National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe thunderstorms possible Great Lakes
- Heavy snow possible Northern Intermountain to Northern Plains
- Wildfires Western U.S.
- COVID-19

- Atlantic:
 - Hurricane Epsilon (CAT 1)
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (60%)
- Eastern Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located near Grand Cayman
- Moving slowly NW; forecast to move near western Cuba this weekend and move slowly across the southeastern Gulf of Mexico by early next week
- Tropical depression could form during the next couple of days
- Regardless of development, locally heavy rainfall will be possible over southern Florida and the Keys through the weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (50%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



Hurricane Epsilon (CAT 1) (Advisory #18 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 195 miles ENE of Bermuda
- Moving N at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 85 mph
- Gradual weakening is forecast to begin on Saturday
- Hurricane force winds extend outward up to 15 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 255 miles



COVID-19 Update



Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 41 states/territories, with 5 (-1) jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 9 (+2) jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,248 (-7) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 22)

Nationwide Testing: 137,040,404 (+1,215,230) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 22)




Response:

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring




National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Fire Weather Outlook








