## National Current Operations & Monitoring



#### **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Super Typhoon Hagibis FINAL
- Critical Fire Weather and Red flag Warning CA, NV, AZ, UT, & CO

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Medium (40%); Disturbance 2: Low (20%); Disturbance 3: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: High (70%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Request: Major Disaster Declaration – Florida

### Typhoon Hagibis – FINAL



#### **Situation:**

Super Typhoon Hagibis is located 625 miles NNW of Guam and is no longer a threat to U.S. interests

#### **Lifeline Impacts:**

#### Safety and Security:

• CNMI: Schools and government offices closed (FEMA Region IX)

#### Food, Water, Shelter:

- Saipan:
  - Water system restoration concurrent with electrical restoration (FEMA Region IX)
  - Boil Water notice issued for CNMI (CNMI Bureau of Environmental Quality)
  - 7 of 14 tanks meet chloritization levels the remainder are being chlorinated by crews (FEMA Region IX)
- Shelters: 1 (-2) open / 12 (-154) occupants (FEMA Region IX, as of 6:30 a.m. EDT)

#### Health and Medical:

 Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation: well stocked and prepared with generator fuel topped off with 2-weeks supply; water tanks also have 2-weeks supply (CHCC Website)

#### Transportation:

 Road: Saipan Department of Public Works continue to clear debris and access damage around the island

#### Energy:

- Saipan: Power outage restoration continues; 5 of 9 power feeders online
  - USACE mission assigned to support power restoration (FEMA Region IX)

#### Response:

- CNMI EOC at Full Activation; Governor declared a State of Emergency
  - FEMA-3424-EM-CNMI approved
- Region IX IMAT-2 deployed to Saipan; MCC de-activated
- Bothell MERS deployed to Guam and Saipan
- FEMA ISB teams deployed to Guam
- NWC and Region IX RWC at Steady State, monitoring

ChST: EDT + 14hrs (0830 EDT = 2230 ChST) Hawaii: EDT - 6hrs (0830 EDT = 0230 HST)

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)


- 1,000 miles E of Bermuda
- Moving W
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located off the Mid-Atlantic coast of the U.S.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

#### Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 250 miles SE of Cape Hatteras, NC
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)




### Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Expected to form several hundred miles SW of the coast of Mexico by the end of the week
- Moving WNW at 5-10 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)
