National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Heavy rain and flooding possible TX and LA
- Critical and elevated fire weather NV, AZ, UT, CO, WY and ID

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Hurricane Humberto (CAT 3); Tropical Storm Jerry
 - Disturbance 1: Low (20%); Disturbance 2: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Kiko; Tropical Storm Lorena; Tropical Storm Mario
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%)
- Central Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%); Disturbance 2: Low (20%); Disturbance 3: Low: (20%)
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

Hurricane Humberto (CAT 3) (Advisory #23A as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 240 miles W of Bermuda
- Moving ENE at 16 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 115 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend 60 miles; tropical-storm force winds extend 175 miles

Tropical Storm Jerry (Advisory #4 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 960 miles E of Leeward Islands
- Moving WNW at 13 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend to 45 miles

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic




Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- Expected to develop this weekend to the east of the Windward Islands
- Moving W to WNW
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- Forecast to move off the west coast of Africa on Thursday
- Moving W at 10-15 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Tropical Storm Kiko (Advisory #24 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 1,130 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving WSW at 5 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Could become a hurricane by late Friday
- · Tropical storm force winds extend 45 miles

Tropical Storm Mario (Advisory #4 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)


- 635 miles S of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving NW at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 90 miles
- Expected to become a hurricane by Friday

Tropical Storm Lorena (Advisory #4A as of 7:00 a.m. EDT)

- 140 miles SW of Zihuantanejo, Mexico
- Moving NW at 14 mph
- · Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 90 miles

Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- Extends several hundred miles S over the Pacific waters
- Moving W at 5-10 mph
- Tropical depression could form over the weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)


- 500 miles SW of Honolulu, Hawaii
- Moving NNW
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- 830 miles WSW of Kauai
- Expected to move slowly NE
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)


- 700 miles SE of Hilo, Hawaii
- Moving slowly NW
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Tropical Depression Imelda Total Rainfall (including amounts already observed):


6-12 inches, with isolated amounts to 18 inches possible across portions of eastern Texas, including the Houston and Galveston areas.





Key Message


This system has the potential to produce significant flash flooding along portions of the Upper Texas Coast, including the **Houston and Galveston** areas.


