- Severe thunderstorms possible Upper Mississippi Valley to Great Lakes
- Heavy Rain/Flash Flooding possible Central & Southern Rockies
- Museum Fire, AZ


Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: Medium (50%); Disturbance 2: Medium (50%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests


- About 1,000 miles SSW of southern tip of Baja California, Mexico

- Formation chance next 5 days: Medium (50%)


Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- Few hundred miles S of southern Mexico









Precipitation Forecast


















Severe Weather Outlook











Fire Weather Outlook






