

Situation:

- The fire began on Nov 17 and is burning on state and private land in and around the communities of Caughlin Ranch, Skyline, and Riverview in the Reno metro area (pop 20k)
- The fire is also threatening high voltage powerlines, telecom infrastructure, and the Galena watershed in the area

Response:

- FMAG approved Nov 17
- NV EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- Region IX IMAT-2 deployed to Mather, CA for Wildfires
- Region IX RWC and NWC continue to monitor






Tropical Depression Iota – Atlantic

Situation: (Advisory #20 as of 4:00 a.m. ET)

- 20 miles NW of El Papalon, El Salvador
- Moving WSW at 13 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- All watches and warnings have been cancelled
- Forecast to continue to weaken into a remnant low today






Tropical Outlook - Five Day

No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days. 2:00 am HST ed Nov 18 2020


Eastern Pacific

Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- Could form in a few days over the southwestern Caribbean Sea

- 5-day Formation chance: Low (20%)


Disturbance 2 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- Could form between the Bahamas and Bermuda

National Weather Forecast










Hazards Outlook - Nov 20-24





