Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorms possible – Mid-Atlantic into Southern New England
- Heavy rain and flash flooding –Tennessee Valley to the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific: Tropical Depression 5-E

Declaration Activity: Amendment No. 14 to FEMA-4421-DR-IA

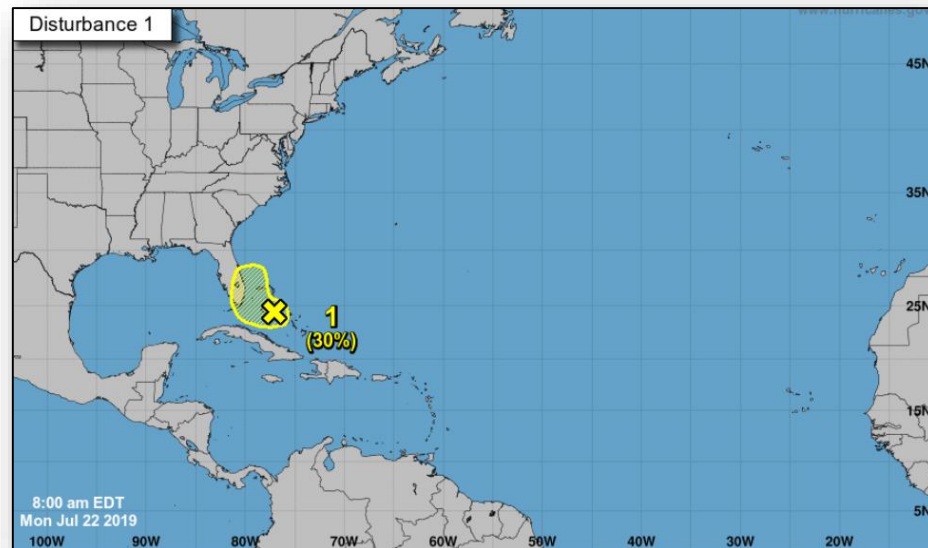
Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



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Disturbance 1 *(as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)*

- Over the Northwest Bahamas
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

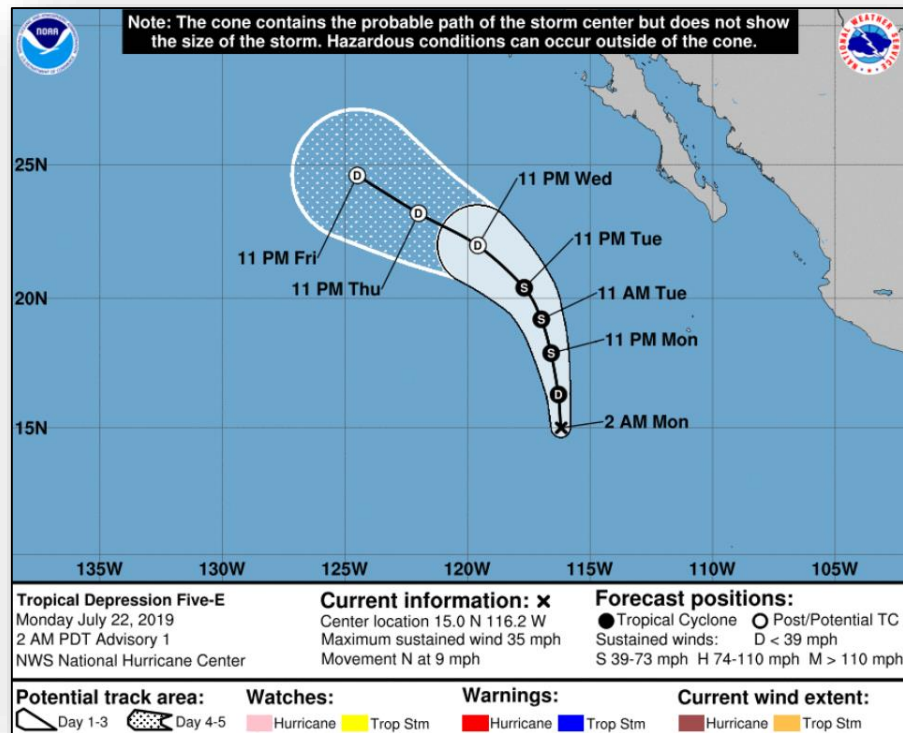
Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



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Tropical Depression Five-E (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

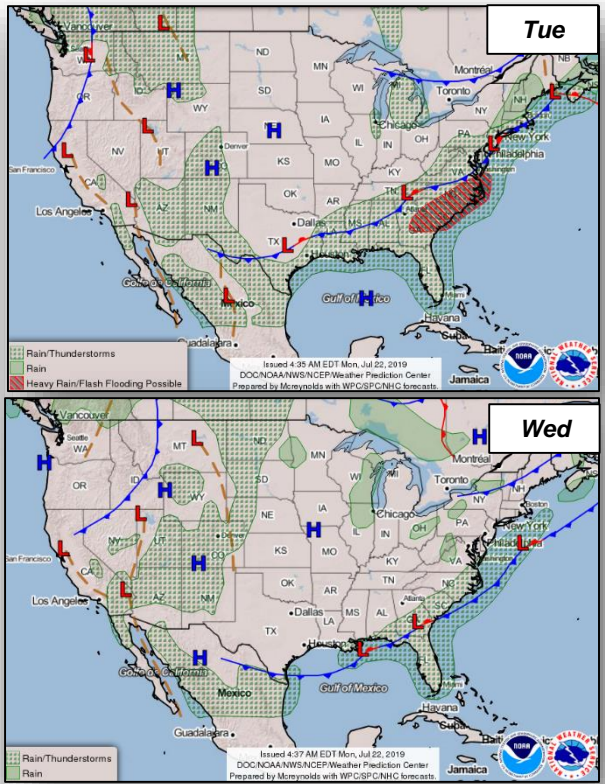
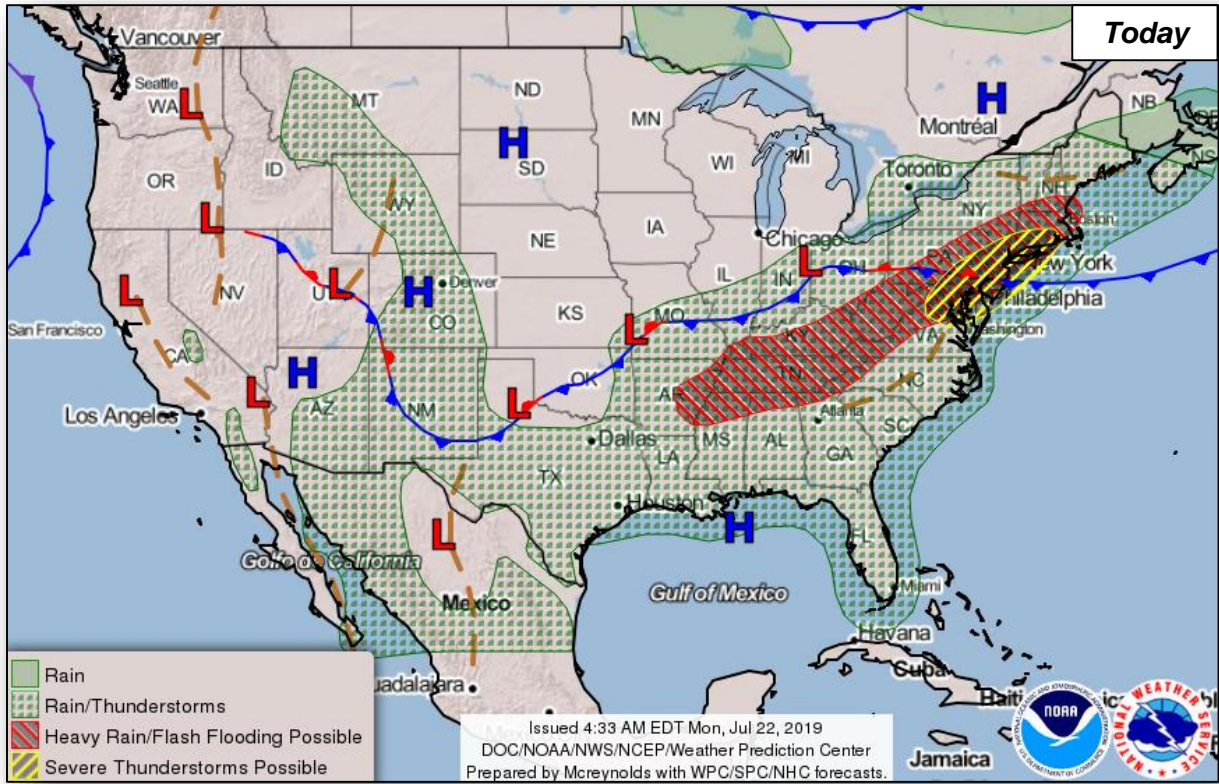
- Several Hundred miles SW of southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving N at 9 mph
- Max sustained winds 35 mph
- Expected to strengthen to a Tropical Storm Tuesday
- No threat to U.S. interests

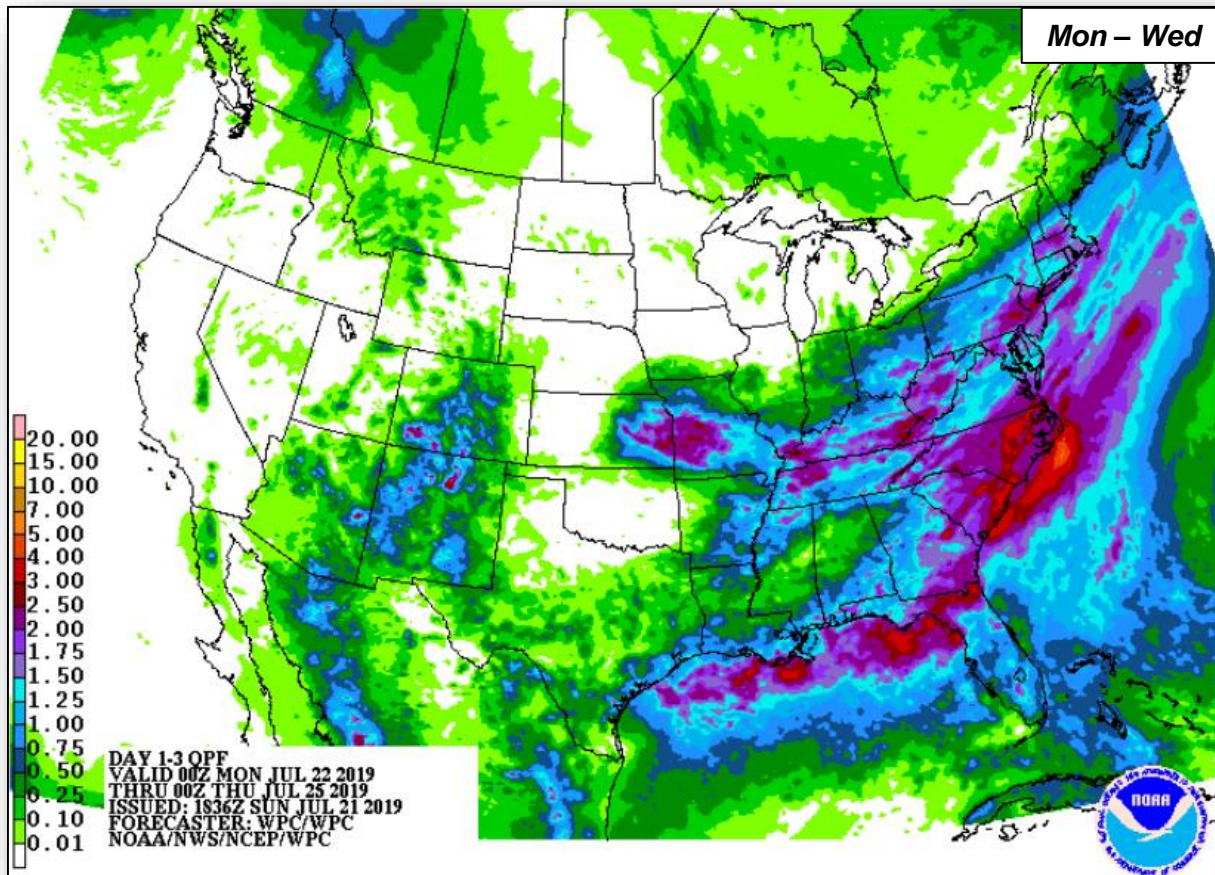

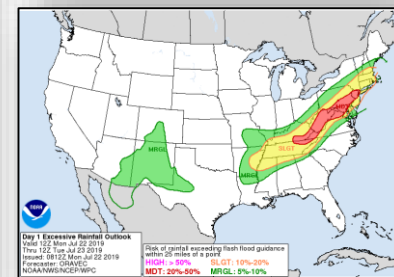
Precipitation Forecast



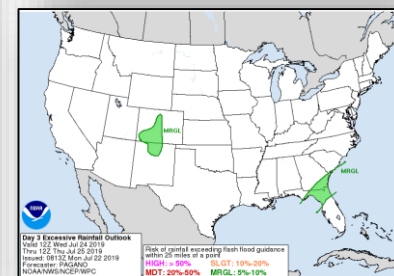

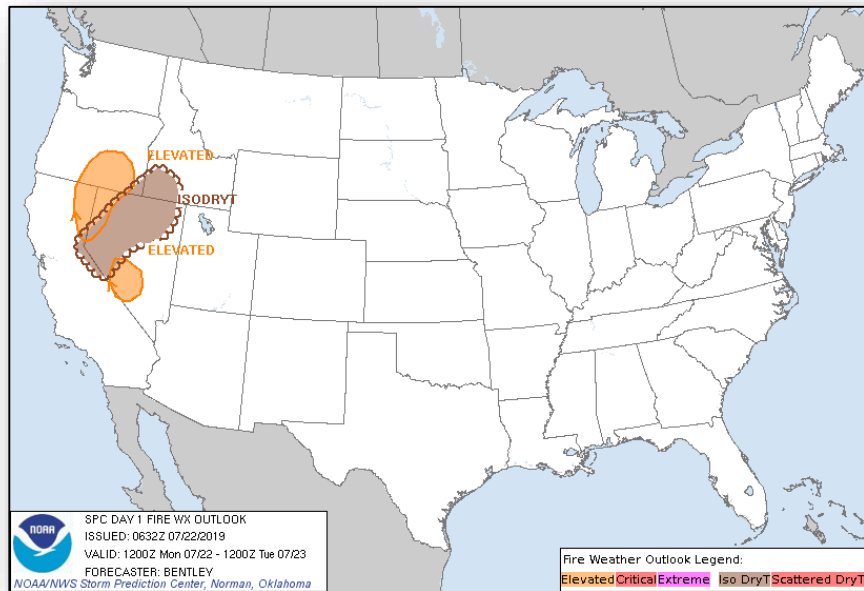

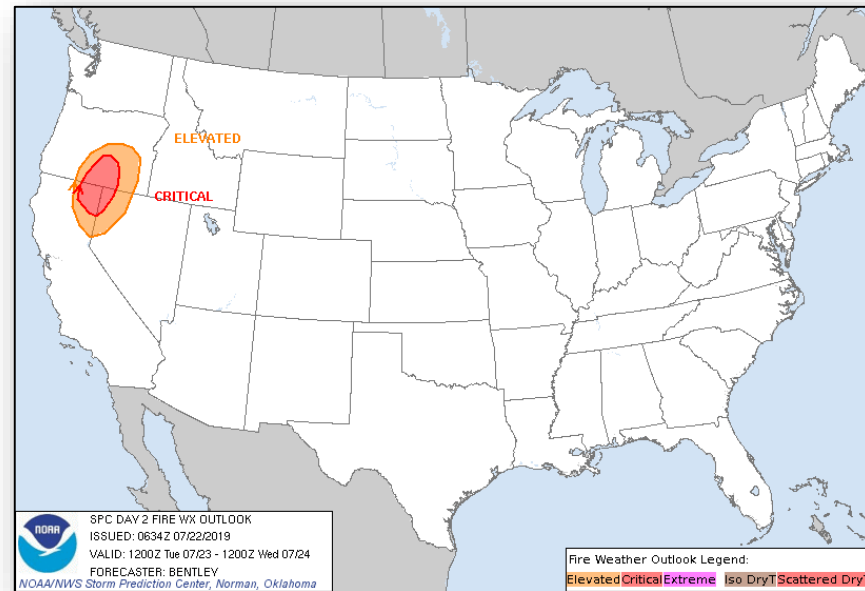

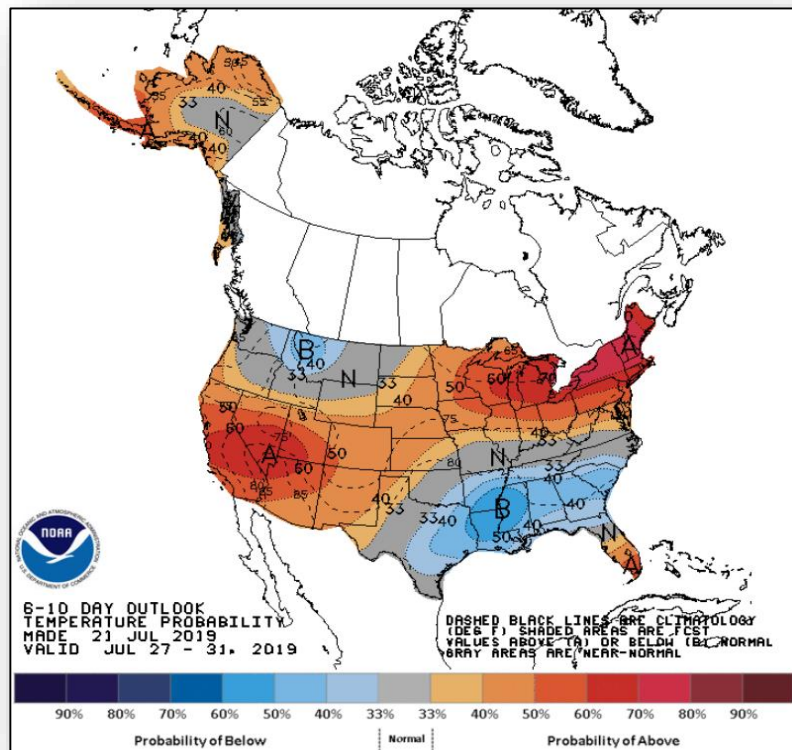

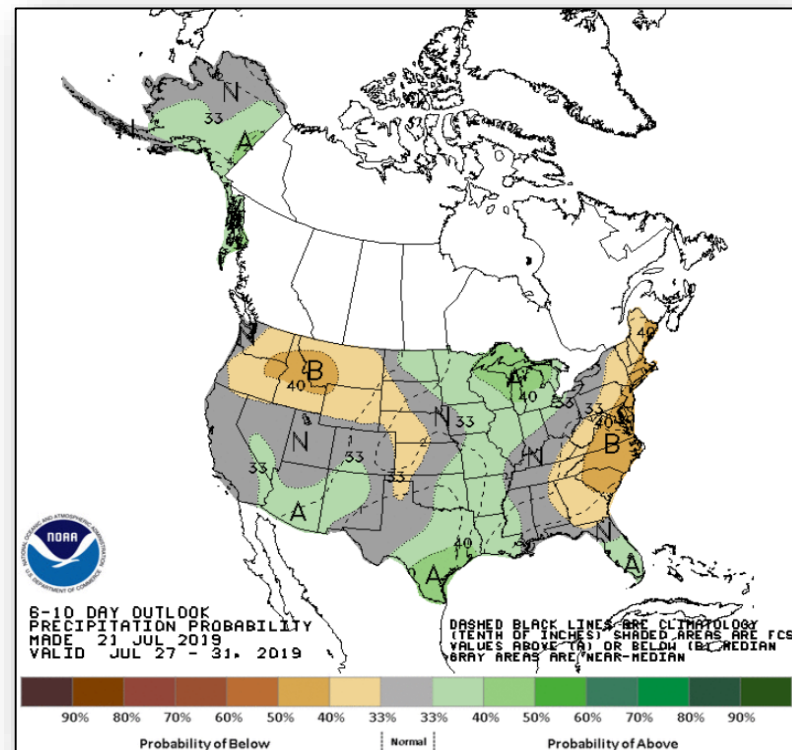
