# National Current Operations & Monitoring

## Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – Southwest to Central Great Basin and Central Rockies; Central Plains to Middle Mississippi Valley
- Severe thunderstorms possible – Mid-Atlantic
- Mile Post 97 Fire – OR
- North Hills Fire – MT

## Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1 – Low (10%); Disturbance 2 – [Medium \(50%\)](#)
- Eastern Pacific:
  - [Hurricane Flossie \(Cat 1\)](#)

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
# Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

## Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located over Hispaniola, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands
- Forecast to move NW to N at 10 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)

## Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located a few hundred miles **SSW** of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving W at 15 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: **Medium (50%)**






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# Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific


## Hurricane Flossie (Cat 1) (Advisory #12 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 2,075 miles ESE of Hilo, HI
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 80 mph
- Hurricane force winds extend 30 miles; tropical storm force winds extend 105 miles



## Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located several hundred miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving W or WNW at 15 mph
- A tropical depression could form over the weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)





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## Hurricane Erick (Cat 3) (Advisory #16 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)




- 695 miles ESE of Hilo, Hawaii




