Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Heavy rain and flash flooding – [Lower Mississippi Valley to the Mid-Atlantic](#)
- Severe thunderstorms possible – Across the central and eastern Carolinas
- Wildfire – Museum Fire, AZ

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: [Tropical Depression 3](#); Disturbance 1: Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific: [Tropical Storm Dalila](#); Disturbance 1: Low (20%); Disturbance 2: Low (30%)

Declaration Activity: FMAG: 5284-FM-AZ Museum Fire (Coconino County)

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic


Tropical Depression Three (as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 40 miles ENE of West Palm Beach, Florida
- Moving N at 12 mph; maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Should remain just offshore of the east coast of Florida
- Forecast to dissipated on Wednesday



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- A non-tropical low-pressure area could form over the northern Gulf of Mexico by late Wednesday or Thursday
- Conditions marginally conducive for some subtropical or tropical development
- Moving slowly east to NE
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Tropical Storm Dalila (as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)



- 585 miles SW of southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving NNW at 7 mph
- Max sustained winds 40 mph
- No threat to U.S. interests

- Few hundred miles south of the coast of southern Mexico
- Moving W at 15 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)



- Few hundred miles south of the coast of southern Mexico

National Weather Forecast








Precipitation Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Fire Weather Outlook



Situation:

- Began Jul 21; burning in Coconino National Forest and on private land
- Two miles north of Flagstaff, AZ (pop. 40k)
- Threatening 180 businesses, water plant, high-voltage power lines, and multiple fire stations/municipal buildings
- Red Flag Warnings in effect for the area; winds of 5-9 mph blowing in the direction of Flagstaff

Impacts:


- One shelter established in Flagstaff with 10 occupants

- AZ EOC is at Normal Operations

FEMA / Federal Response:

- FMAG approved on Jul 22
- FEMA Region IX continues to monitor
- FEMA NWC continues to monitor








