National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats: None

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Medium (50%); Disturbance 2: Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: Low (0%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: Tropical Storm 20W (Hagibis)

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Forecast to form over the North Atlantic between Bermuda and the Azores in a couple of days
- Moving W
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Forecast to develop over the western North Atlantic between Bermuda and the east coast of U.S. by the middle of next week
- Expected to move N to NE
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)




Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 1,400 miles WSW of southern tip of Baja California peninsula, Mexico
- Development is unlikely
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (near 0%)



Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific






Tropical Outlook – Western Pacific



Tropical Storm 20W (Hagibis) (Warning #5 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 618 miles E of Andersen AFB, Guam
- Moving W at 20 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- On the forecast track it should pass just N of Saipan early Mon EDT
- Tropical storm force winds extend 100
- Storm Surge: dangerous surf likely for Saipan and Tinian, up to 17 feet Mon and Tue; 1-2 feet of inundation possible along windward coastlines
- Rainfall: heavy rain will begin Mon; 5-8 inches possible for Saipan and Tinian; 2-4 inches for Rota through Tue
- Typhoon Warning in effect for Tinian, Saipan, Alamagan and Pagan
- Tropical Storm Warning in effect for Rota and Agrihan
- Tropical Storm Watch in effect for Guam



Tropical Cyclone – Hagibis


Preparations and Response:

- There are no reported unmet needs. There have been no requests for FEMA assistance.
- Region IX RWC remains at Steady State, continues to monitor
- Airports: no closures at this time
- Seaport conditions: Saipan (Yankee); Guam (X-Ray)
- Saipan/Tinian/Rota: 7 shelters opened with 15 occupants (Region IX SPOTREP as of 7:24 am EDT)
- Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI)
 - EOC at Full Activation
 - Government offices and schools will close on 7 Oct (local time)
 - Hospital generators and water tanks have two weeks of supply and have 30 day medical supply on hand (HHS Region IX SPOTREP as of 5:30 am EDT)
- Guam
 - EOC at Normal Operations










Severe Weather Outlook











Precipitation Forecast
















6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




