Significant Incidents or Threats:


- Tropical Cyclones Preparations and Response
- Severe thunderstorms possible Northern/Central Plains
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Southwest, and eastern/central Gulf Coast
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Tropical Storm Gonzalo
 - Tropical Storm Hanna
 - Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: Low (10%)
- Central Pacific:
 - Hurricane Douglas (CAT 4)
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests


Atlantic Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK




Tropical Storm Hanna SATELLITE LOOP




Tropical Storm Hanna MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS




3 DAY RAINFALL FORECAST




Tropical Storm Hanna FLASH FLOOD POTENTIAL




Tropical Storm Gonzalo FORECAST TRACK




Hurricane Douglas SATELLITE LOOP

Tropical Cyclones – Preparations/Response



Situation:

FEMA HQ and coastal FEMA Regions are closely monitoring tropical cyclone activity in the Atlantic

State/Local Response:

- LA & TX EOCs: Partial Activation (COVID-19)
 - TX EOC: Boat crews rostered and pre-positioned
- HI EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); Governor declared a State of Emergency

Federal Response:

- Region VI
 - RRCC at Level III, will go to 24/7 operations for Tropical Storm Hanna and COVID-19
 - LNO deploying to TX EOC
- Region IX
 - RRCC is Rostered
 - IMAT-2 deploying to Oahu (ETA July 24); LNOs deploying to Oahu and Maui (ETA July 25)
- o FEMA HQ
 - NRCC remains activated to Level I
 - Logistics:
 - Deployments to HI: National ISB team and select SMT Team personnel (ETA July 25)
 - o Commodities on HI: 5M+ meals and 1.2M liters of water (above historic stock levels)
 - o PPE (130,00 N95/KN95/KN90s), gloves and gowns available
 - US&R Mission Ready Package (White IST 10 PAX)) and one Type 3 Task Force (50 PAX) deploying to HI
 - DEC: Bothell MERS personnel deploying to Honolulu (ETA July 25); Denton MERS on stand-by

COVID-19 Update



Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 11 (-10) states, with 26 (+5) states in a plateau status. 29,835 (-408) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,239 (-9) FEMA employees deployed.

Nationwide Testing: 51,680,022 (+1,336,756) cumulative (as of July 23)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 Response Update as of July 23)

o Worldwide: 15,012,731 (+247,475)


Deaths caused by COVID-19

Response:


- NRCC at Level I
