




## 5 DAY RAINFALL








## FLASH FLOOD RISK valid through 8 AM EDT Thursday





### **Hurricane Milton (CAT-3) – Florida**



Situation: Milton is strengthening in the Gulf of Mexico moving E toward the coast of Florida. FEMA is prestaging resources in coordination with Florida emergency management.

### Lifelines: (TC Helene SLB, as of 6:42 p.m. ET, Oct 6)

### Food, Hydration, Shelter:

- FL: 14 shelters / 429 occupants (Helene)
- o 70 food distribution sites/15 food banks operational/1.2M meals received by the state Water Systems:
- FL: 18 Active Boil Water Notices; assessments and restoration continues (Helene)

### State / Tribal Response:

- FL: SEOC at Full Activation (TC Helene)
- Gov declared State of Emergency for 51 counties

### **FEMA / Federal Response:**

- FEMA RIV: RRCC activated to Level II with all ESFs (will activate to Level 1 tomorrow)
- IMAT-2 deployed to FL SEOC
- NWC is Monitoring; NRCC is at Level I (TC Helene and TC Milton)



Situation: Locally executed, state managed, and federally supported operations continue.

### Safety & Security:


- GA: 12 curfews remain in effect for Richmond counties
- NC: Unified local, state, and federal US&R operations ongoing in impact areas with landslides complicating response and recovery efforts; curfews remain in place
- SC: US&R missions have been completed and federal resources are redirecting to North Carolina

Food, Hydration, Shelter: (ARC, as of 7:50 a.m. ET, Oct 6)

- FL: State is monitoring shelter population; commodity needs are being met
- GA: 8 shelters / 448 occupants
  - 3.5M meals/1.4M liters of water received by the state
- NC: 22 shelters / 825 occupants
  - 7M (+2) meals/9.3M (+1.8) liters of water received by the state
- SC: 7 shelters / 81 occupants
  - o 28k meals and 688k liters of water received by the state
- TN: 4 shelters / 56 (-9) occupants

#### Health & Medical:

- GA: All hospitals have returned to normal power and normal water systems; 33 confirmed fatalities
- NC: Federal medical support staff continue to support with patient encounters, hospital decompression, and fatality management; 76 (+6) confirmed fatalities



#### Water Systems:

- FL: Water infrastructure restoration continues
- GA: 330 Active boil water notices; boil water notices are decreasing as systems resume full operation
- NC: Service restoration efforts continue for water and wastewater systems as power is restored; 96 active boil water notices
- SC: Significant improvement to public water infrastructure
- TN: Water infrastructure restoration continues; 18 active boil water notice advisories
- VA: Wastewater treatment plants in VDEM Regions disrupted; 21 (-3) active boil water advisories

### Energy: (DOE Eagle-I, as of 7:50 a.m. ET, Oct 7)

- o GA: 75k (-42k) (2%) customers without power
- o NC: 137k (-6k) (3%) customers without power
- o SC: 55k (-62k) (3%) customers without power

#### Communications:

- GA: Power restoration efforts are ongoing with fiber and internet disruptions remaining across the state
- NC: 2 counties with cell sites with 50% plus sites down; 11 of 241 comms towers operating on generator power
- TN: Communication equipment and support augmentation remain in place

### **Transportation:**

- GA: All primary roads are cleared, and secondary roads are improving
- NC: Significant road closures continue with potential impacts to highways due to landslide threat
- TN: I-40, I-26, and 7 US/state routes remain closed; 30 of the 49 state routes originally closed are reopened
- VA: Recovery efforts are ongoing




