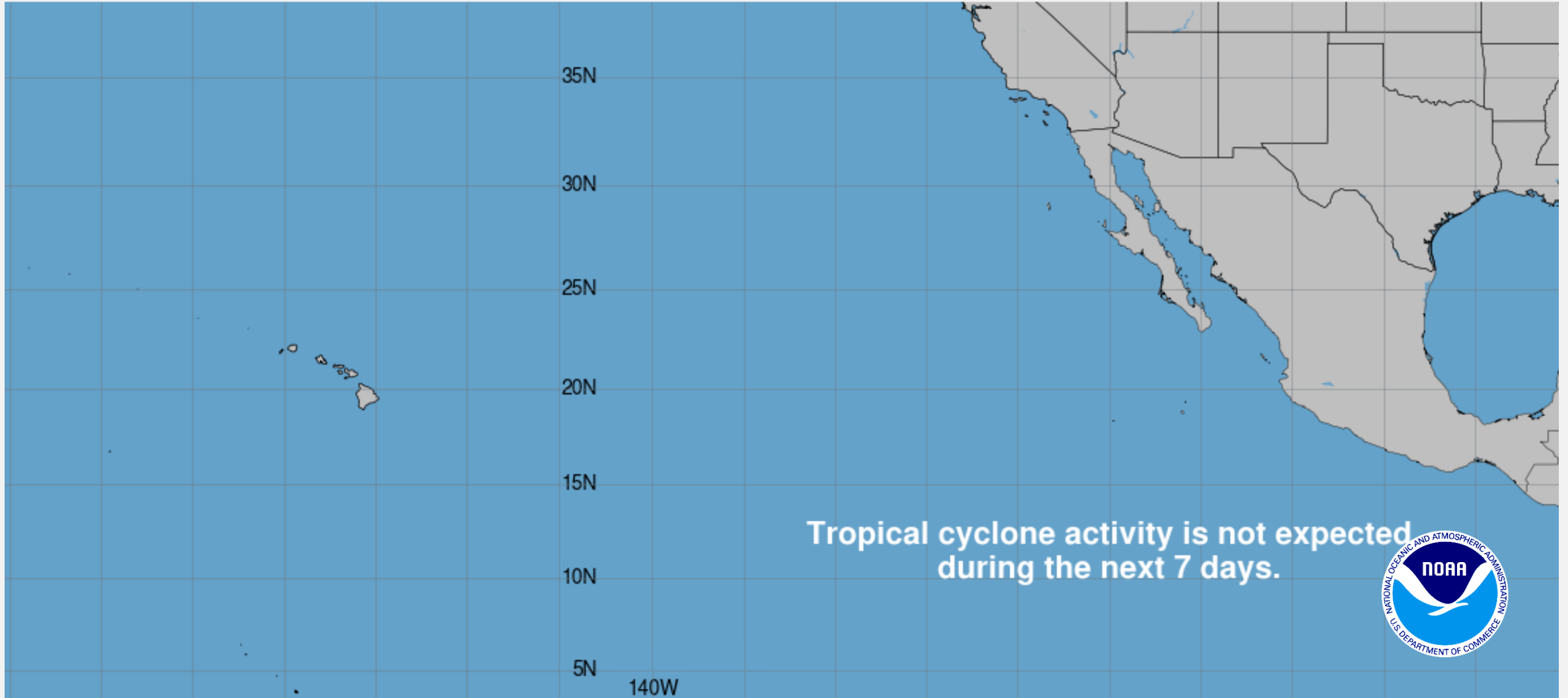

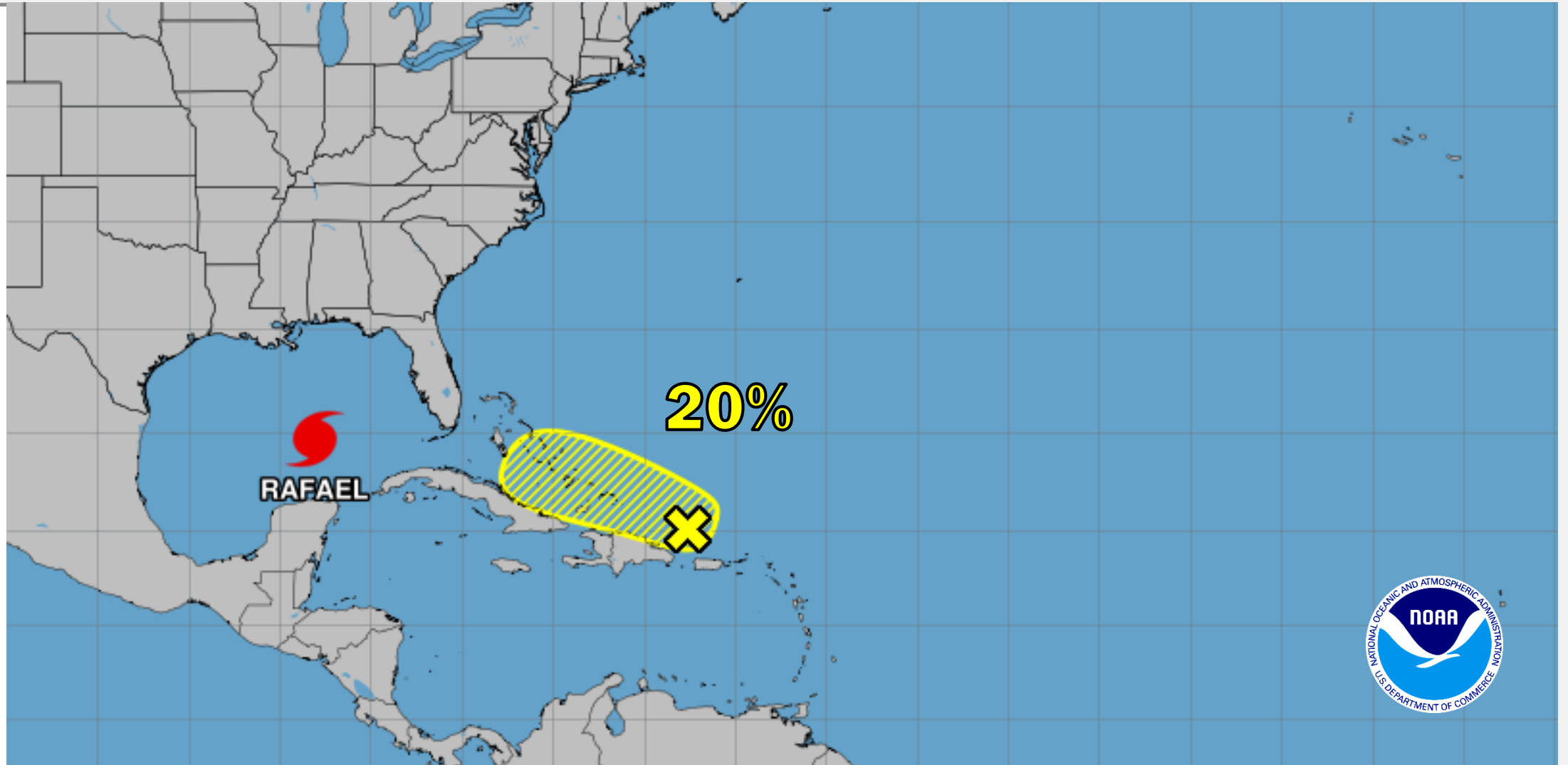

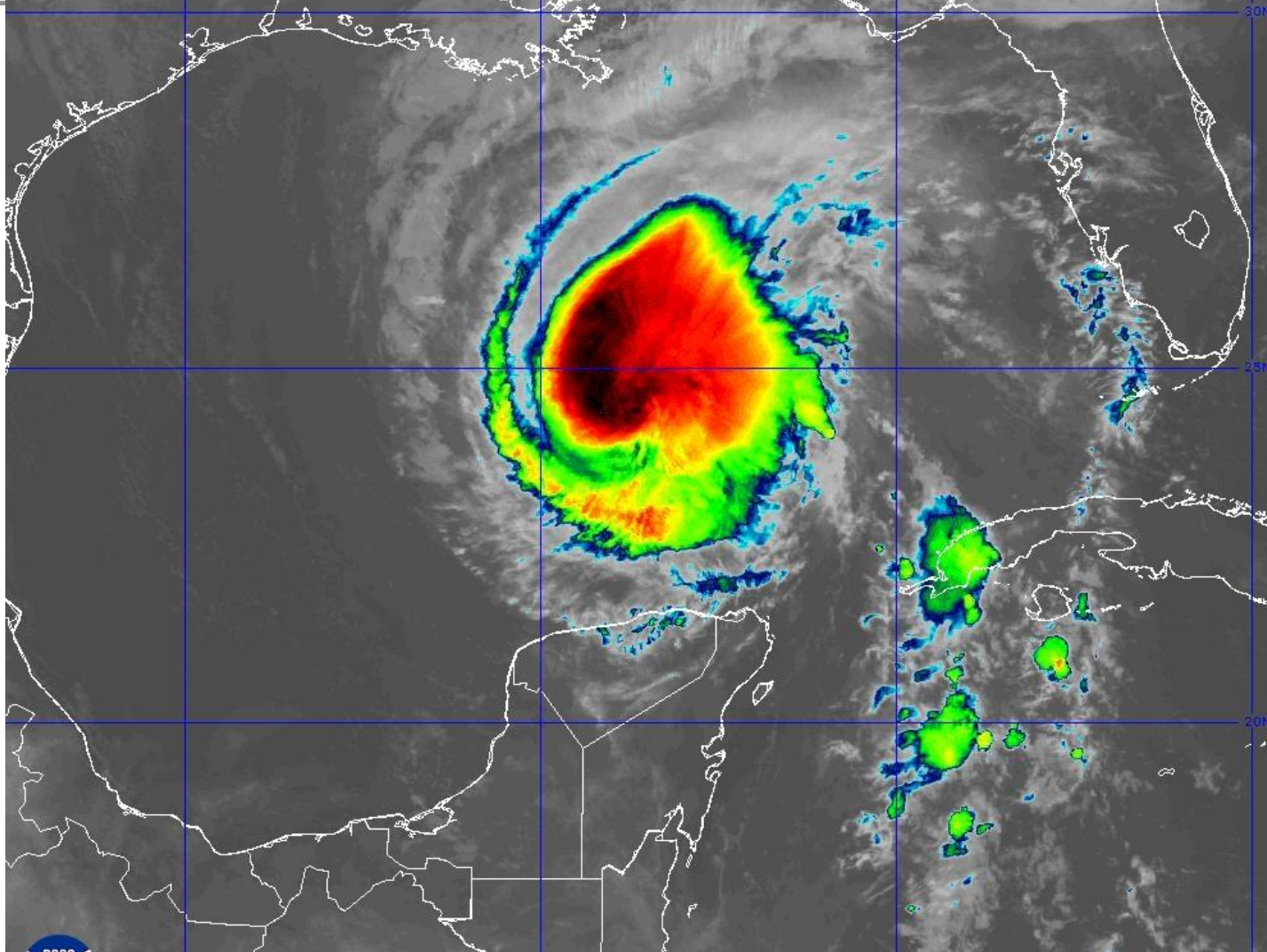

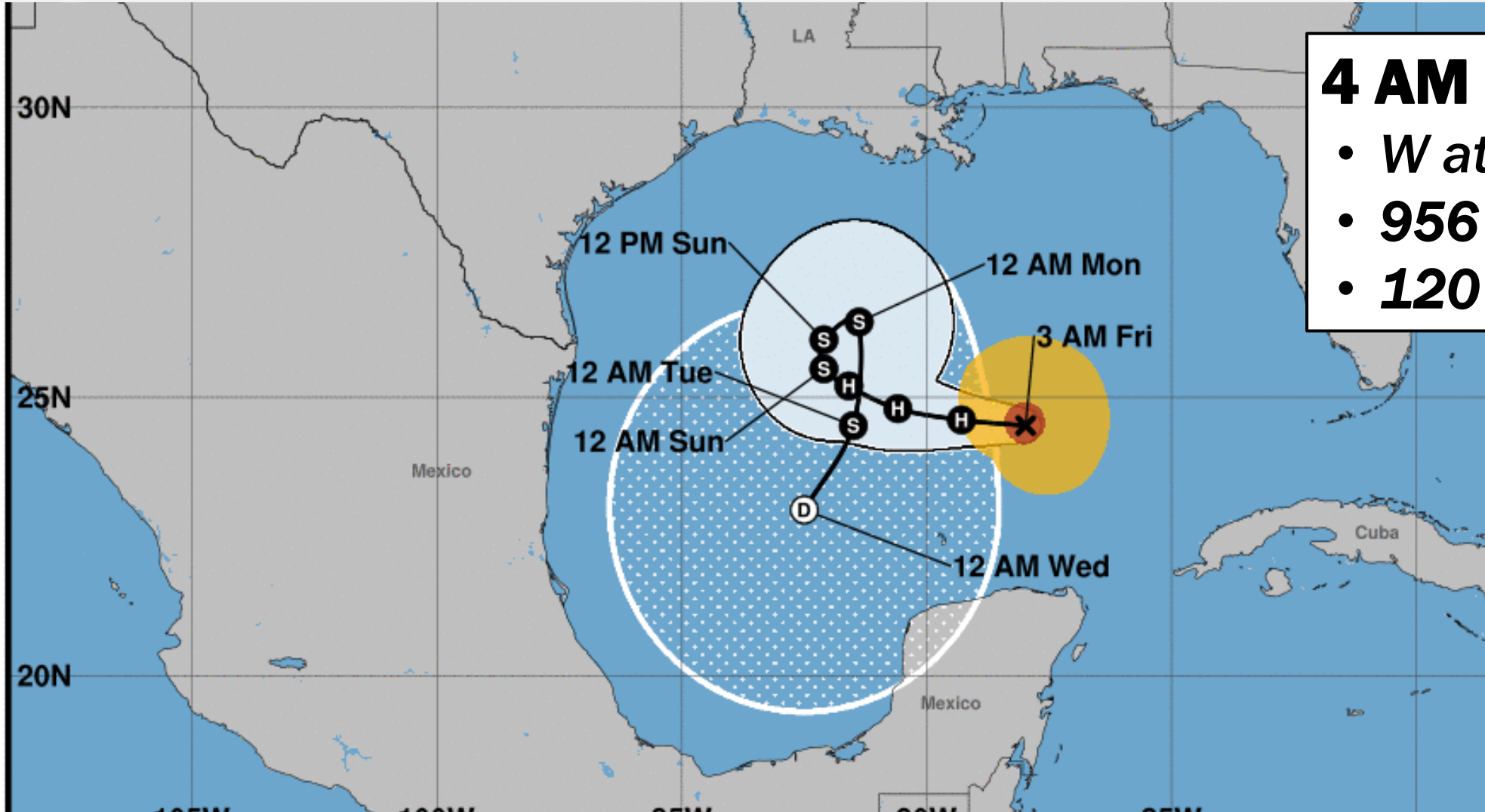

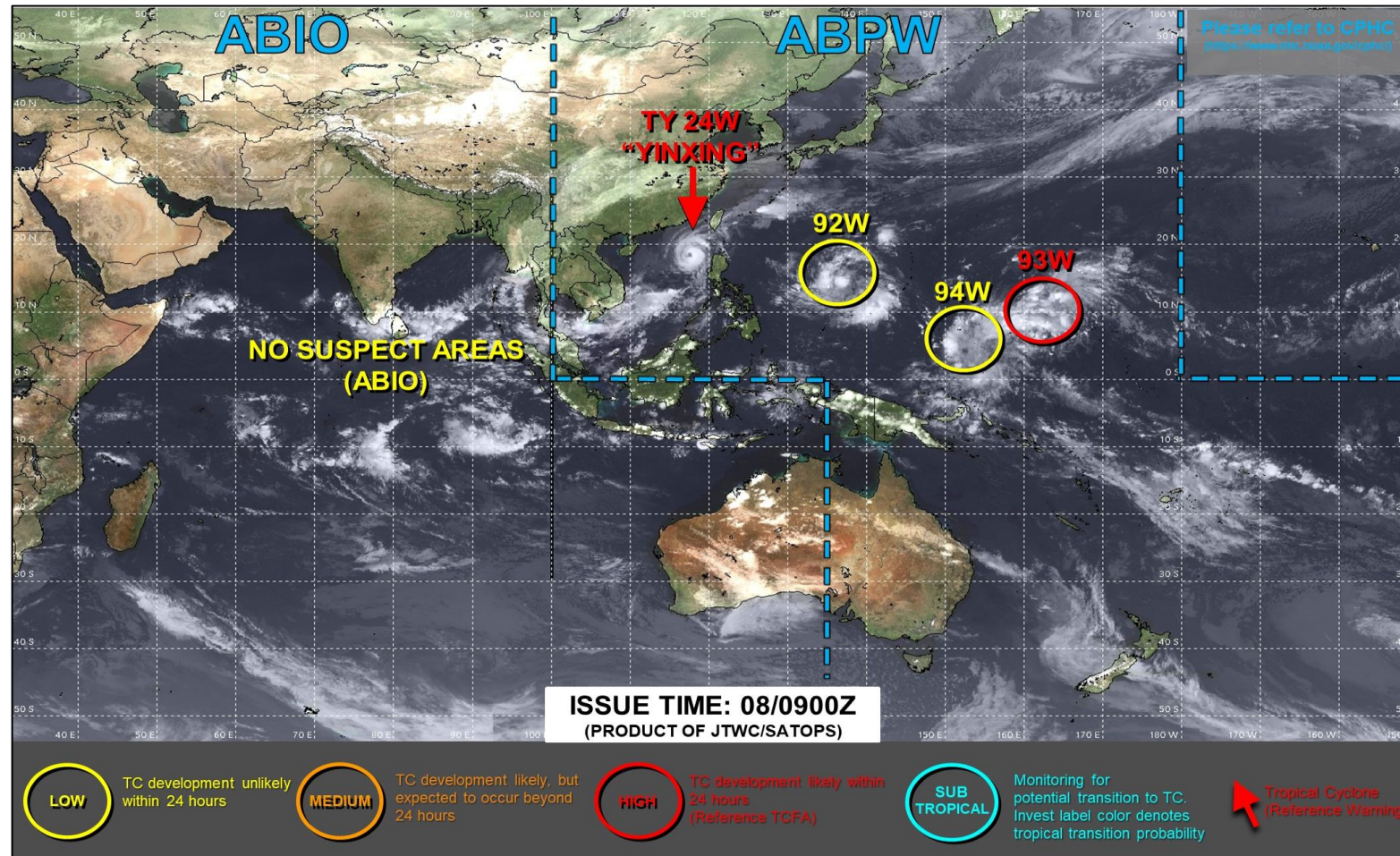

MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS



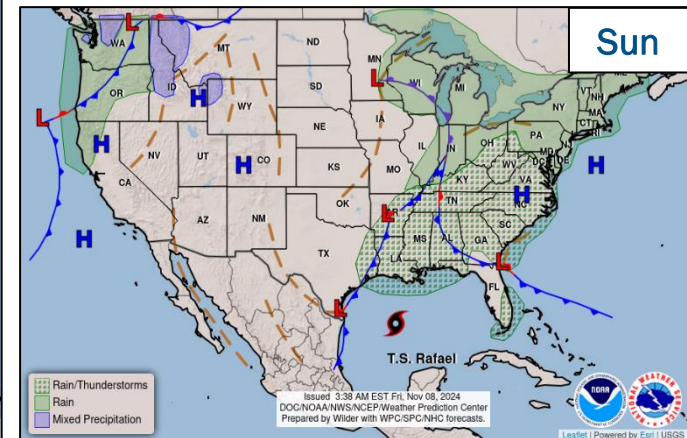
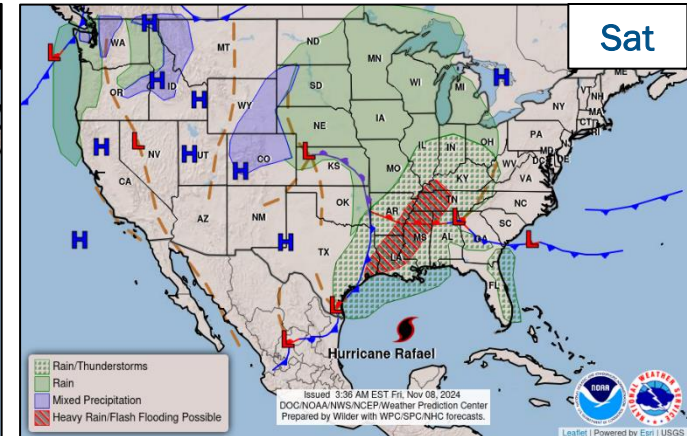
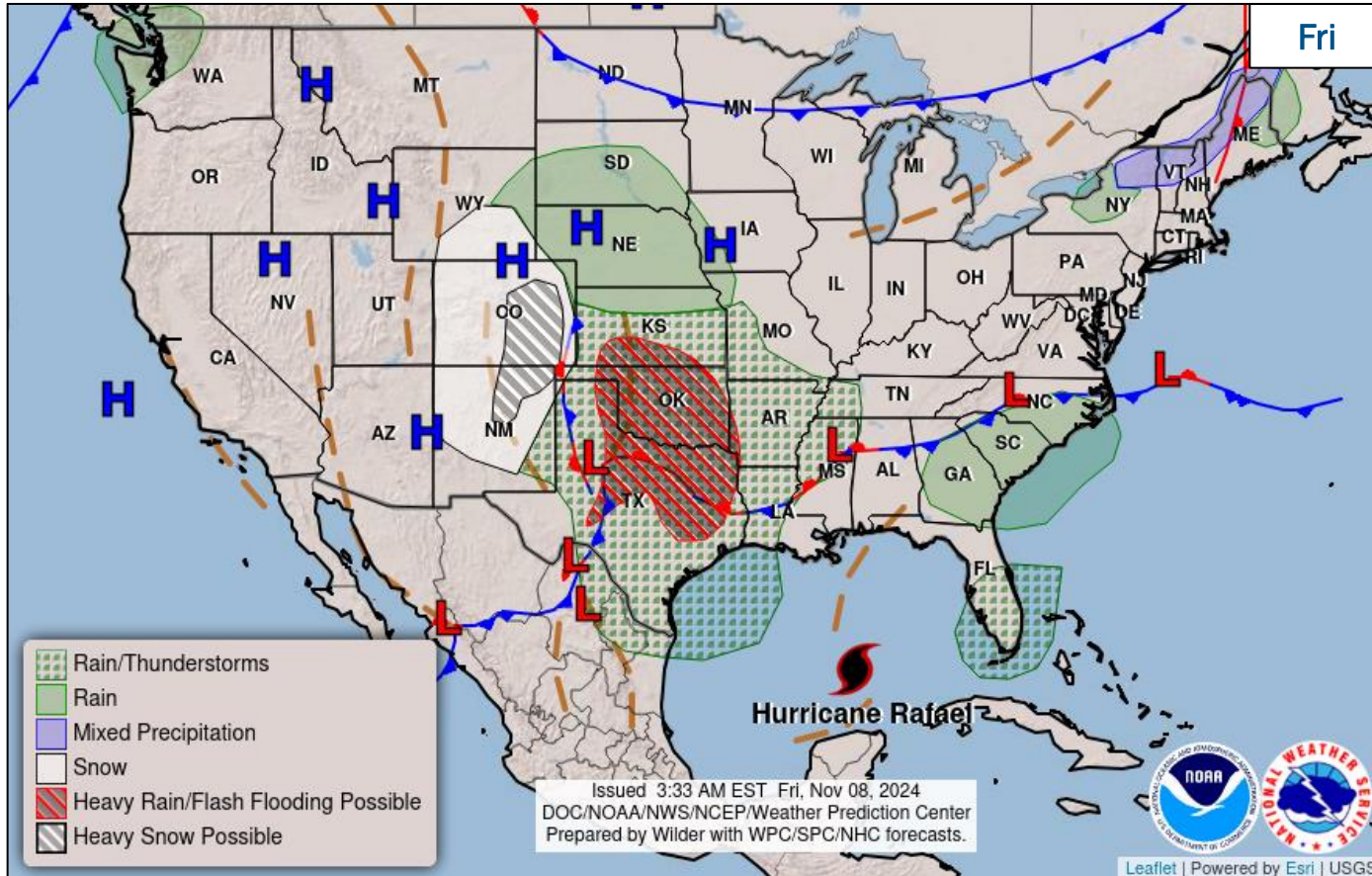

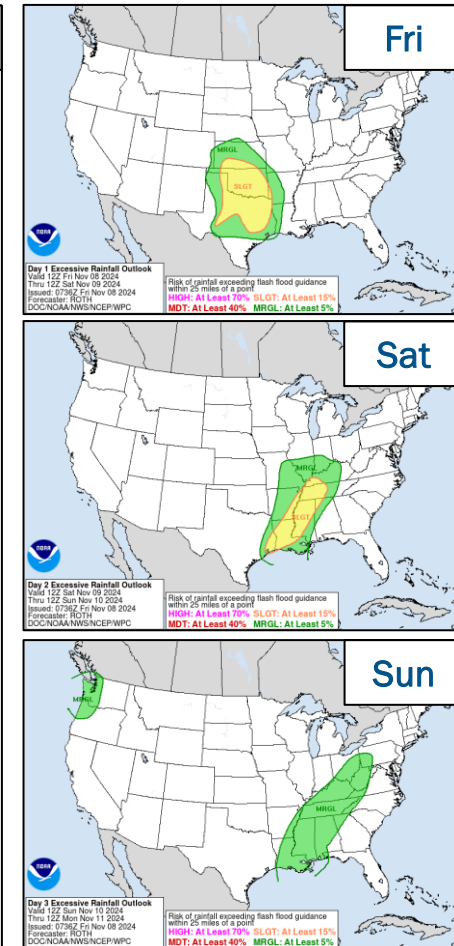
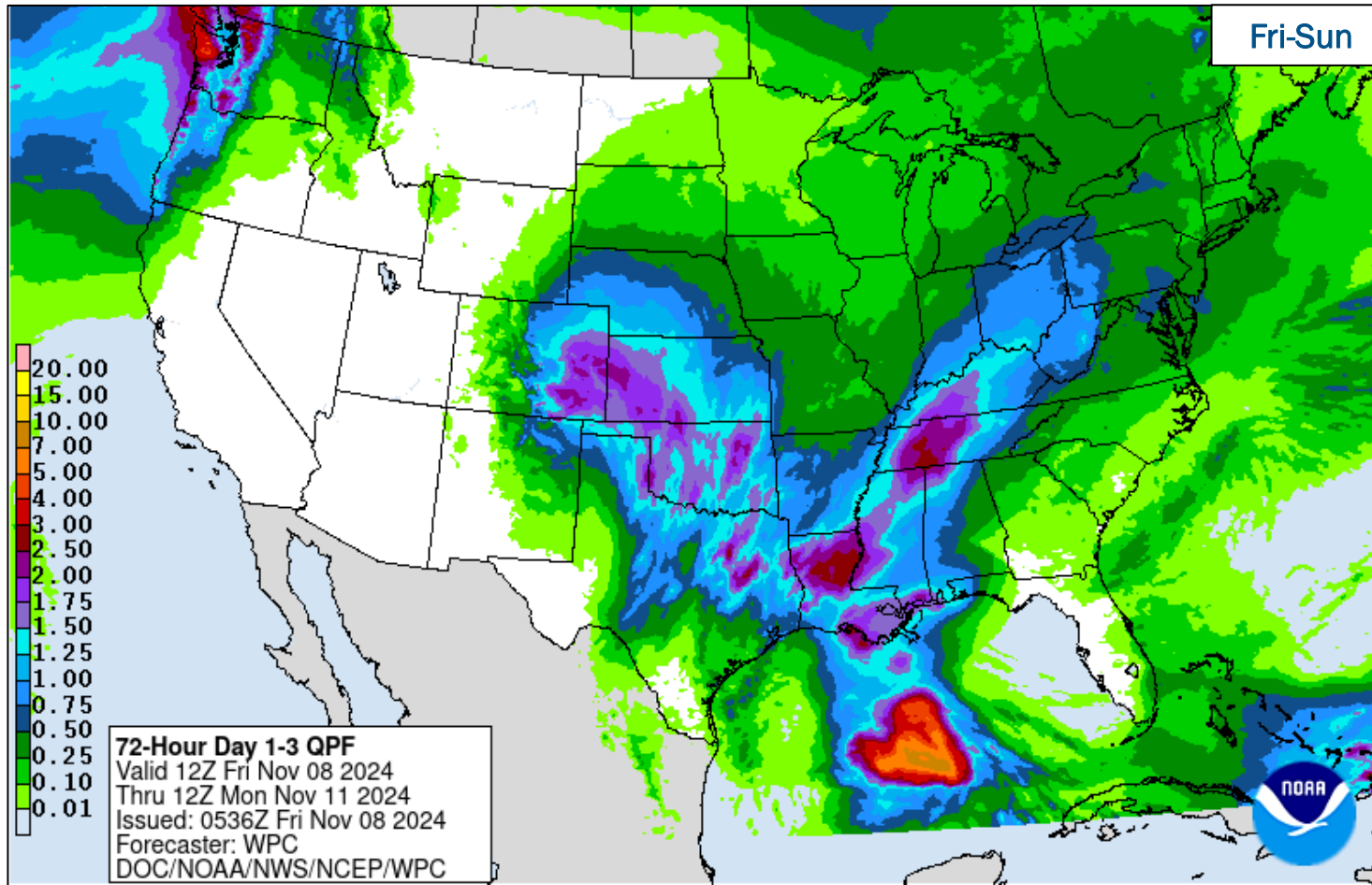
National Weather Forecast

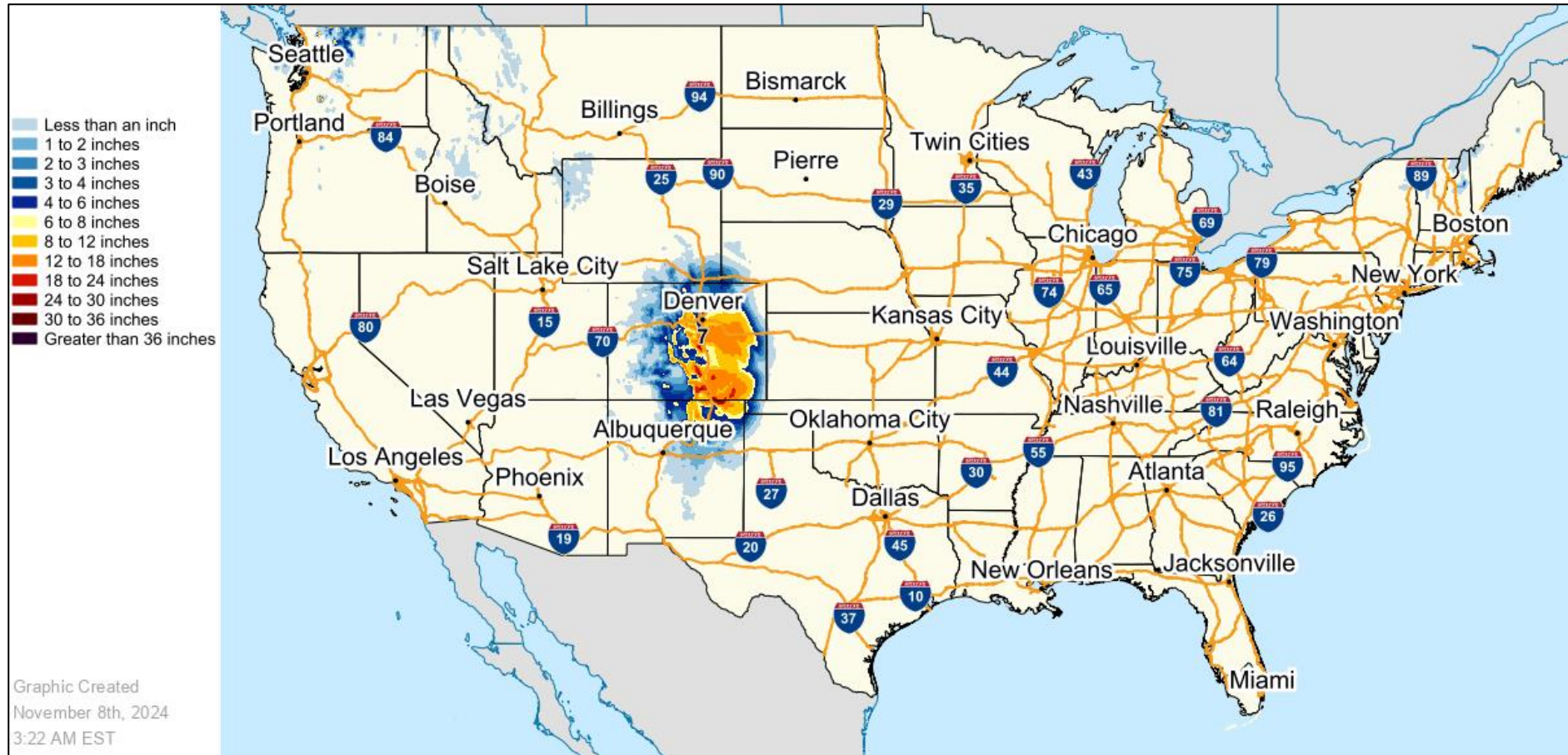
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

Snowfall Forecast

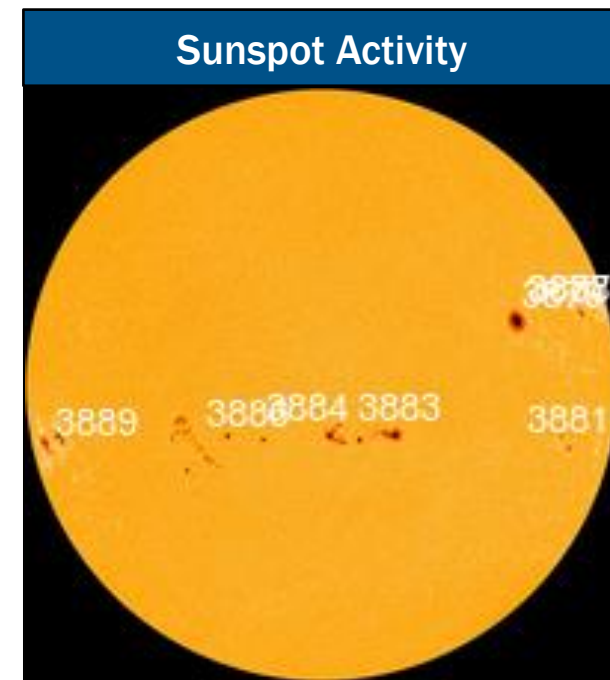
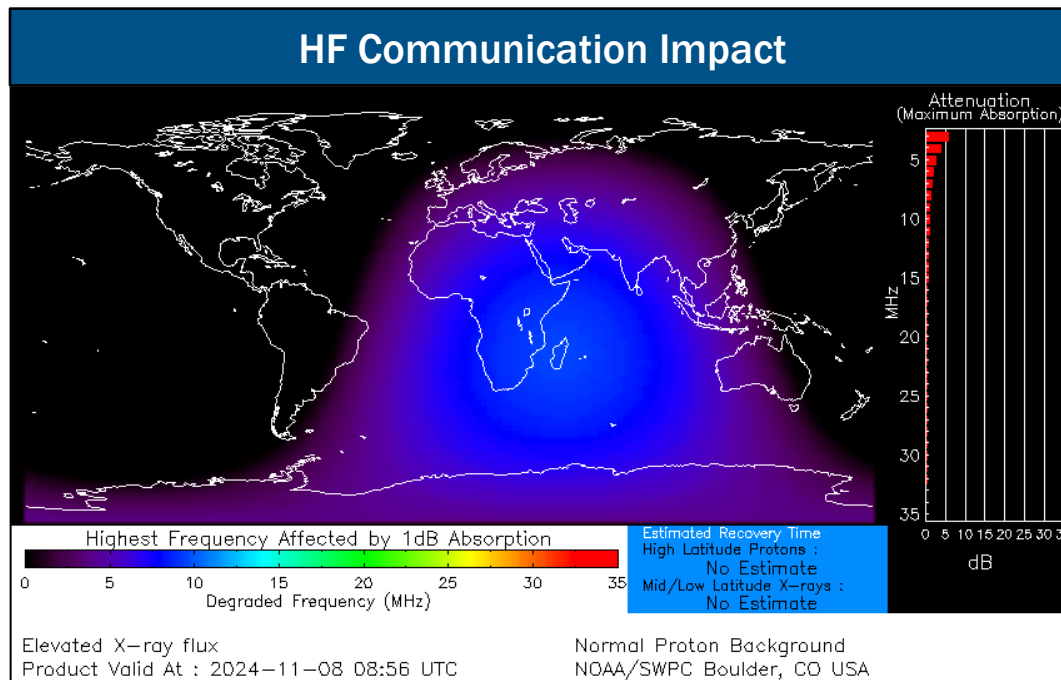
