National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Tropical Cyclone Karen Atlantic
- Severe thunderstorms and excessive rain Southwest

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Tropical Storm Karen; Tropical Storm Lorenzo; Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Kiko; Disturbance 1: Low (10%); Disturbance 2: Medium (50%); Disturbance 3: Low (20%)
- Central Pacific: No tropical cyclones expected through the next 5 days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Declaration Activity:

• Approval: Major Disaster – FEMA-DR-4483-South Dakota

Tropical Cyclone Karen

Situation

Tropical Cyclone Karen is forecast pass near or over the U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico today.

A Tropical Storm Warning is in effect for the U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico. Rainfall accumulations of 2 to 4 inches, with isolated 8 inches, may cause flash flooding and mudslides.

Local Preparations/Response

- USVI Government offices closed
- USVI schools are closed (Region II Spot Report as of 6:54 p.m. EDT)
- PR: 35 shelters opened with 25 occupants (ARC Shelter Report as of 6:12 a.m. EDT)
- · PR: Port conditions X-RAY (ports remain open to all commercial traffic)
- USVI: Port conditions ZULU (all ports closed)
- PR EOC Full Activation, State of Emergency declared
- USVI EOC Full Activation

Federal Preparations/Response

- NWC Enhanced Watch, day shift only (UNGA)
- NRCC ROC activated, day shift (Tropical Cyclone Karen) Region II:
- RWC at Enhanced Watch, 24/7 (UNGA through Sep 28)
- RRCC at Level III, day shift (UNGA Sep 23-24)
- LNOs deployed to PR and USVI

IMAT Teams:

- Region I IMAT: deployed to PR
- Region II IMAT: deployed to USVI
- N-IMAT East: deployed to PR



Tropical Storm Karen (Advisory #9A as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 75 miles WSW of St. Croix, USVI
- Moving N at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- On the forecast track, the center will pass near or over Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands today
- Tropical storm force winds extend 80 miles

Watches/Warnings:

• Tropical Storm Warning in effect for USVI and PR



Tropical Outlook – Atlantic


Tropical Storm Lorenzo (Advisory #6 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 310 miles SW of southernmost Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving WNW at 16 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 65 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 115 miles
- Forecast to become a hurricane later today; could become a major hurricane on Thursday

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Centered near the north coast of the Yucatan Peninsula
- Moving slowly W at 5-10 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Tropical Storm Kiko (Advisory #48 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 1,115 miles east of Hilo, Hawaii
- Moving NW at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds at 40 mph
- Expected to become a remnant low in a couple of days

Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- · A few hundred miles south of southwestern coast of Mexico
- Expected to merge with a larger system to the east in a few days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)


Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- Expected to form south of the southern coast of Mexico
- Tropical depression could form over the weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- Could form several hundred miles SSW of southern tip of Baja California peninsula, Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



Precipitation Forecast












States with Currently Occupied Units


