FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorms and flash flooding possible – Upper Mississippi Valley and Great Lakes
- Extreme heat continues – Central and Eastern U.S.

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Eastern Pacific – No threat to U.S. interests
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (60%)
 - Disturbance 2: Low (30%)
- Central Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Western Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm 06W (Danas)
 - Invest 91W

- Amendment No. 2 to FEMA-3416-EM-LA

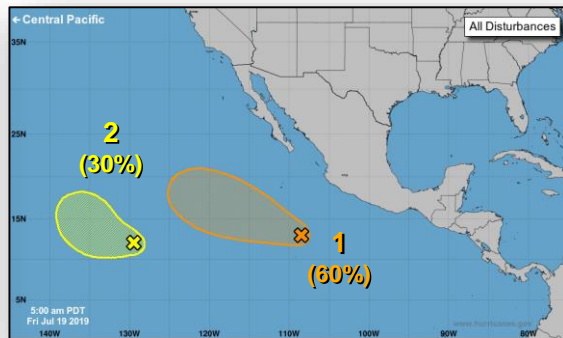
Tropical Outlook – Five Day



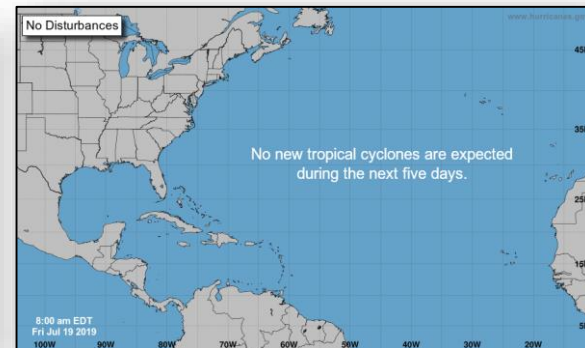

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Several hundred miles south of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 10-15 mph
- Tropical depression could form early next week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 1,500 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California Peninsula
- Moving WNW 10-15 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

Current Disturbances & 5 Day Cyclone Formation: < 40% | 40-60% | > 60%
Tropical / Sub-Tropical Cyclone: Depression | Storm | Hurricane | Post-Tropical Cyclone / Remnants

Potential track area: Day 1-3 | Day 4-5 | Watches: Hurricane | Trop Stm | Warnings: Hurricane | Trop Stm | Current wind extent: Hurricane | Trop Stm

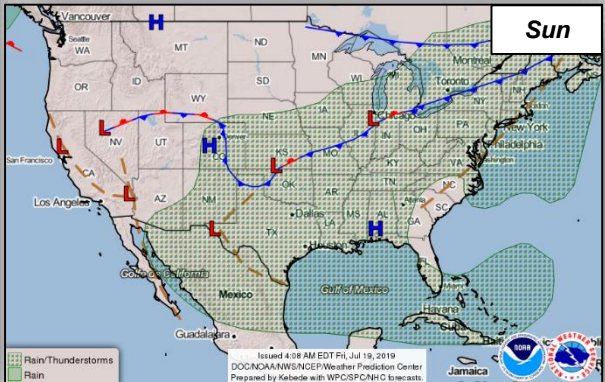
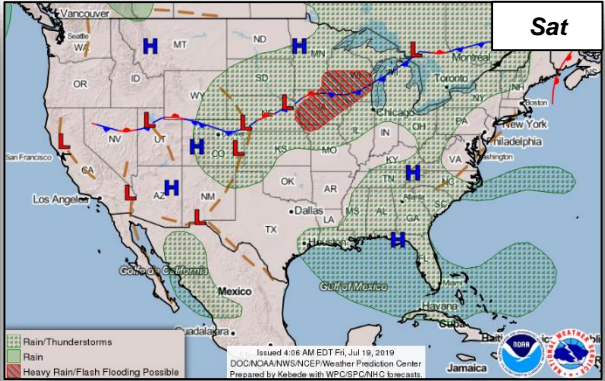
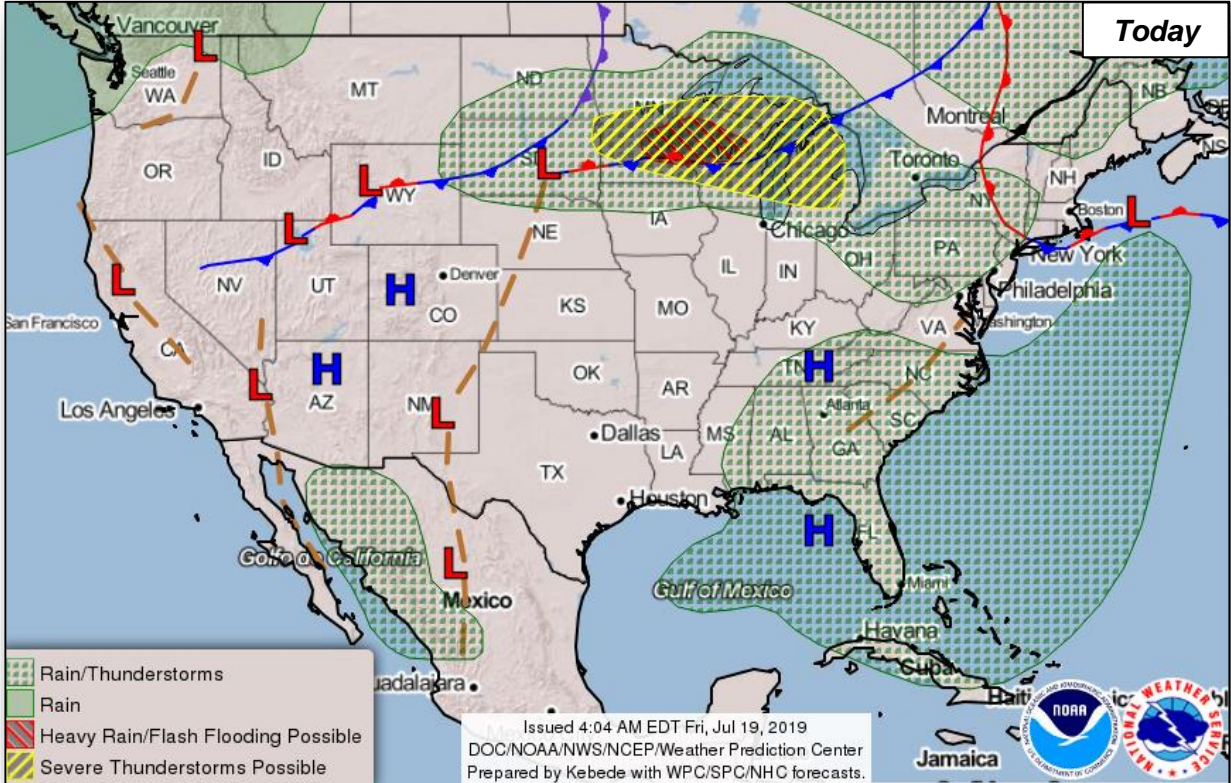
- Located 285 miles SW of Kadena Air Base

- Potential development is downgraded to medium



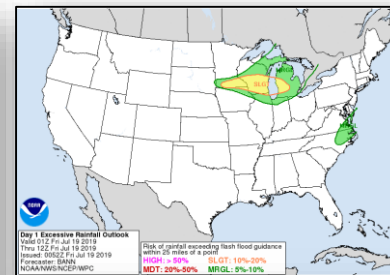
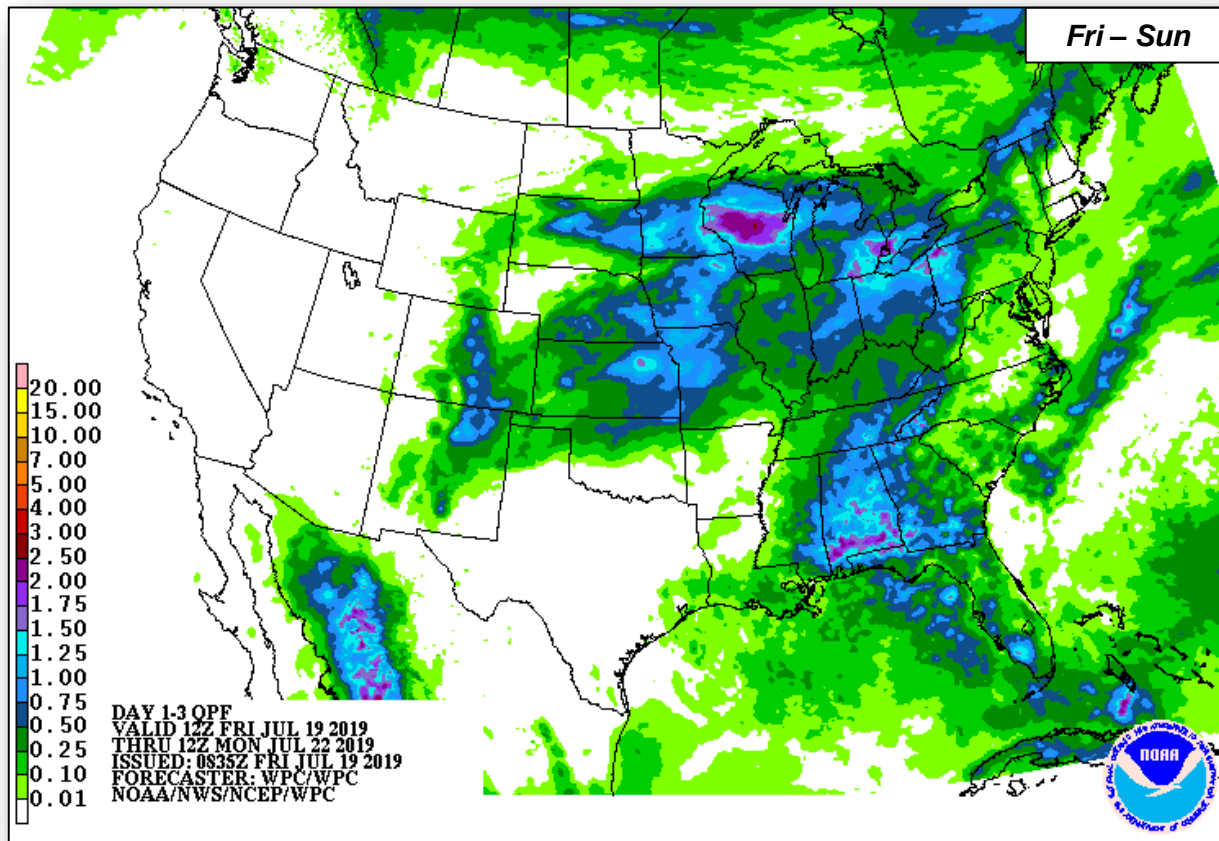
National Weather Forecast



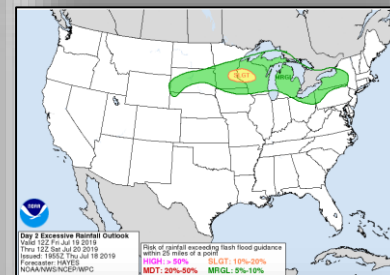
Precipitation Forecast



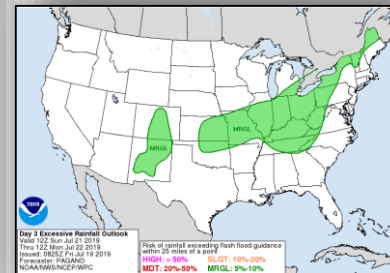

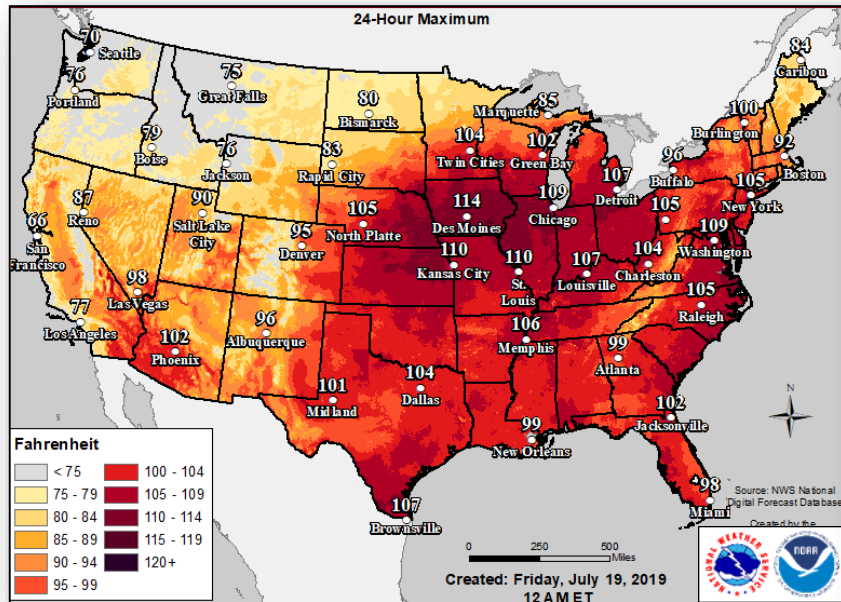
Severe Weather Outlook



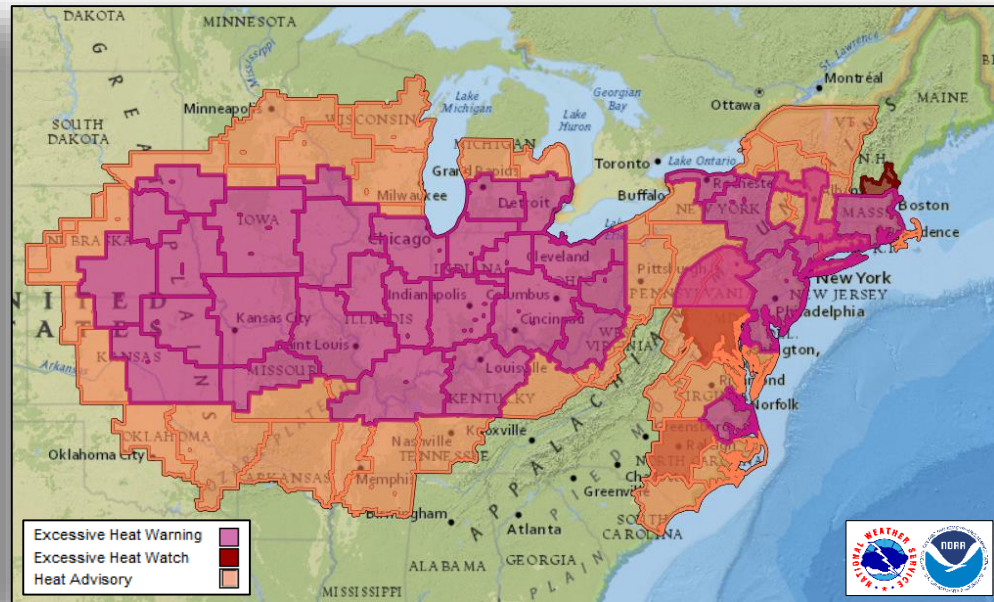
Forecast Heat Index

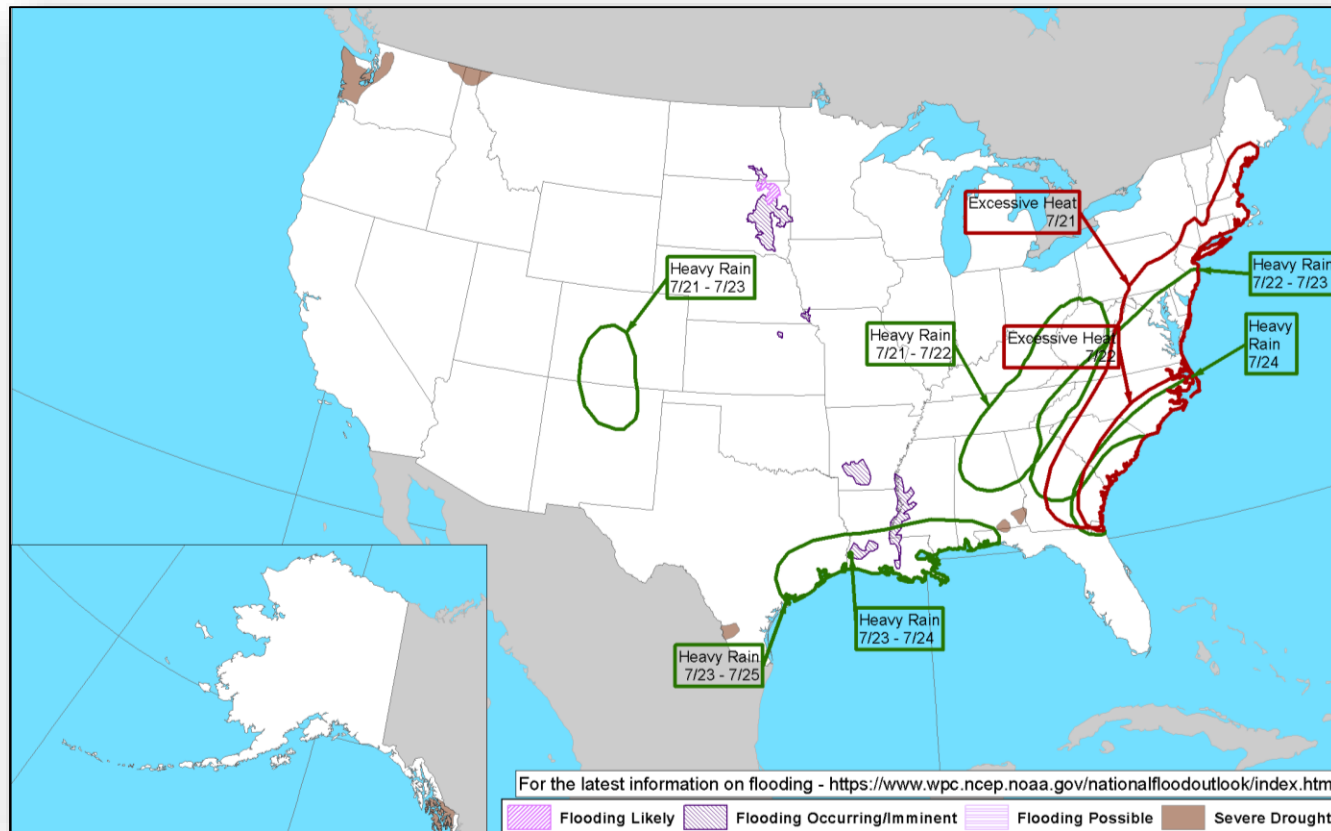

Hazards Outlook – July 21-25



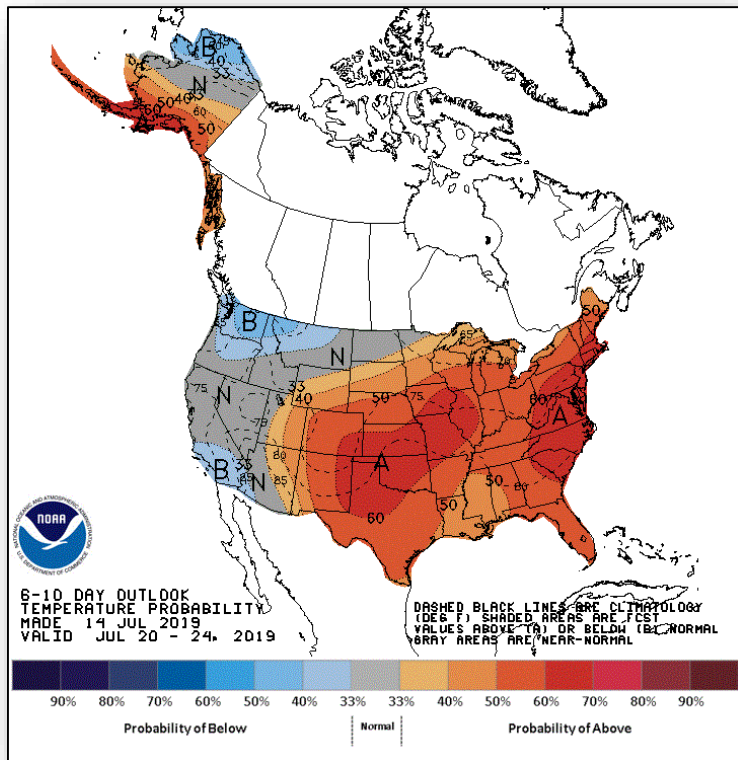

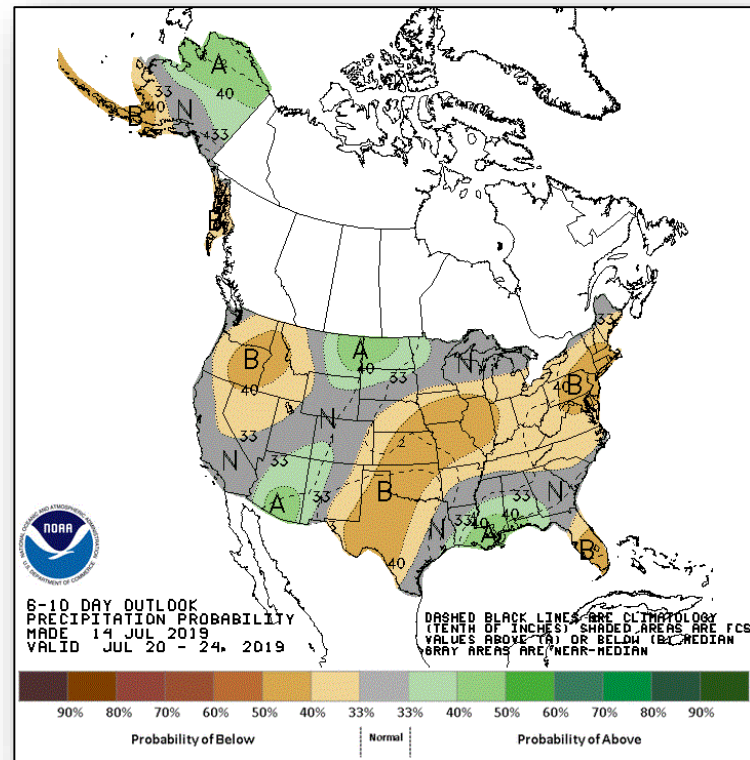
Long Range Outlooks – Jul 20-24

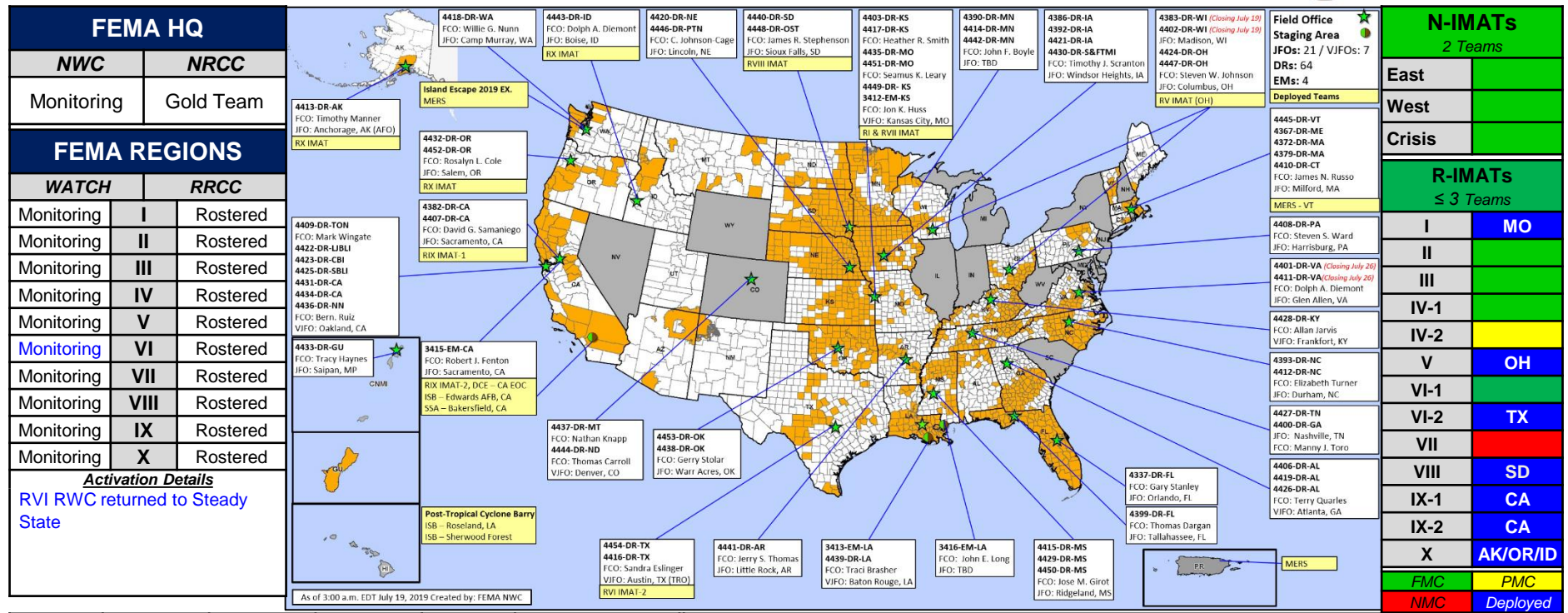
