COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> FEMA, HHS, and federal partners are working with our state, local, tribal, and territorial governments to execute a whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The President released Guidelines for Opening American Up Again and the Federal Government is continuing to work with governors across the country to ensure they have the equipment, supplies, and testing resources they need to reopen safely and responsibly. The HHS Secretary issued a renewal of the January 31 COVID-19 Public Health Emergency Declaration for 90 days.

- FEMA NRCC remains at Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; all FEMA RRCCs activated
- FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed to 27 states/territories; LNOs deployed to 37 states/territories
- 56 major disaster declarations approved; All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 47,599 (+388) FEMA, DOD, HHS, VA and CDC personnel deployed/activated in support of COVID-19 response
 3,161 (+6) FEMA Employees deployed in support of COVID-19 response
- Testing: 6,833,834 (+81,903) cumulative as of May 3

Operational Task Forces

Community Based Testing Sites (CBTS)

- 150,540 (+2,587) samples collected at CBTS locations since March 20
- 118,008 (+7,229) tests processed from Private-Partnership Testing Sites since April 5



Public Health


- Mitigation: CDC issued extended guidance for cleaning and disinfecting homes, schools, and businesses, in anticipation of the phased reopening of many segments of the American economy
- Personal Protective Equipment
 - 500,000 cloth facial coverings shipped to Puerto Rico to support earthquake response that occurred May 2
 - 1.2 million facial coverings are being processed for delivery to 532 Tribal sites
- Medical Care: NYC Mortuary Affairs: DoD providing 24-hour operations; mission assignment extended to May 26 Other Domestic Lifelines
- Food, Water, & Shelter: Cold storage supplies of red meat, pork, and poultry indicate there is enough frozen supply to meet normal demands
- Transportation: Beginning May 4, JetBlue was the first U.S. airline to require passengers to wear masks; Delta and American began requiring flight attendants to wear masks on April 28 to at least June 30




National Weather Forecast











Severe Weather Outlook











U.S. Monthly Drought Outlook











