- Heavy rain and possible flooding/flash flooding - Western Gulf Coast

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Hurricane Humberto (CAT 1)
 - Disturbance 1: High (90%); Disturbance 2: Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Hurricane Kiko (CAT 1)
 - Disturbance 1: High (90%); Disturbance 2: High (90%); Disturbance 3: Low (30%)
- Central Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%); Disturbance 2: Low (20%); Disturbance 3; Low: (20%)
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Hurricane Humberto *(Advisory #19A as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)*

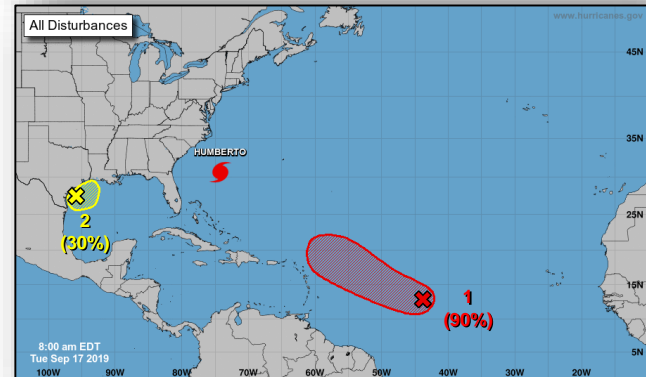
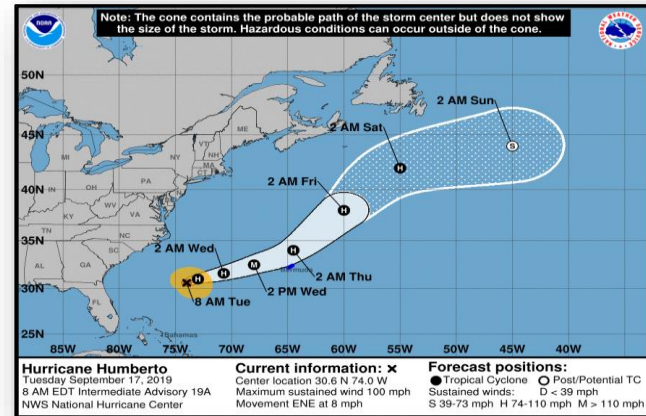
- 555 miles W of Bermuda
- Moving ENE at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 100 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend 30 miles
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 150 miles

Disturbance 1 (Invest 97L) *(as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)*

- 1,000 miles E of the Lesser Antilles
- Tropical depression likely to form in day or so
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

Disturbance 2 *(as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)*

- Located over the northwestern Gulf of Mexico
- Moving inland along the northwestern Gulf coast by tonight
- Expected to produce locally heavy rainfall and possible flash flooding along the central and upper TX coastal areas later this week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Hurricane Kiko (CAT 1) *(Advisory #20 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)*

- 1,035 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving W at 5 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 80 mph
- Expected to become a tropical storm later today
- Hurricane-force winds extend 15 miles; tropical-storm-force winds extend outward 60 miles

Disturbance 1 (Invest 91E) *(as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)*

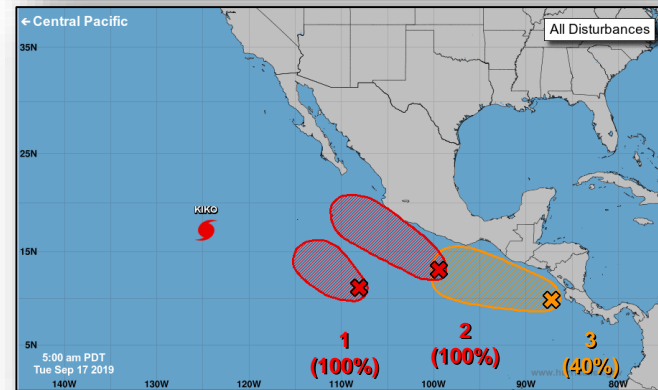
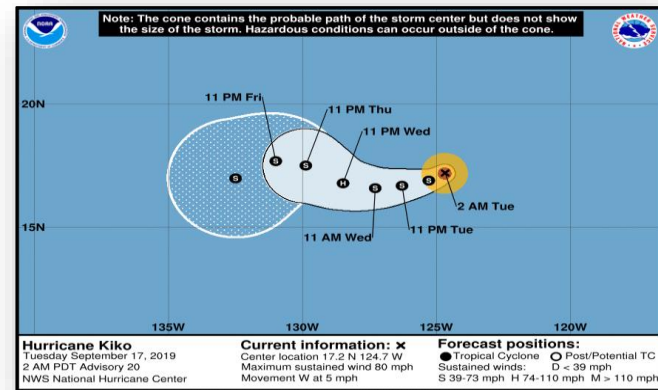
- 600 miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Tropical depression could form later today or tonight
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (100%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (100%)

Disturbance 2 (Invest 92E) *(as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)*

- 250 miles S of Acapulco, Mexico
- Tropical depression or tropical storm could form later today or tonight
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (100%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (100%)

Disturbance 3 *(as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)*

- Disorganized cloudiness and showers just west of Central America
- Moving WNW at 5 to 10 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

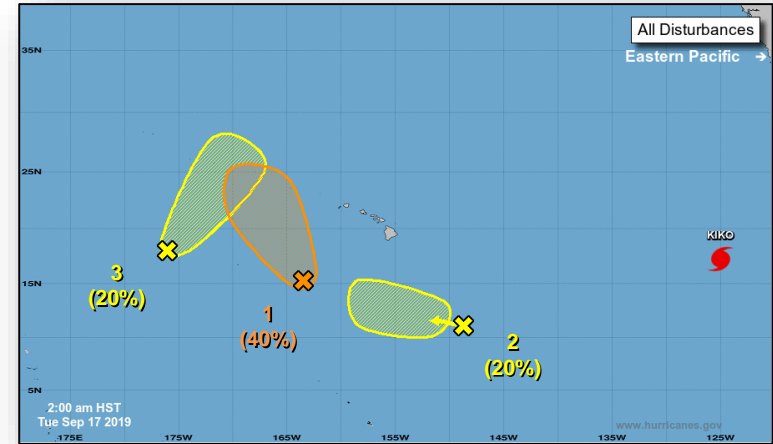
- 540 miles SSW of Honolulu, HI
- Moving slowly NW
- Could become a tropical depression within a few days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 700 miles SE of the Big Island of Hawaii
- Moving slowly W
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

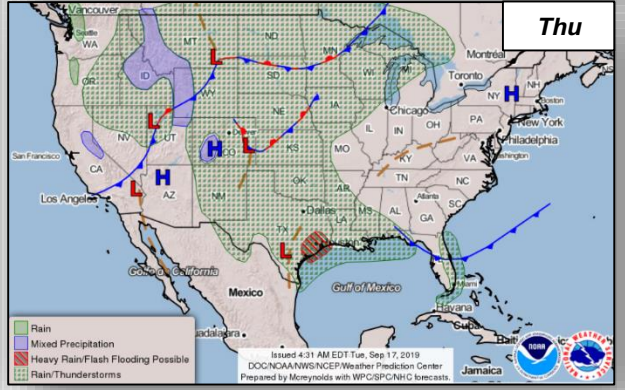
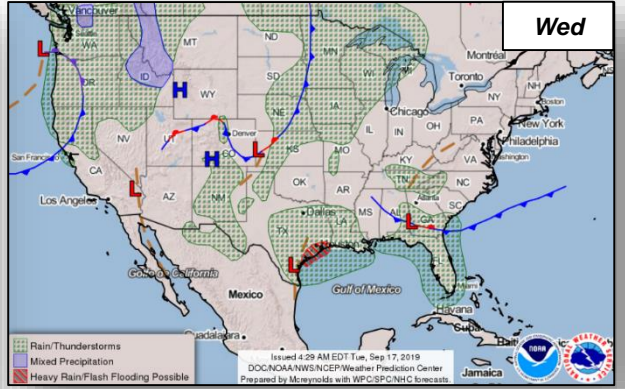
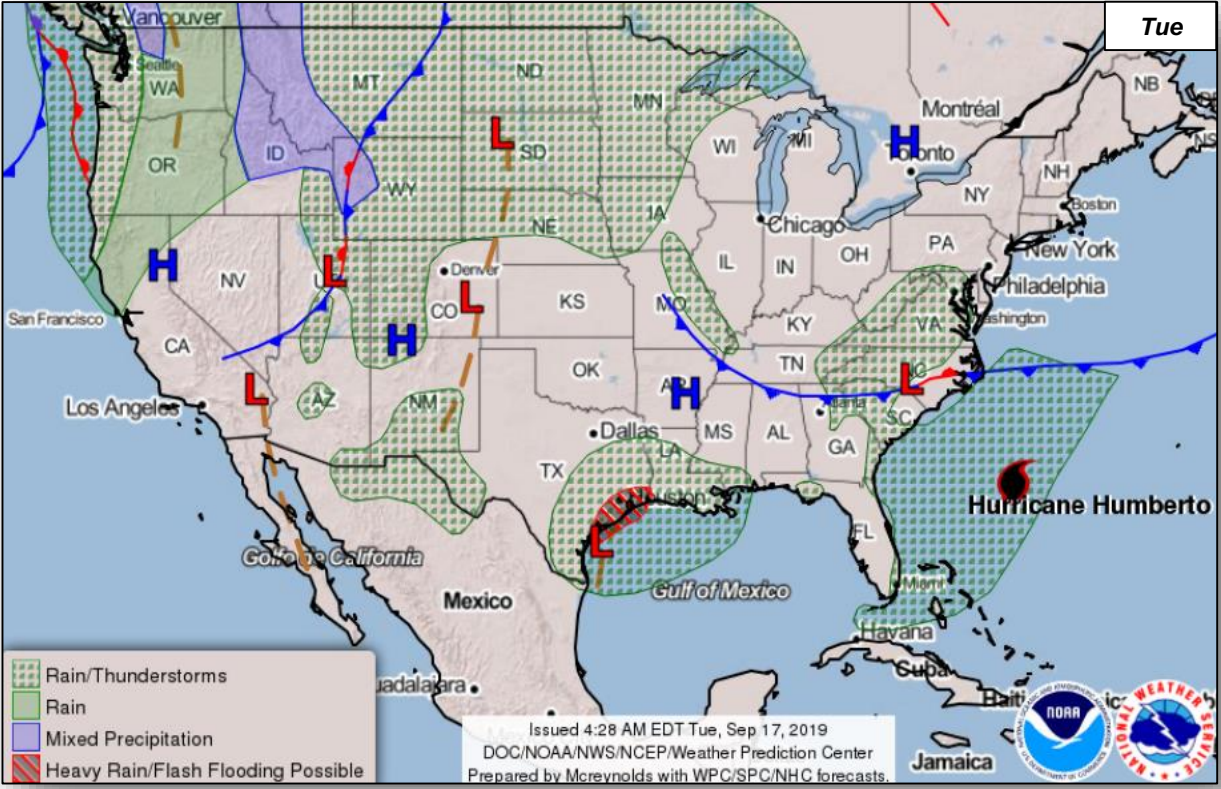
- 1,100 miles WSW of Kauai

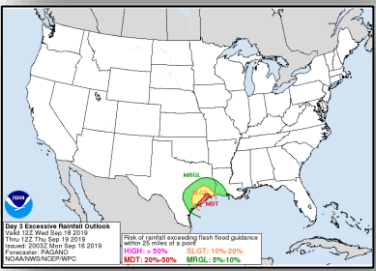
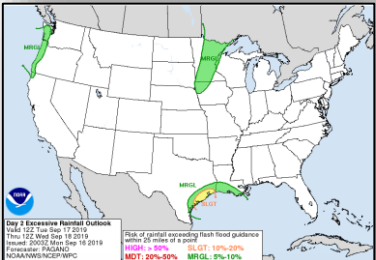
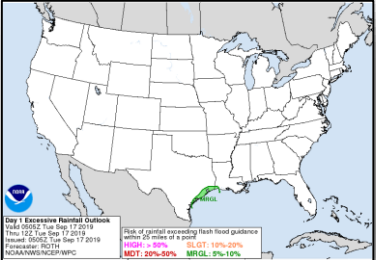
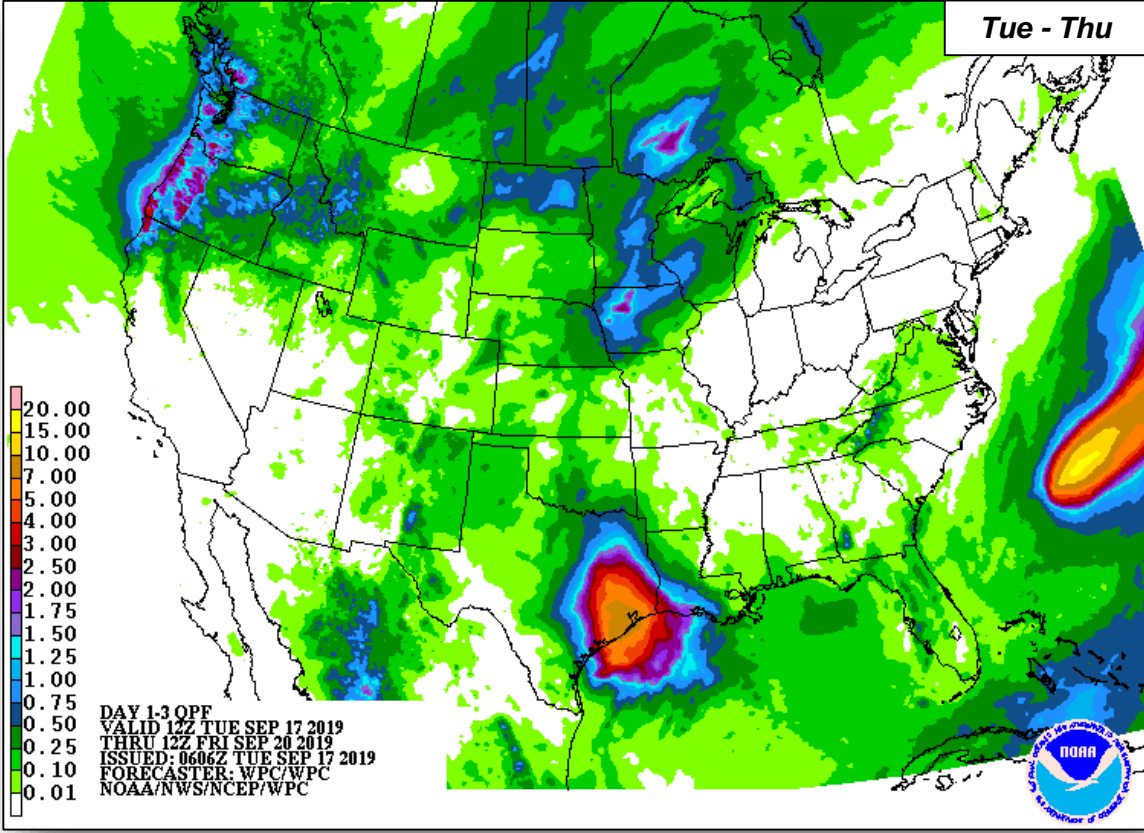
National Weather Forecast



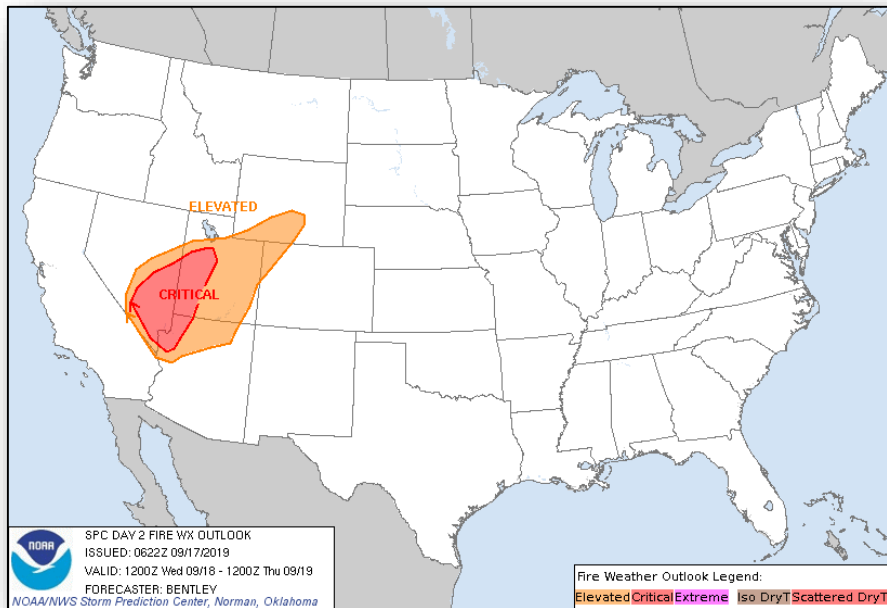
Precipitation Forecast



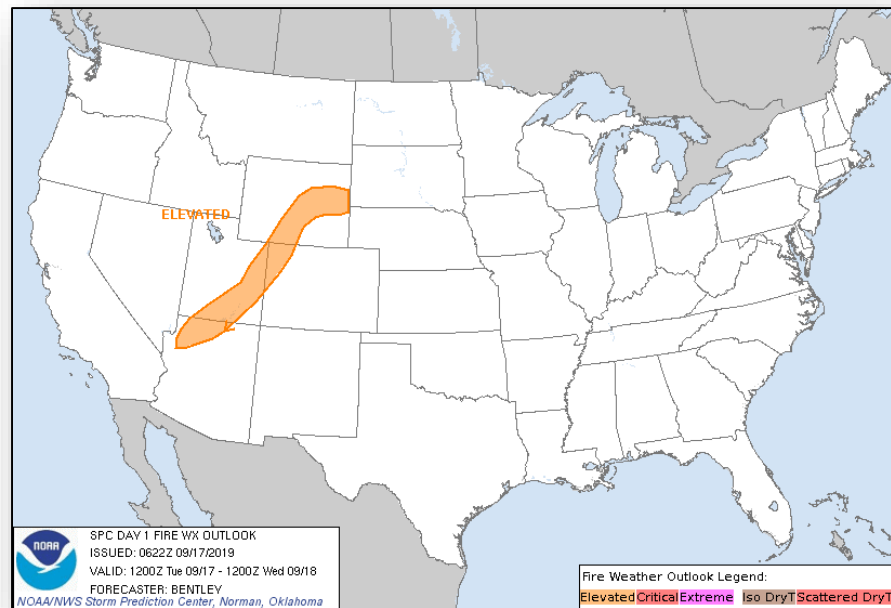

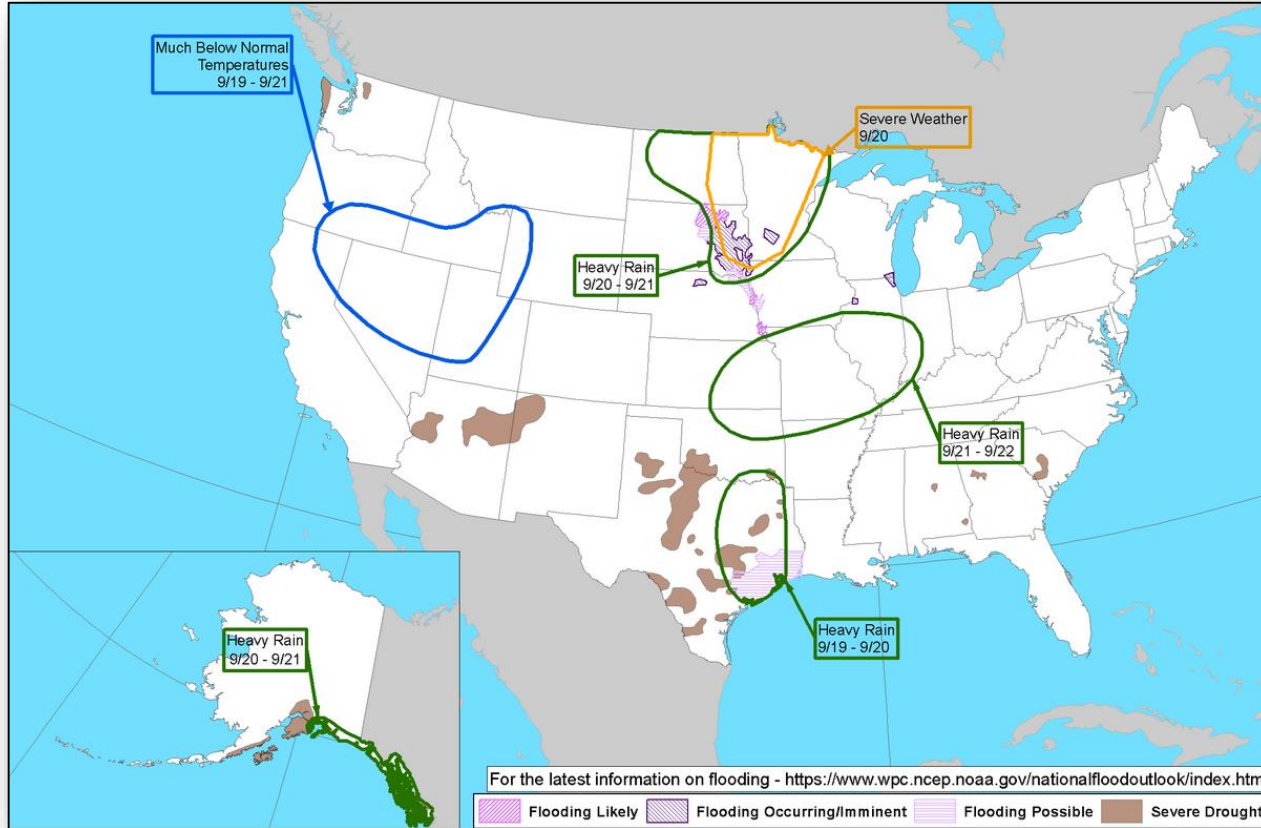

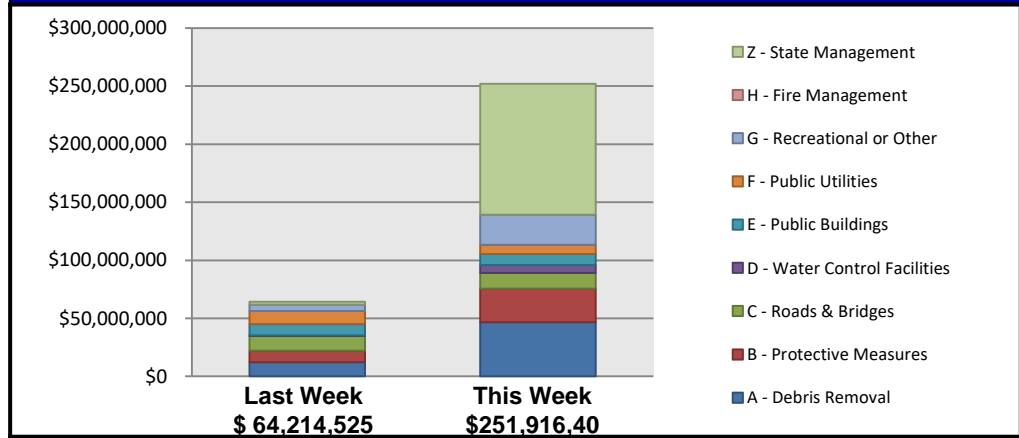

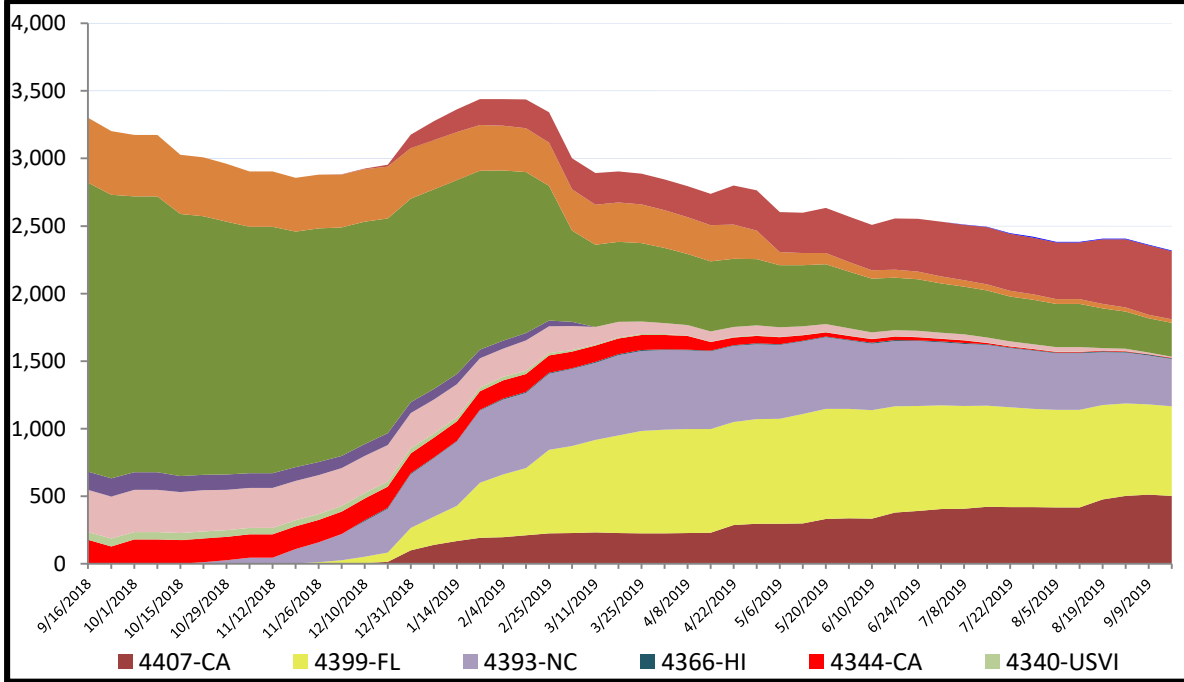

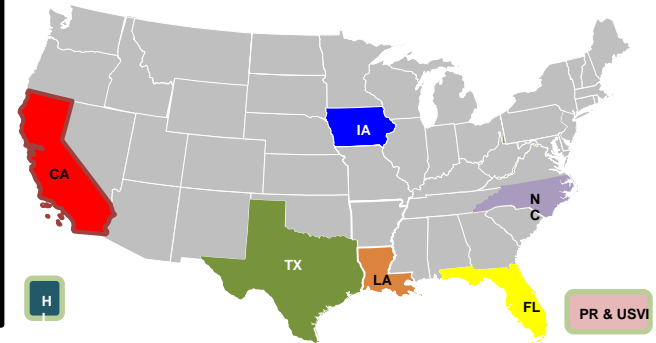

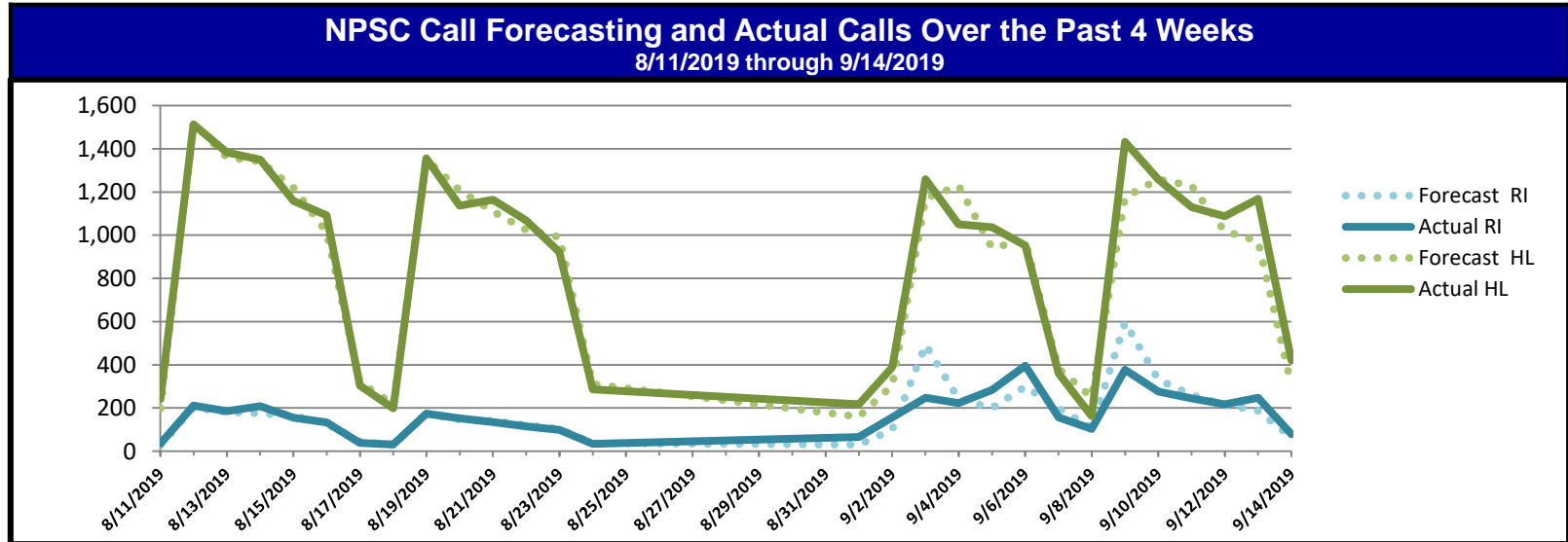


States with Currently Occupied Units
