National Current Operations & Monitoring



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Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Critical Fire Weather conditions – Central Great Basin
- Red Flag Warnings – Pacific Northwest to Northern Rockies; Central Great Basin

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected in the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%)
 - Disturbance 2: Low (30%)
 - Disturbance 3: Medium (50%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected in the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

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Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- Located 100 miles SE of Acapulco, Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- A few miles SSW of Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 1,000 miles SSW of Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)




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Precipitation Forecast




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


