National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – Southwest

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Tropical Storm Karen; Hurricane Lorenzo (CAT 3)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%); Disturbance 2: High (70%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Declaration Activity: None

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

Tropical Storm Karen (Advisory #17 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 520 miles NNE of San Juan, PR
- Moving NNE at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 45 miles

Hurricane Lorenzo (Cat 3) (Advisory #15 as of 6:00 a.m. EDT)

- 995 miles W of southernmost Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 125 mph
- Hurricane force winds extend 35 miles; tropical storm force winds extend 205 miles

Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located several hundred miles SSW of southern tip of Baja California peninsula, Mexico
- Moving slowly N or NNE
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- Located over the far eastern portion of the East Pacific basin
- Moving WNW at 10-15 mph
- Tropical depression is likely to form over the weekend or early next week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (80%)

Federal Preparations/Response


- NWC at Enhanced Watch, day shift only (UNGA)

- N-IMAT East: demobilizing








Precipitation Forecast









Fire Weather Outlook






