- Rain and thunderstorms – Southeast, Tennessee/Ohio valleys
- Localized Heavy Rain possible – Hawaiian Islands

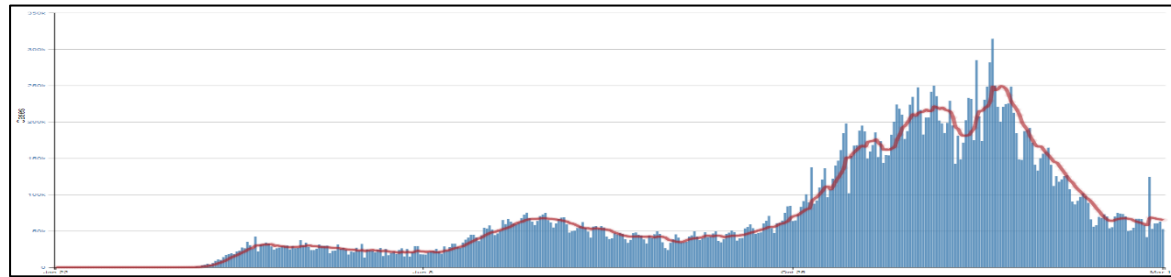

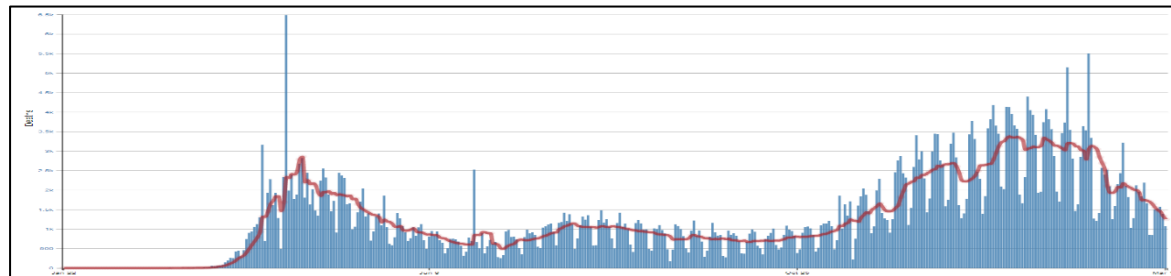

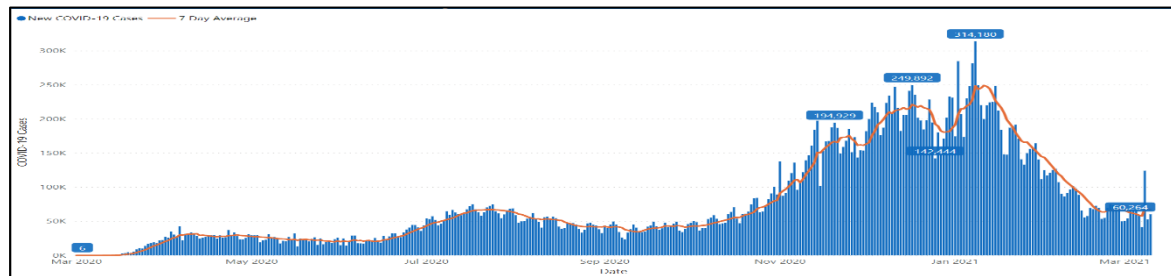
COVID-19 Weekly Update *(CDC data, as of March 14)*



Daily Trends of COVID-19 Cases



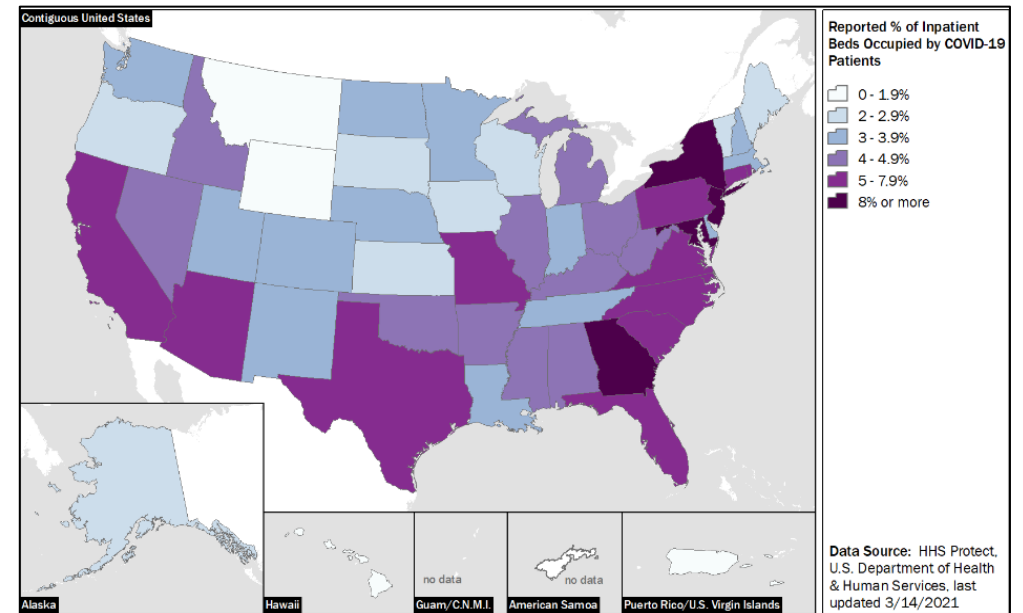
Daily Trends of COVID-19 Deaths



National Inpatient Beds Used – COVID-19 Patients

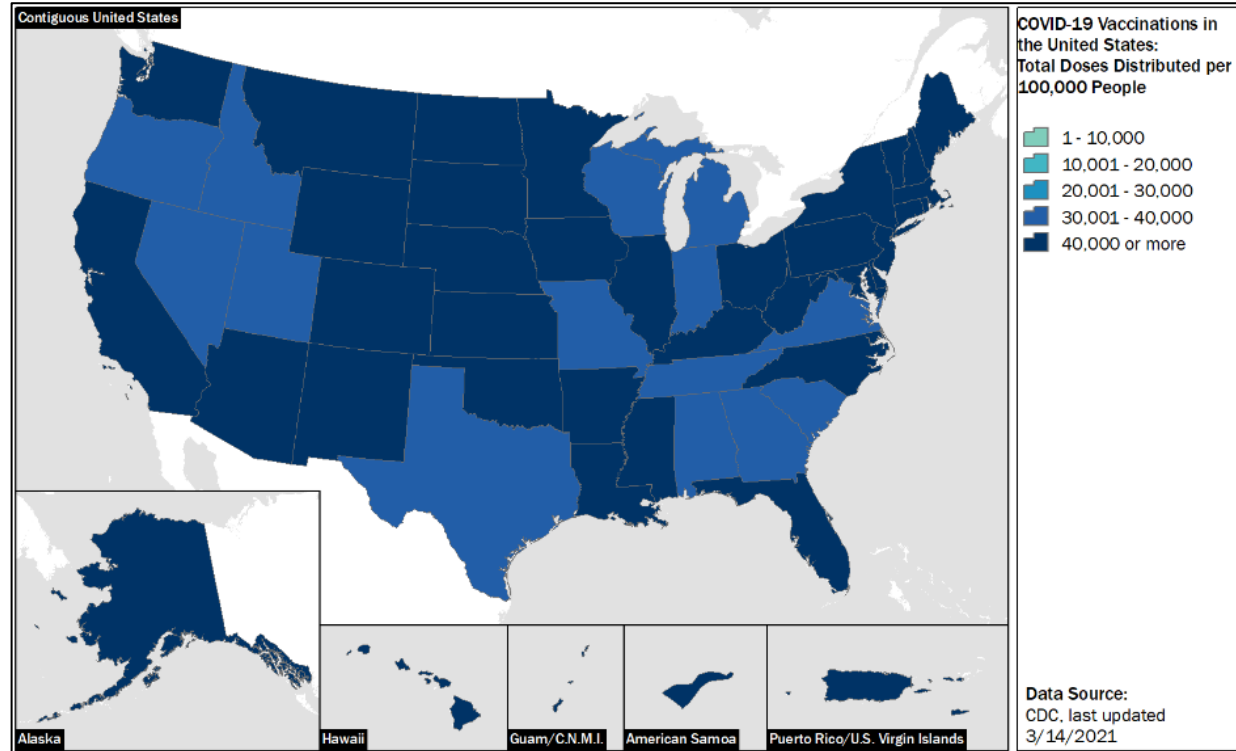
Key Updates:

 - Confirmed Cases: **29,229,162 (+457,413)**
 - Confirmed Deaths: **531,766 (+8,793)**
- Major Disaster Declarations: 58 Emergency Declarations: 43
- Public Assistance obligated for COVID-19 Response: **\$16 billion (+1M)**
- FEMA NRCC activated to Level I in support of COVID-19 operations



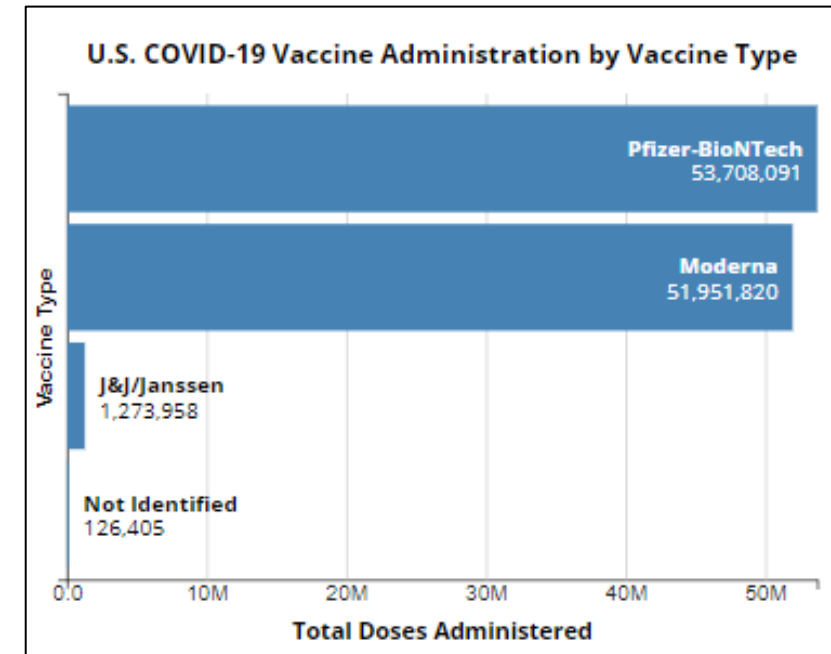

COVID-19 Vaccine Weekly Update *(CDC data, as of March 14)*



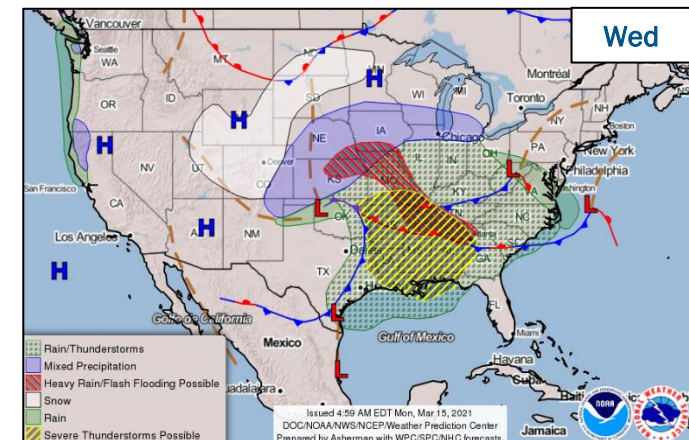
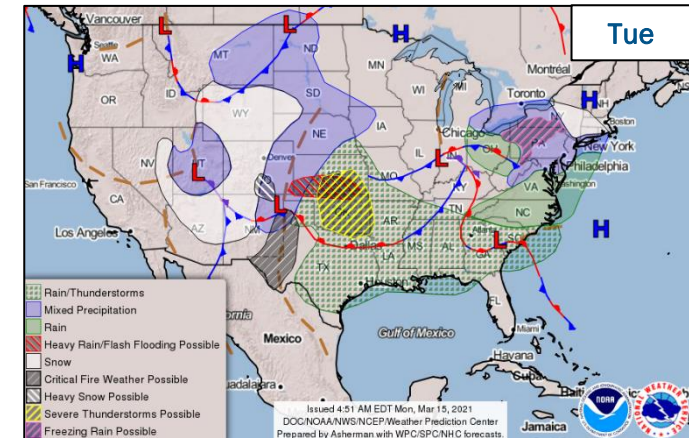
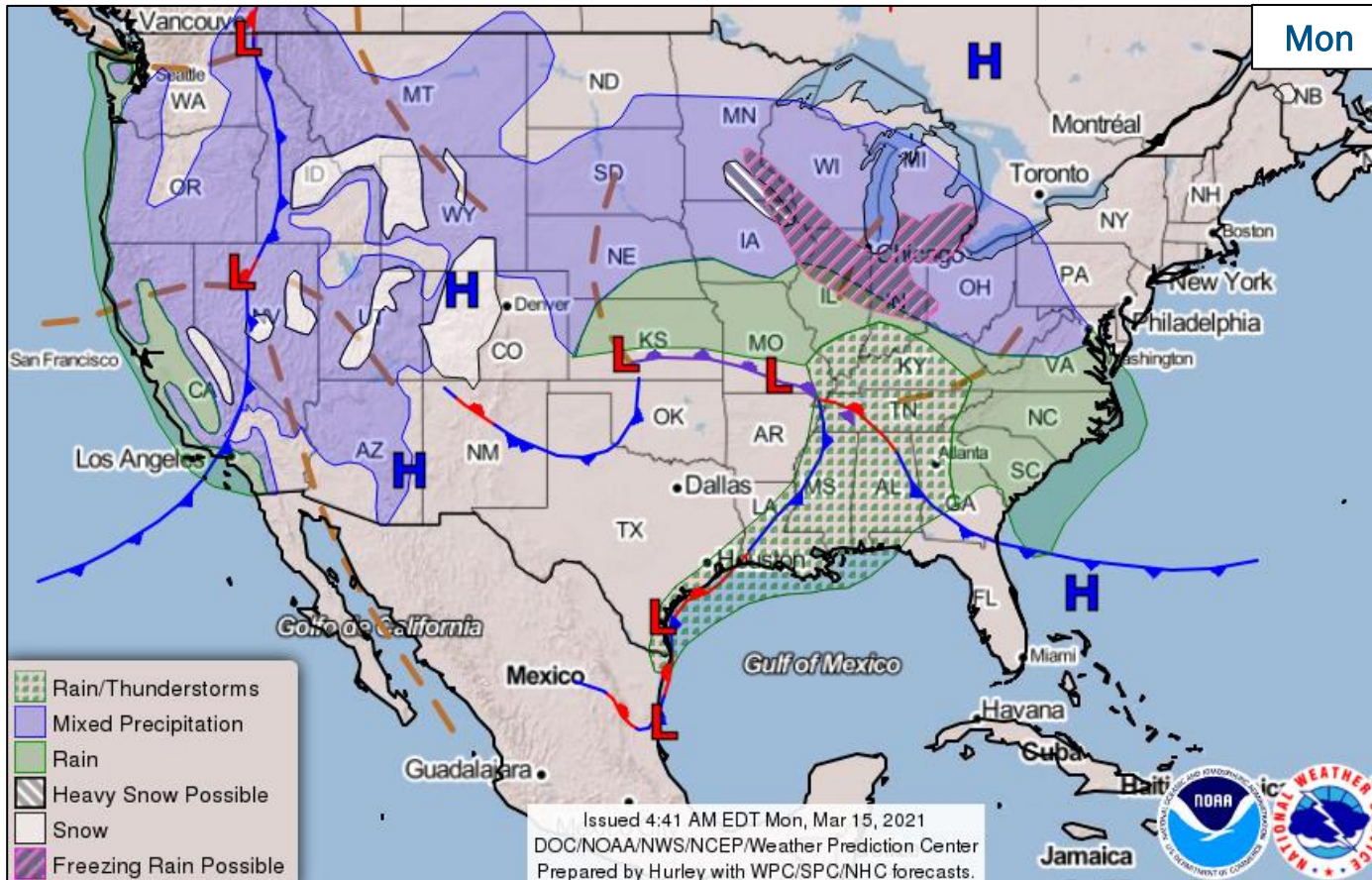

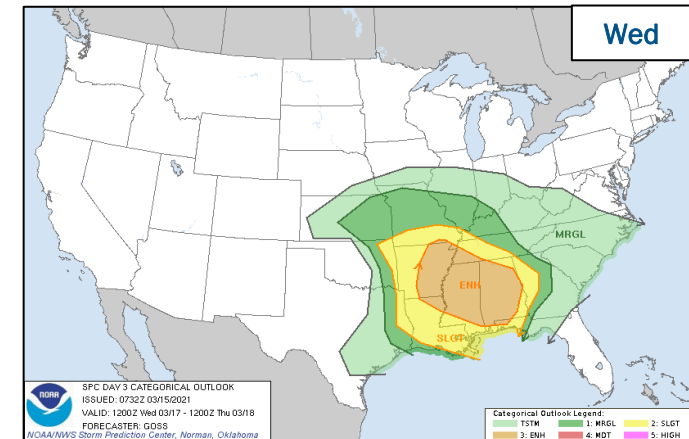

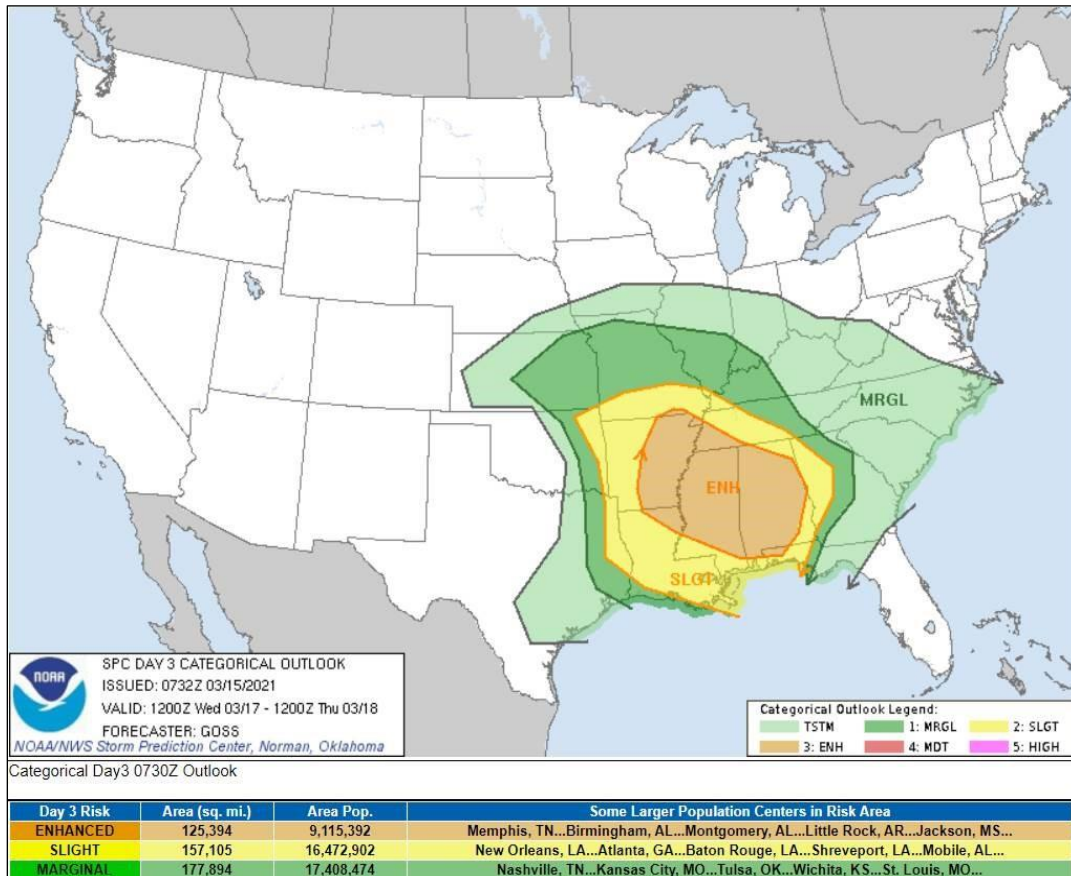
Severe Weather Outlook



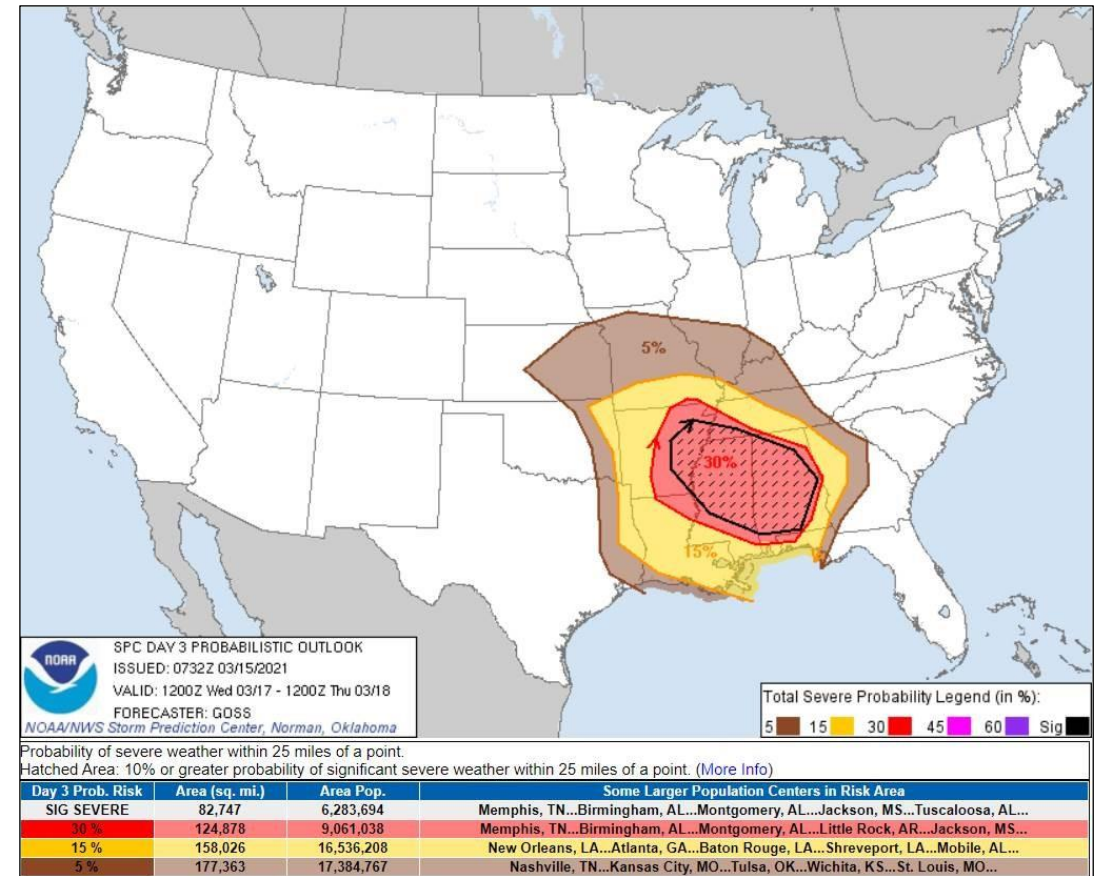

Categorical Outlook



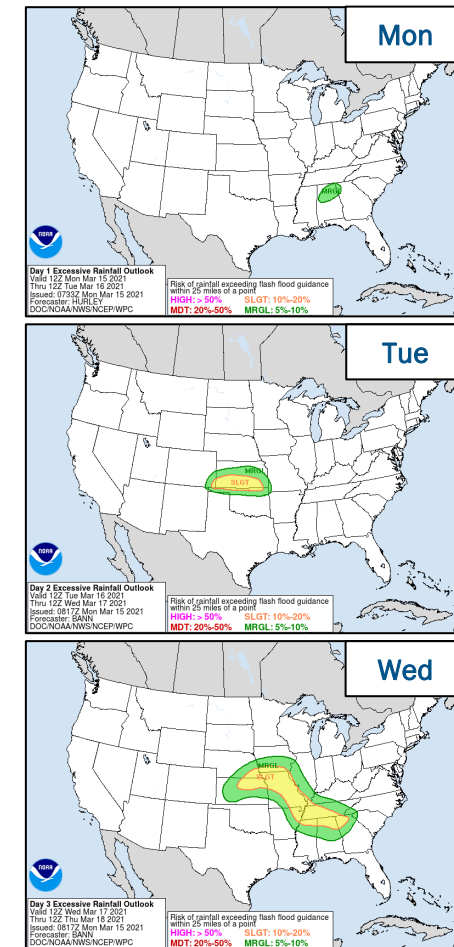
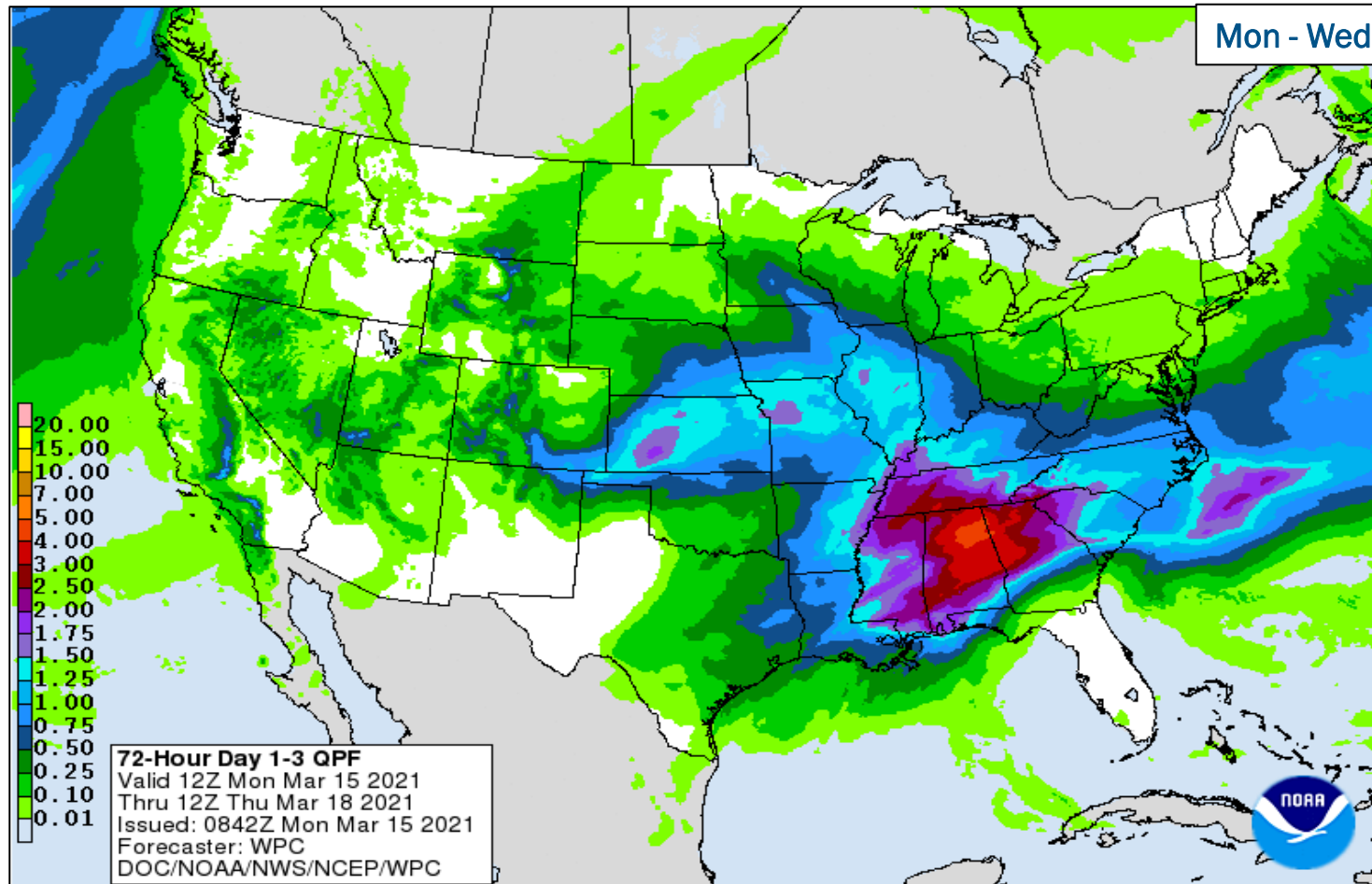

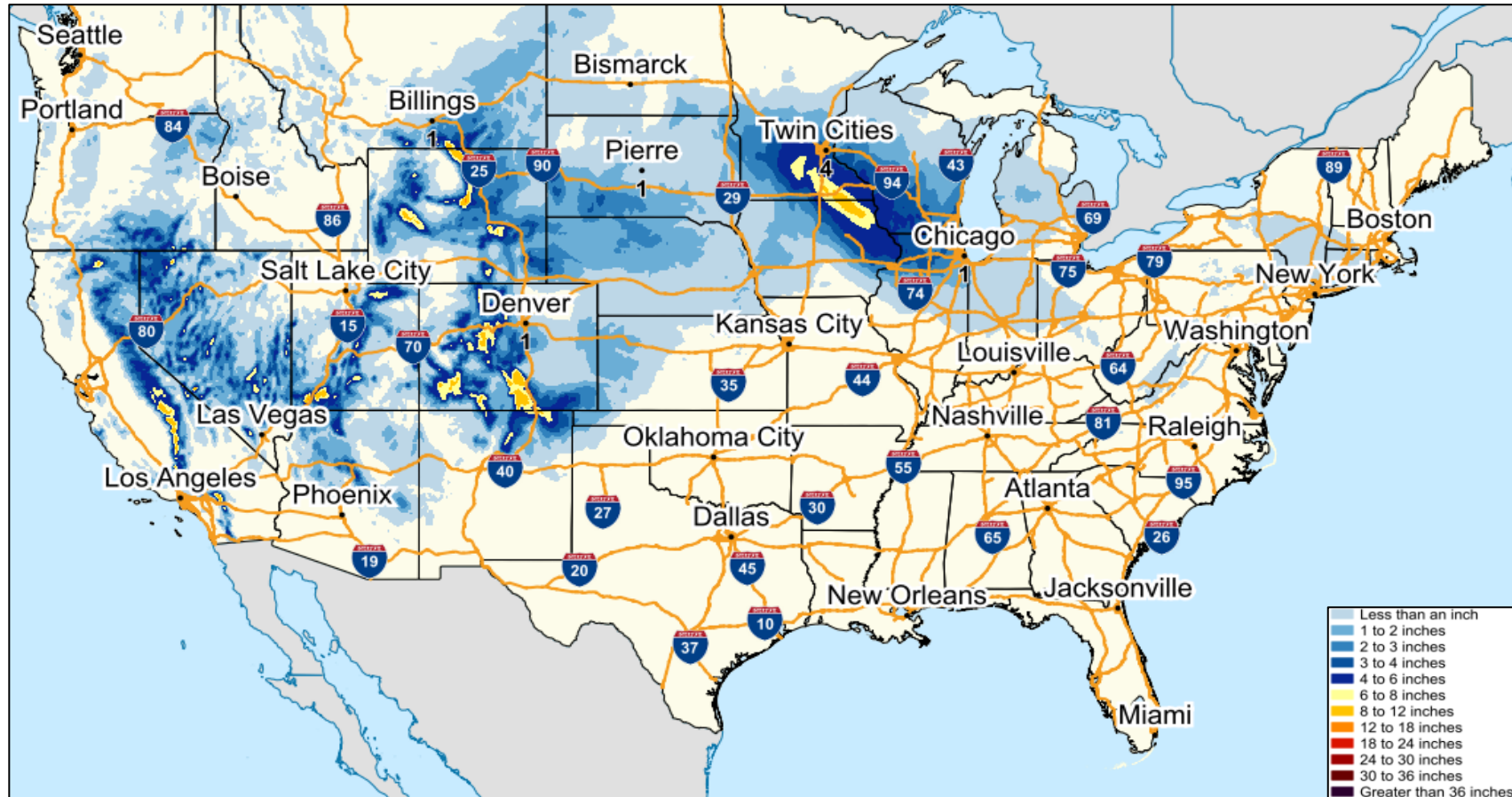

Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



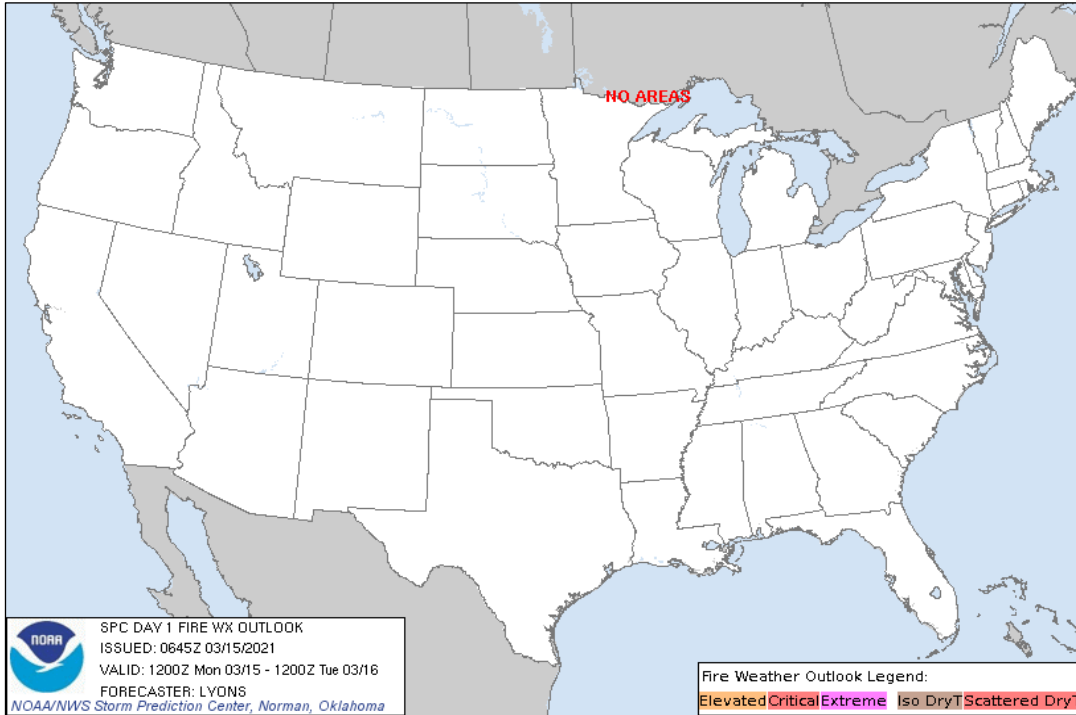

Forecast Snowfall

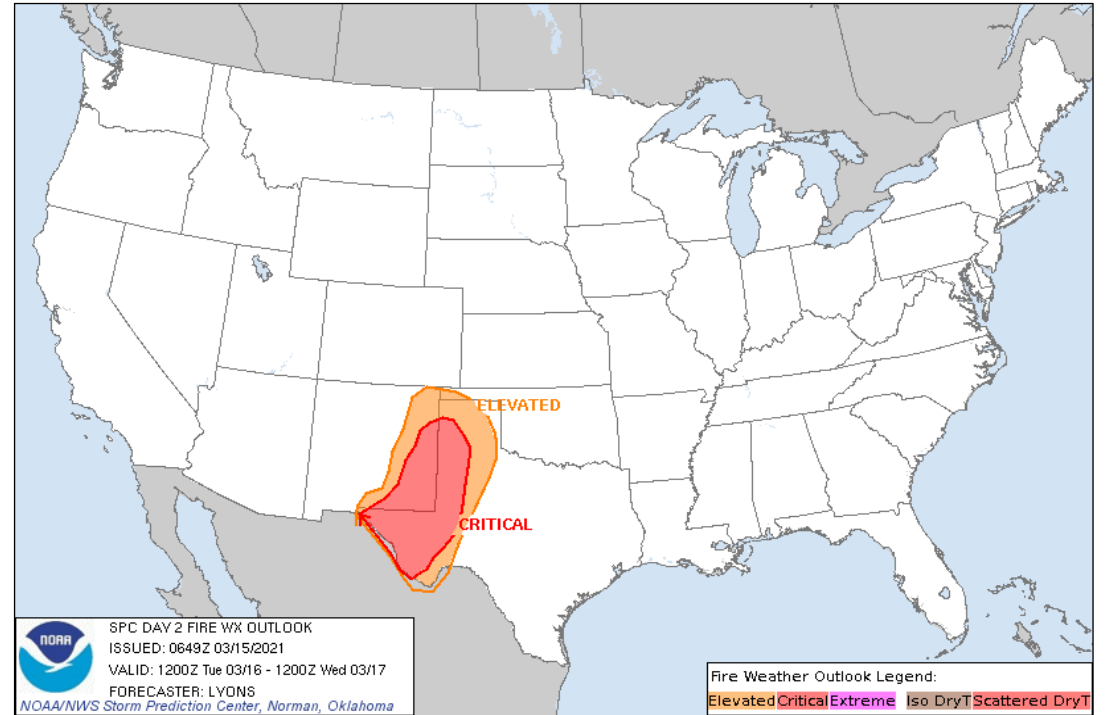

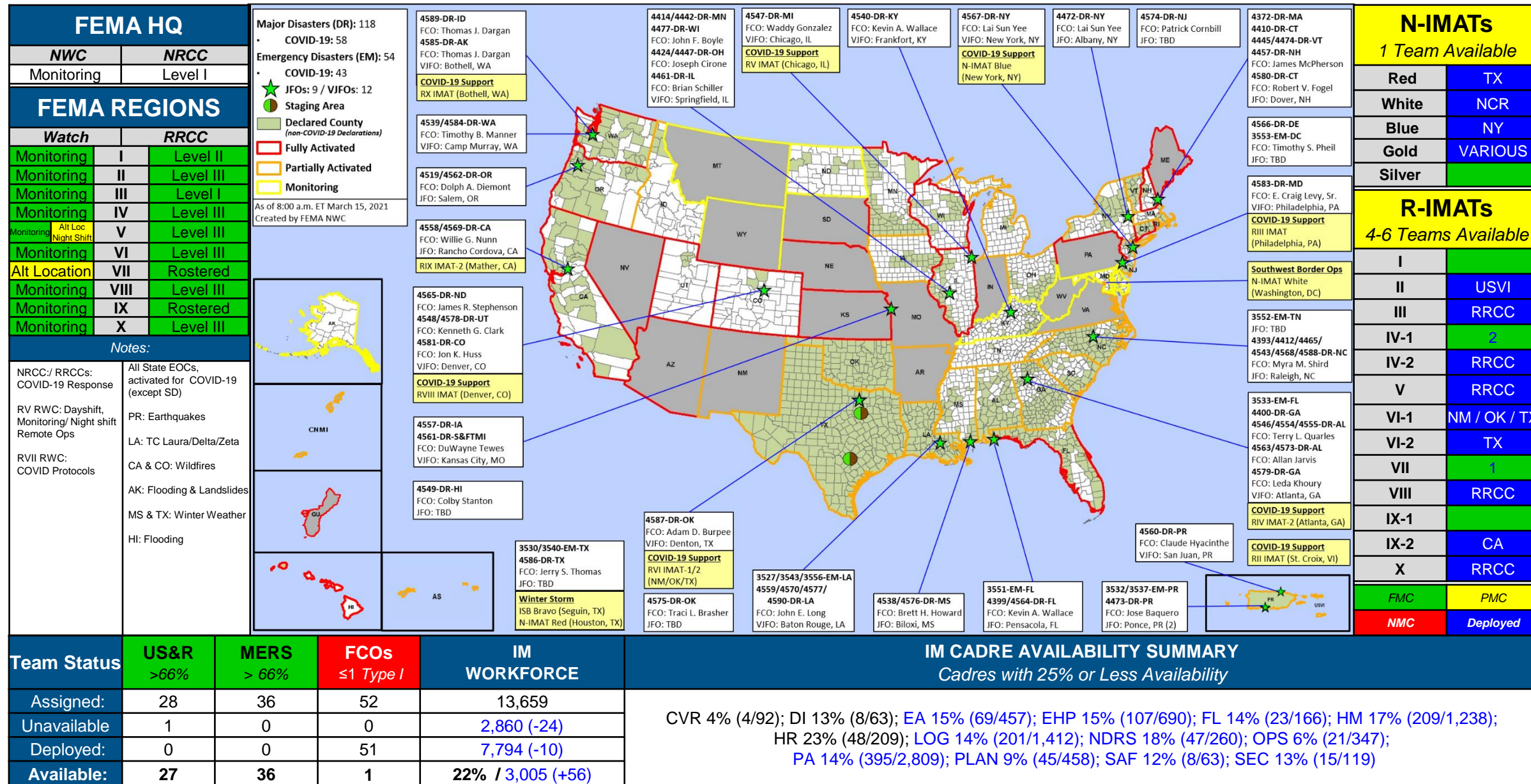
