National Current Operations & Monitoring



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Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorm possible – Northern Plains to Upper Mississippi Valley
- Red Flag Warnings – MT
- Wildfire – Museum Fire, AZ

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Low (10%)
- Eastern Pacific: Tropical Depression Dalila; Disturbance 1: Medium (50%); Disturbance 2: Medium (40%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Declaration Activity:

- Request: Major Disaster – West Virginia


Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

- Located over the northern and central Gulf of Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (0%)

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Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

Tropical Depression Dalila (Advisory #13 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 675 miles W of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving NW at 6 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 30 mph
- **Expected to become a post-tropical remnant low later today**
- No threat to U.S. interests




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- A thousand miles SSW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 10-15 mph
- **A tropical depression could form over the weekend or early next week**
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)



- An area of low pressure is expected to form a few hundred miles south of the coast of southern Mexico by the end of the week
- **A tropical depression could form by early next week**
- Moving W at 15-20 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)







National Weather Forecast



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

Precipitation Forecast



Severe Weather Outlook




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
Fire Weather Outlook




