National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorms possible Central Plains; Middle Mississippi Valley to Great Lakes
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Central Plains to Great lakes
- Extreme heat Central to Eastern U.S.

Tropical Activity:


- Atlantic Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next 5 days
- Eastern Pacific No threat to U.S. interests
 - Disturbance 1: High (80%)
- Central Pacific No activity affecting U.S. interests
 - Disturbance 1: Low (10%)
- Western Pacific No activity affecting U.S. interests

Tropical Outlook – Five Day









Central Pacific

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Several hundred miles SSE of the Big Island of Hawaii
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)

Eastern Pacific

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Several hundred miles SSW of southern tip of Baja California
- Moving W to WNW at 10-15 mph
- Tropical depression is likely to form within the next few days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (80%)








National Weather Forecast





Precipitation Forecast











Severe Weather Outlook











Forecast Heat Index





Hazards Outlook – July 22-26









