National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Severe weather possible Upper Mississippi Valley

- Eastern Pacific Disturbance 1 Medium (60%)

COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 47,223 FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; 3,029 (-8) FEMA employees deployed. Federal, state, tribal, and territorial partners continue to focus on expanded access to testing as COVID-19 infection remains prevalent throughout the country. Nationwide testing: 13,627,379 cumulative as of May 24.

Public Health - Federal/State Assistance:

- SBA has approved 430,906 Economic Injury Disaster Loan applications resulting in \$37,869,479,978 disaster loan funds available to assist businesses and their employees
- SBA approved 4,426,118 Paycheck Program applications resulting in \$511,231,948,095 available to assist businesses and their employees

Food, Water, Shelter


 HI: Honolulu is participating in a COVID-19 Wastewater Testing Project with dozens of other states to test sewage for the presence of the virus; testing is designed to monitor for possible increases in COVID-19 cases in particular communities or on the island as a whole

Transportation

 NY: Metropolitan Transportation Authority in NYC announced pilot program using ultraviolet C spectrum technology to kill COVID-19; first phase will be on subways, buses, and transit facilities; if successful, second phase will expand to Long Island Railroad and Metro-North Railroad trains

Response

- Region VII RRCC is rostered; the NRCC and all remaining RRCCs remain activated
- 28 FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed (24 actual/ 4 virtual) to states/territories/tribal nations; LNOs deployed to 37 (21 actual / 16 virtual) states/territories/tribal nations
- 57 Major Disaster Declarations approved; All State / Territory EOCs activated



- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)




Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Disturbance 1 (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Expected to form in a few days S of coasts of southern Mexico, Guatemala, and El Salvador










Severe Weather Outlook











Long Range Outlooks – May 31 – June 4


