- Severe thunderstorms possible – Central Plains to Ohio Valley; Upper Mississippi Valley
- McKinley Fire, AK

- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected in the next five days

Situation:


- Began Aug 17 and is burning on private land, 18 miles north of Willow (pop. 2k)
- Threatening three subdivisions, state owned Alaska Railroad, and publicly owned power lines

Impacts:

- 3 shelters open with 95 occupants statewide (ARC *Midnight Shelter Count as of 5:48 pm EDT*)

Response:


- AK EOC at Normal Operations
- FMAG approved on Aug 20
- FEMA Region X and NWC continue to monitor






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Tropical Outlook – Five Day


Eastern Pacific

Invest 97E (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- 900 miles WSW of southern tip of Baja California peninsula, Mexico
- Moving W to WNW at 10 mph
- Formation chance through 5 days High (80%)




Invest 97L (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)




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Severe Weather Outlook







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Precipitation Forecast





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

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


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Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State

States with Currently Occupied Units




