National Current Operations & Monitoring



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Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Mile Post 97 Fire – OR
- North Hills Fire – MT
- Heavy rain/flash flooding possible – Northern Plains to the Great Lakes

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Erick
 - Disturbance 1: High (90%)
- Central Pacific: TS Erick expected to enter this basin on Tuesday
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Declaration Activity:

- Approval: FMAG – Mile Post 97 Fire – Oregon
- Approval: FMAG – North Hills Fire – Montana

Situation:


- Began Jul 24
- Burning south of Canyonville, OR (pop. 2k) on federal, state, private, and tribal land
- Threatens subdivisions in Azalea and Canyonville (combined pop: 1k)

State / Local Response:

- OR EOC at Normal Operations
- Evacuation warnings issued for affected communities

FEMA / Federal Response:

- FMAG approved on Jul 27
- FEMA Region X and NWC continue to monitor

Situation:


- Began Jul 26
- Burning on federal, state, and private land, 2.5 miles north of Helena, MT (pop. 31k)
- Threatens two subdivisions, Hauser Hydroelectric Dam, and major electrical transmission lines

Impacts: One shelter open / unknown number of occupants

State / Local Response: MT EOC at Normal Operations

FEMA / Federal Response:

- FMAG approved on Jul 28
- FEMA Region VIII and NWC continue to monitor






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Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific


Tropical Storm Erick (Advisory #4 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 1,865 miles ESE of Hilo, Hawaii
- Moving W at 16 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Forecast to become a hurricane tomorrow with continued strengthening through Tuesday
- Expected to move into the Central Pacific on Tuesday



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- Several hundred miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving W at 15-20 mph
- Expected to become a tropical depression
- Formation chance next 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance next 5 days: High (90%)





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Precipitation Forecast





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Severe Weather Outlook




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

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

6-10 Day Temperature Probability





6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


