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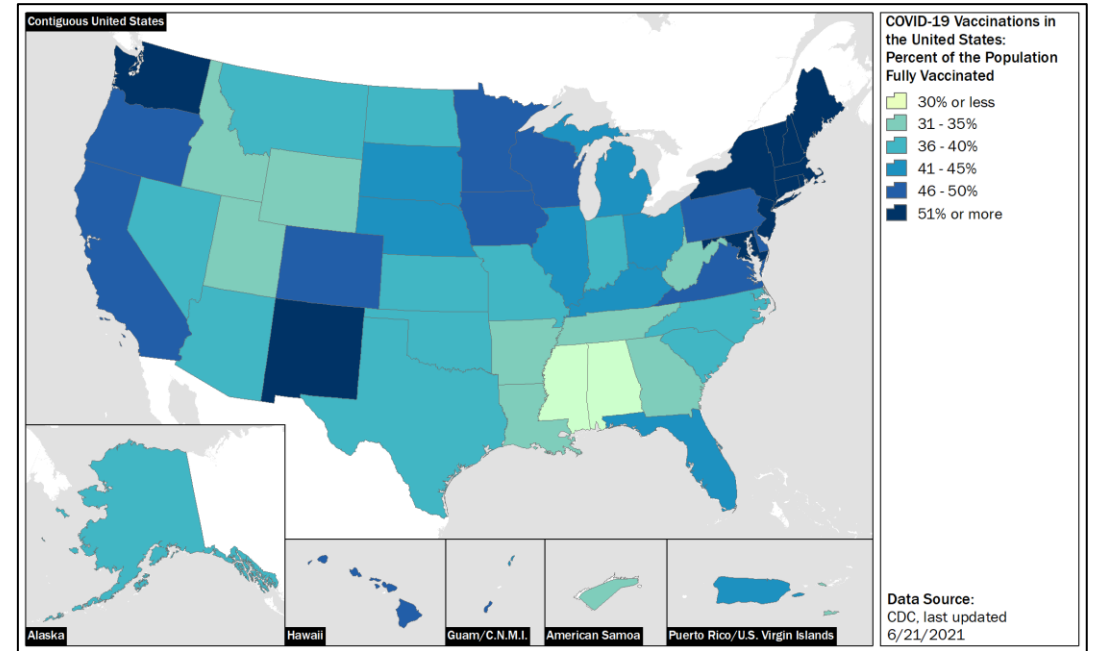
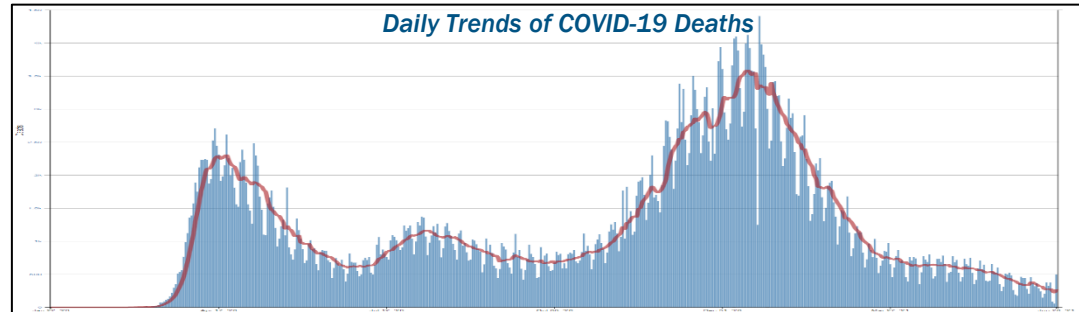
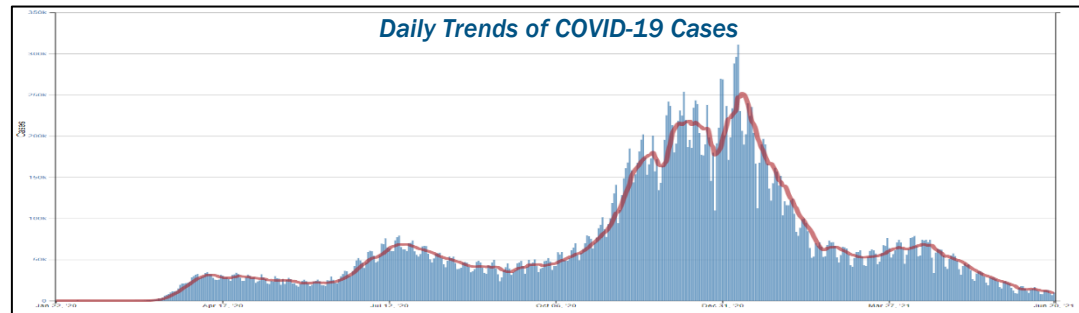
# COVID-19 Weekly Update *(CDC data, as of Jun 21)*

- Confirmed US COVID-19 Cases: 33,368,860 (+76,815)
- Confirmed US COVID-19 Deaths: 599,354 (+2,011)
- Total vaccine doses administered: 318,576,441 (+7,930,614)
- People fully vaccinated: 150,046,006 (+5,126,667)

- Federally-Supported Sites (CVCs): 1,732 (+32)
- Public Assistance obligated for COVID-19 Response: \$28 (+1B) billion
- FEMA NRCC activated to Level III in support of COVID-19 operations

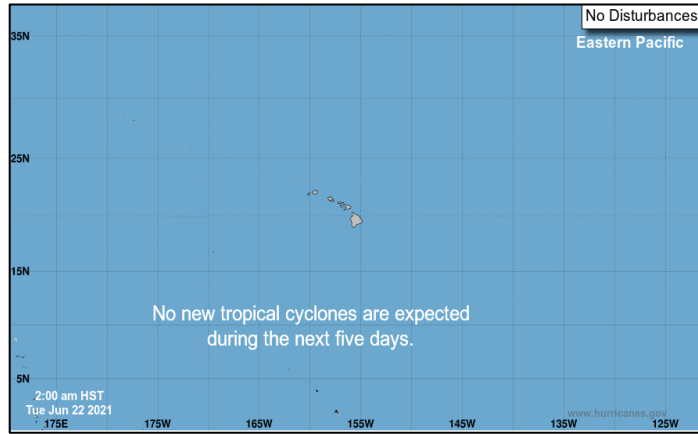


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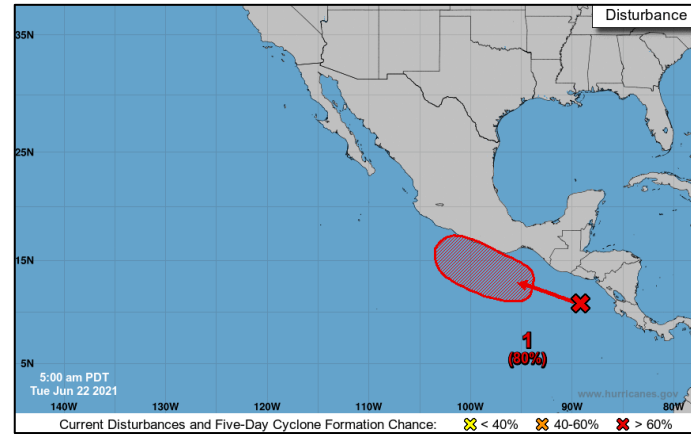

## Central Pacific



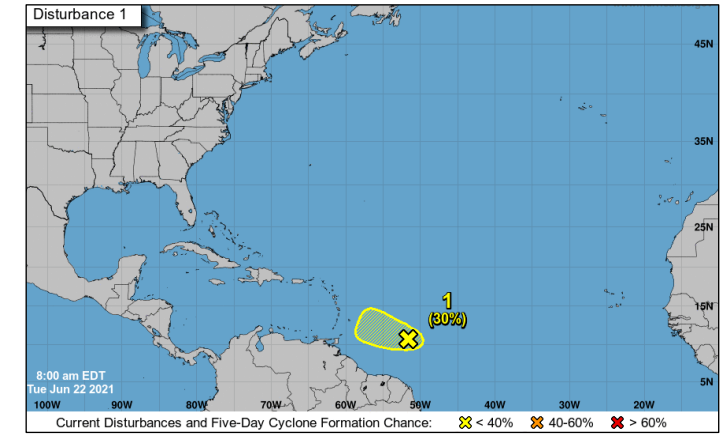
## Eastern Pacific



### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Over Central America and the far eastern Pacific
- Tropical depression is likely to form late this week or this weekend as it moves WNW near the southern coast of Mexico
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day formation chance: High (80%)

## Atlantic



### Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 500 miles E of the Windward Islands
- Expected to move W to WNW at 15-20 mph
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (30%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (30%)

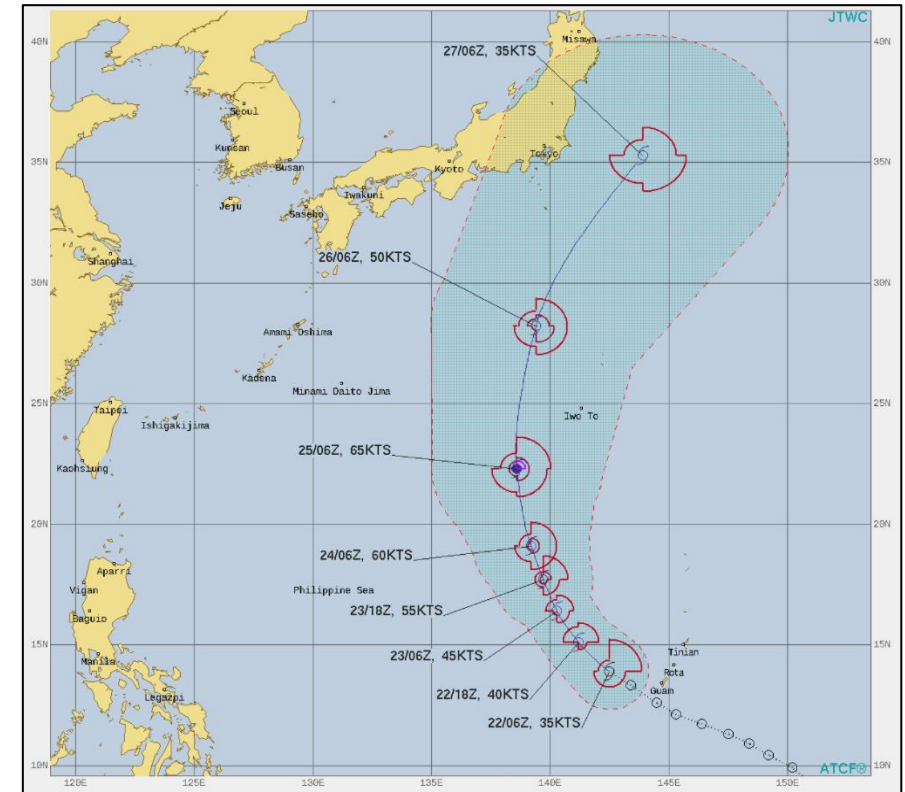


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# Tropical Storm 06W– Western Pacific

## Tropical Storm 06W (Advisory #6 of 5:00 a.m. ET) - FINAL

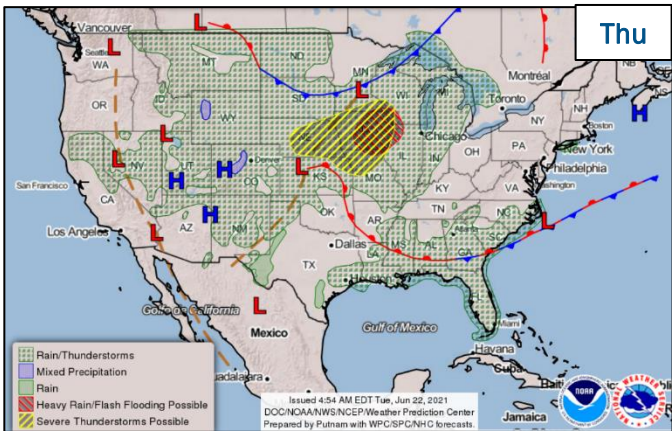
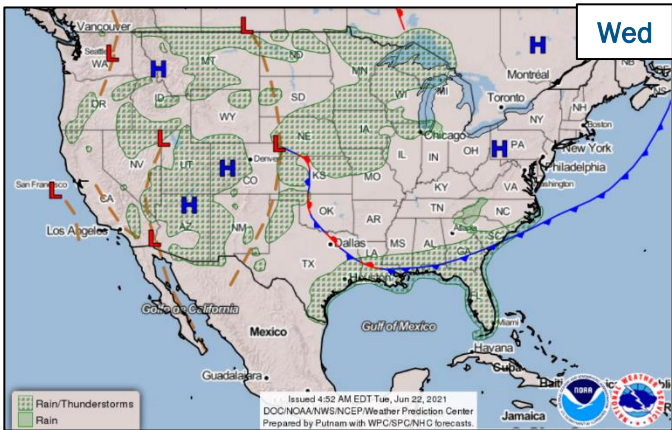
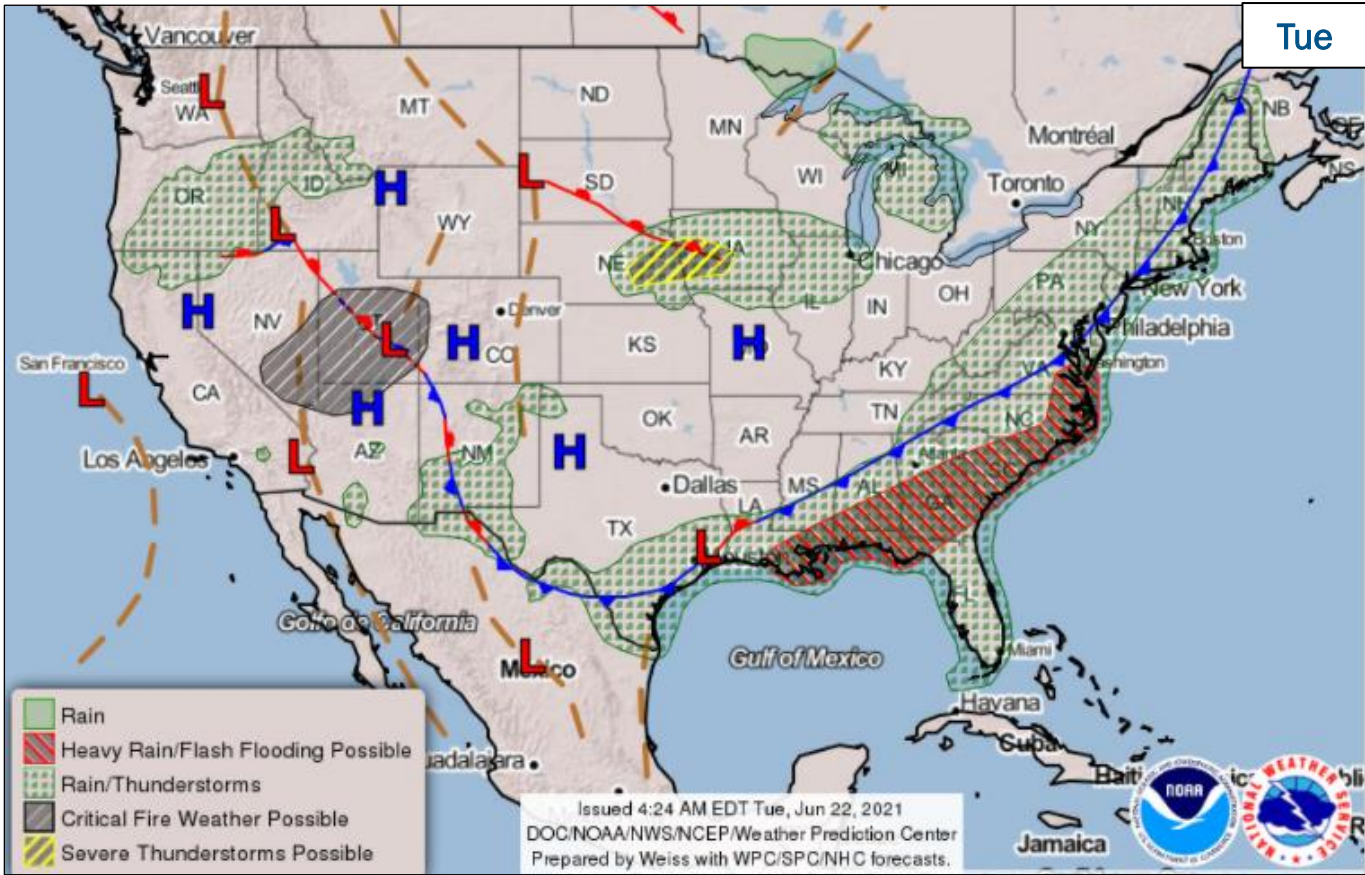
- 180 miles WNW of Guam
- Moving NW at 13 mph, away from the Marianas
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 90 miles
- Tropical cyclone watches and warnings have been discontinued for Guam
- No longer expected to pose any direct threats to the islands



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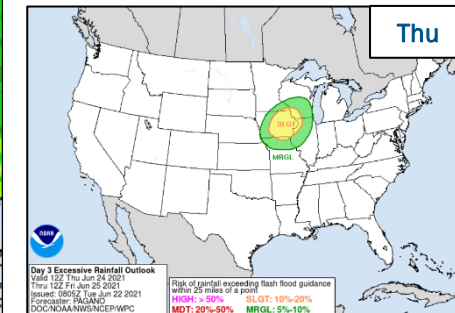
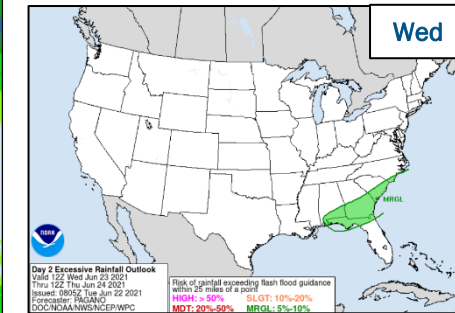
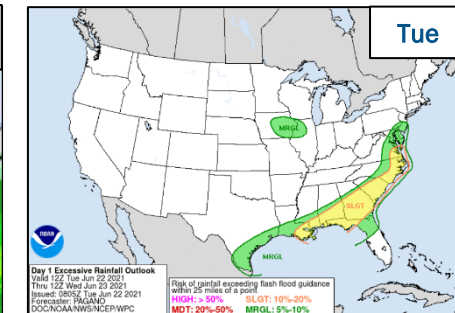
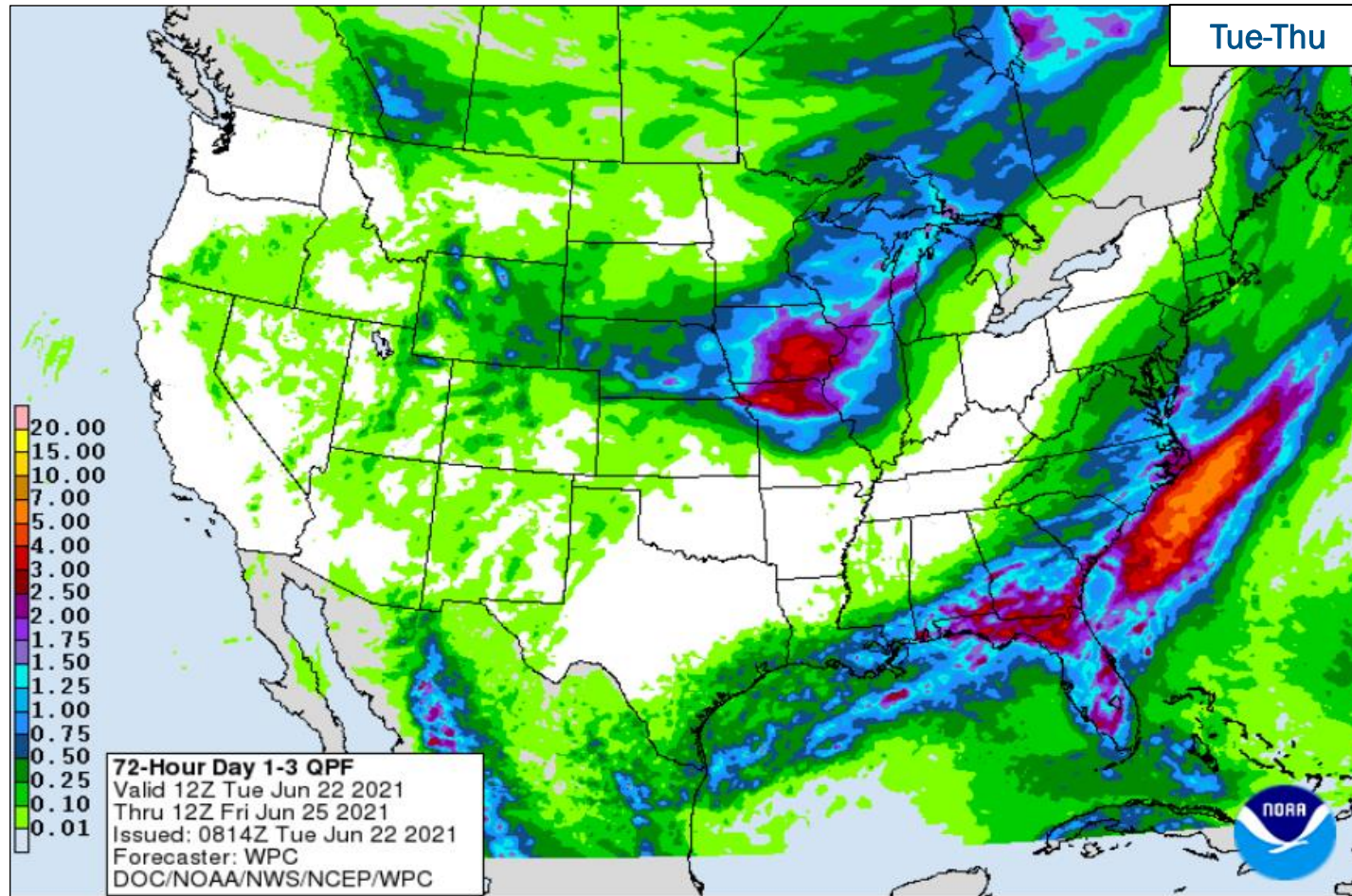

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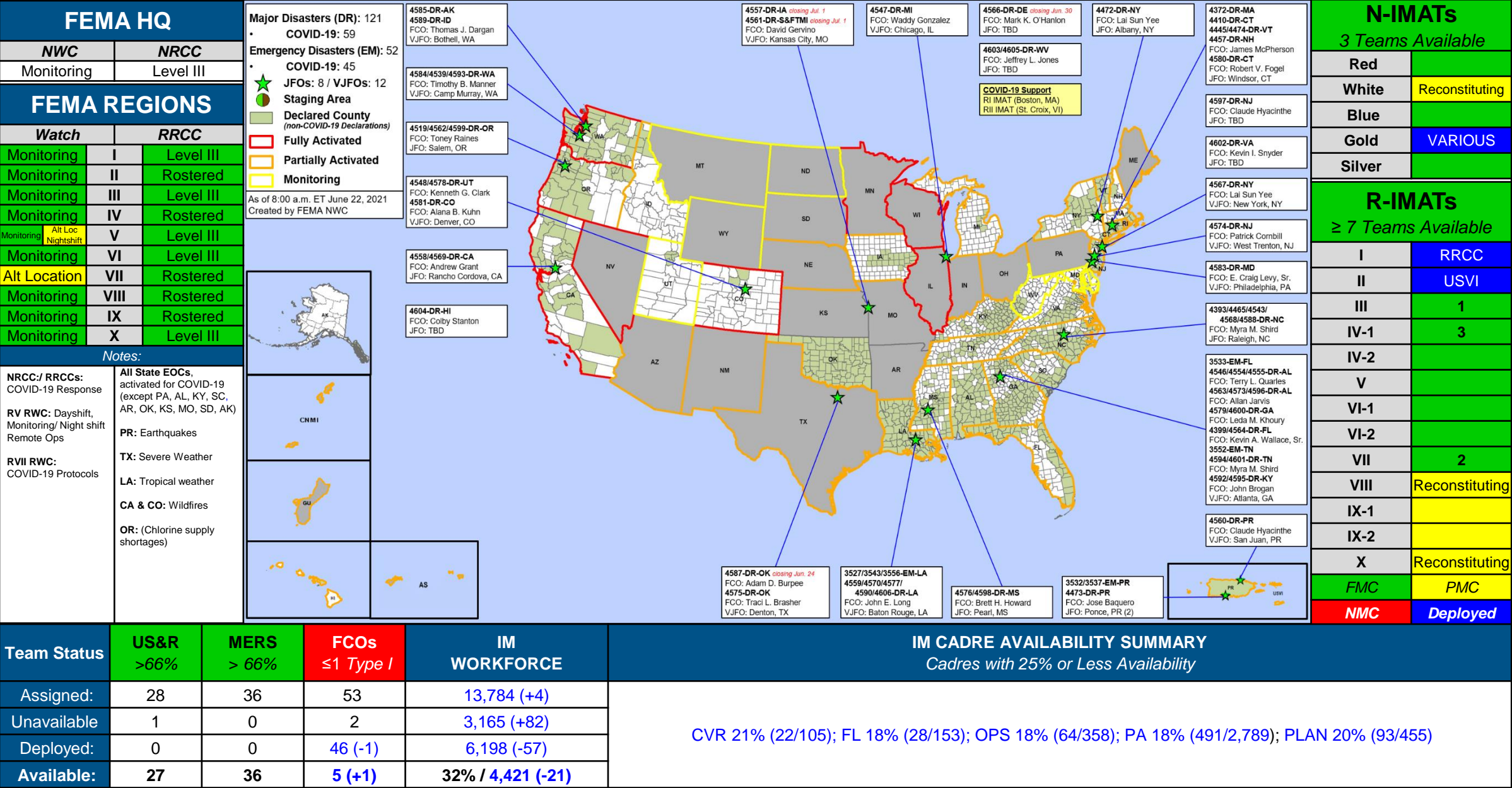

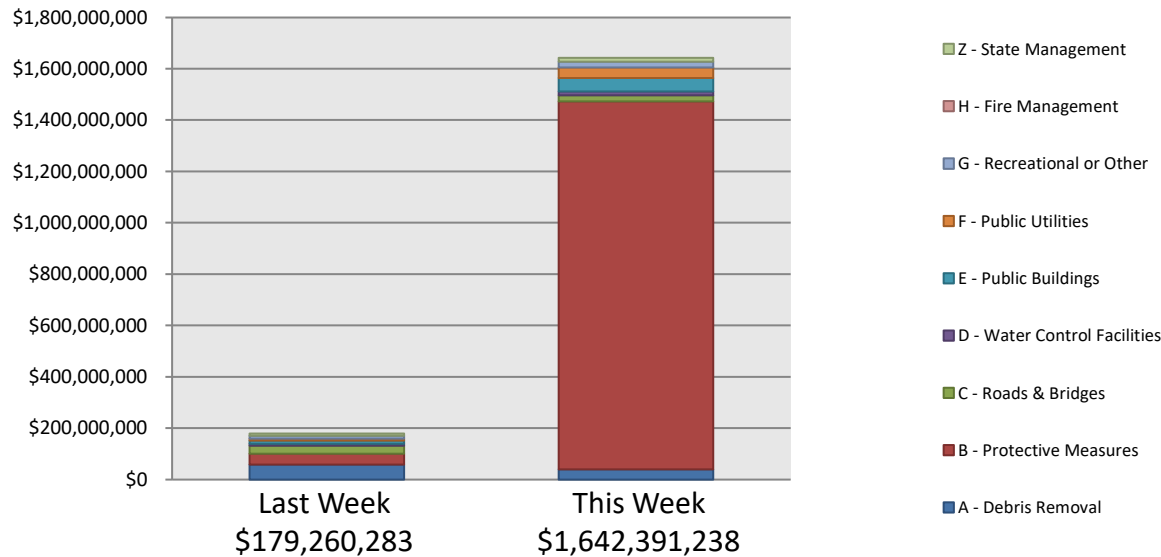

States with Currently Occupied Units

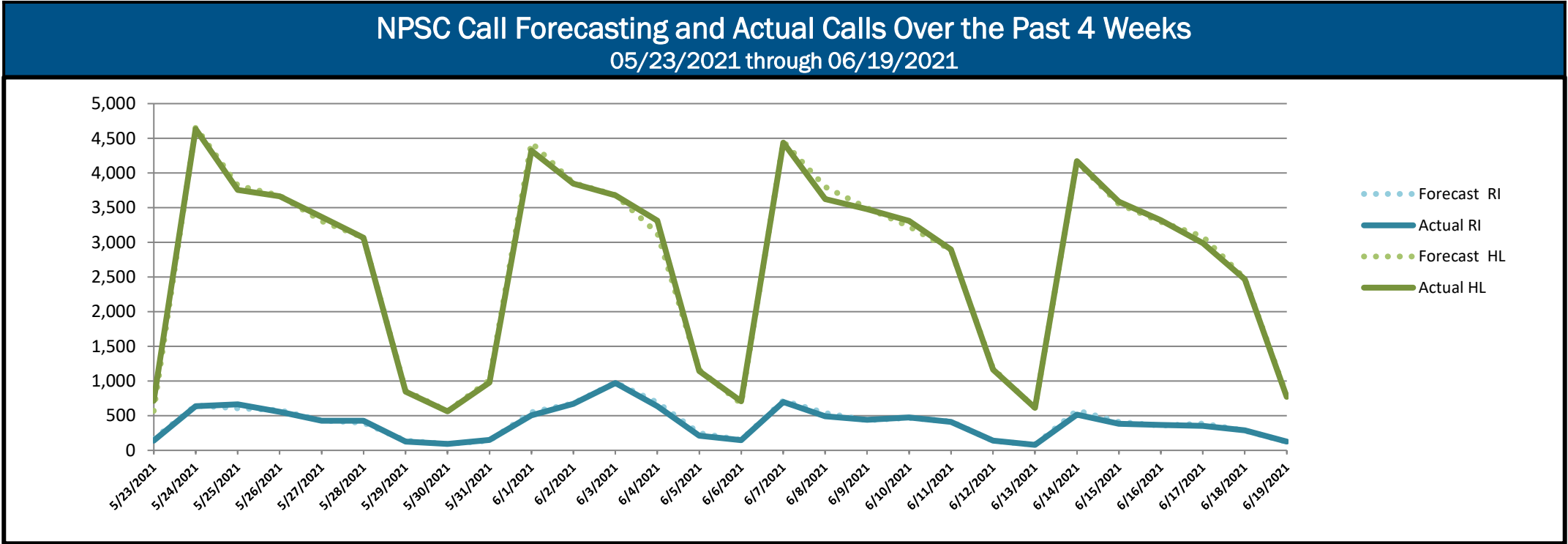


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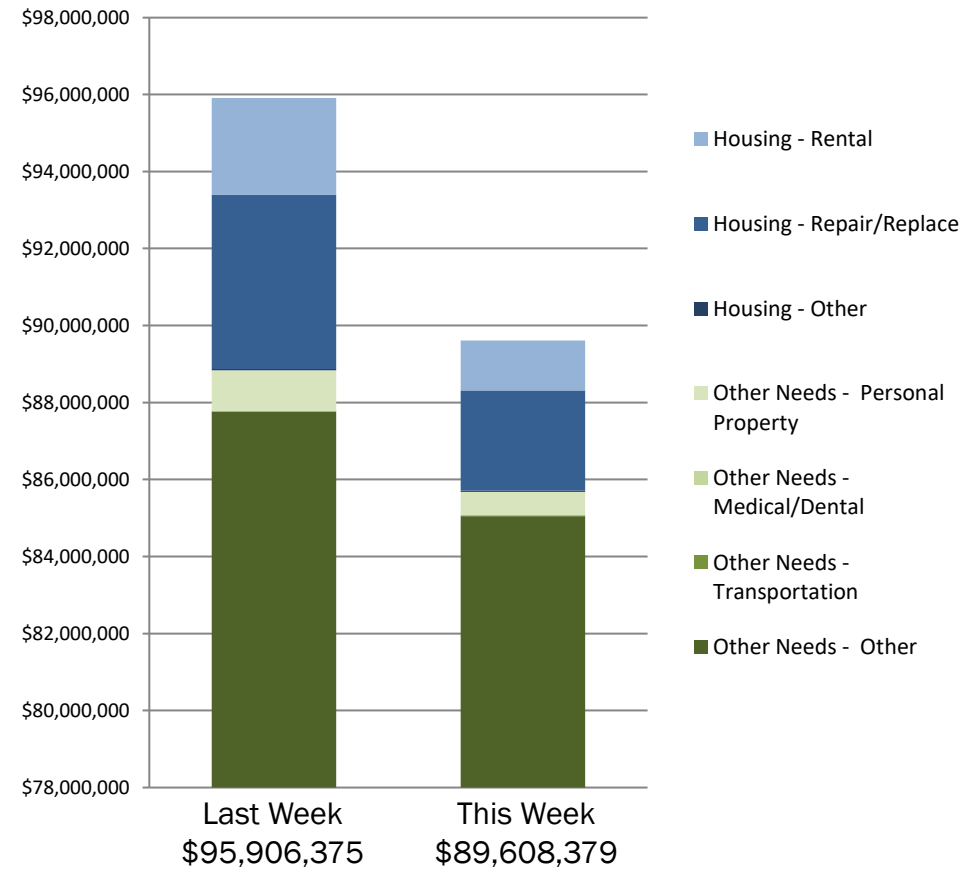
