Significant Weather:


- Severe Thunderstorms Possible Portions of TX, Upper Mississippi Valley, and Tennessee/Ohio valleys to the Mid-Atlantic






- A few hundred miles southwest of the Gulf of Tehuantepec









Excessive Rainfall – Forecast










Severe Weather Outlook











Fire Weather Outlook









6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




