




Nationwide Testing: 171,739,267 (+616,762) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 20)

  - Worldwide: 1,355,963 (+11,960)


#### FEMA Response:

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring









#### **Severe Weather Outlook**






#### **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**




