Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorms possible – Central/Northern Plains and Middle/Upper Mississippi Valley
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – Middle/Upper Mississippi Valley; Southeast and coastal Carolinas

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: High (80%)
 - Disturbance 2: Low (20%)
 - Disturbance 3: Low (20%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected in the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests




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Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located over the northeastern Gulf of Mexico and northeastern Florida
- Moving NE at 5-10 mph
- Forecast to produce heavy rainfall with a threat for flash flooding near the coasts of GA, SC, and NC
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

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Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- A couple of hundred miles S of the coast of Guatemala
- Moving WNW at 10 mph
- A tropical depression is likely to form early next week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (80%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 850 miles SSW of southern tip of Baja California Peninsula, Mexico
- Moving W to WNW at 5-10 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- 1,300 miles WSW of southern tip of Baja California Peninsula, Mexico



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Severe Weather Outlook







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Precipitation Forecast




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

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
