




Daily Trends of COVID-19 Cases



Daily Trends of COVID-19 Deaths



- FEMA NRCC activated to Level III in support of COVID-19 operations








Tropical Outlook - Five Day







Post-Tropical Cyclone Ana – Atlantic


Post-Tropical Cyclone Ana (Advisory #8 as of 11:00 p.m. ET) - FINAL


- 680 miles NE of Bermuda











Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Long Range Outlooks - May 29 - Jun 2



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability






