- Tropical Activity:
 - Atlantic: Post-Tropical Cyclone Eta FINAL, Tropical
 Storm Theta, Disturbance 1: High (90%)
 - Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: Medium (60%)
- Heavy snow possible Pacific Northwest to Central Rockies and Central Plains; northern CA
- Freezing rain possible Northeast
- Earthquakes NV and CA no damage or injuries

Event Monitoring:

No significant scheduled activity


Eastern Pacific



Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles SW of coast of Mexico
- Tropical depression could form early to middle portion of next week
- 48-hour Formation chance: Low (30%)
- 5-day Formation chance: Medium (60%)

Atlantic



Tropical Storm Theta (Advisory #14 as of 4:00 a.m. ET)

- 445 miles SSE of the Azores
- Moving E at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 195 miles
- Expected to become a remnant low Sunday

Disturbance 1 (as of 1:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central Caribbean Sea
- Tropical depression or tropical storm likely to form later today or tonight
- 48-hour Formation chance: High (90%)
- 5-day Formation chance: High (90%)




Post-Tropical Cyclone Eta – Atlantic – *FINAL*

Situation: (Advisory #52 as of 4:00 a.m. ET)

- 85 miles SE of Wilmington, NC
- Moving ENE at 21 mph
- On the forecast track, expected to gradually pull away from the southeast U.S. coast today
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend out 115 miles
- Could intensify a little as a non-tropical cyclone during the next day or so before it becomes absorbed by a larger non-tropical cyclone on Saturday or Saturday night
- This is the last public advisory issued by the National Hurricane Center

Hazards Affecting Land:

 Swells will affect portions of the southeastern U.S. coast today; likely to cause life-threatening surf and rip current conditions will affect portions of the southeastern U.S. coast today





Post-Tropical Storm Eta – FINAL



<u>Situation</u>: Expected to accelerate over the western Atlantic and move parallel to, but offshore of the Carolinas today. Lifelines are stable throughout the impacted areas.

Lifeline Impacts: (Source: Region IV Status Update 6 as of 4:54 p.m. ET)

Safety & Security:

- All evacuations lifted
- All county schools and government offices have re-opened

Food, Water, & Sheltering:

All shelters have closed

Health & Medical:

1 confirmed fatality

Energy:

6,700 (-44k) (less than 1%) customers without power (DOE Eagle-I as of 5:45 a.m.)

Transportation:


- Tampa and Sarasota-Bradenton International Airports re-opened
- Sunshine Skyway Bridge re-opened
- Ports of Tampa, Manatee, and St. Petersburg open with no restrictions

State/Local Preparations and Response:

FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19 & TS Eta); Gov declared State of Emergency

FEMA/Federal Preparations and Response:

- NWC Monitoring; NRCC at Level III (COVID-19)
- Region IV RWC is monitoring
- FEMA-3551-EM-FL Approved Nov 11
- No additional requests for federal assistance





COVID-19 Update

<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 52 (+2) states/territories, with 1 (-1) jurisdiction in a plateau status, and 2 (-1) jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,240 (-1) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 12)

Nationwide Testing: 160,684,177 (+2,896,054) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 12)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 12)

United States: 10,314,254 (+277,891)

o Worldwide: 51,848,261 (+1,172,189)




FEMA Response:

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring







National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall








