FEMA Extends Deadline for COVID-19 Public Assistance Projects

FEMA extended the deadline for closeout submissions for COVID-19 Public Assistance projects for applicants and recipients until June 30, 2025.

FEMA extended the COVID-19 project closeout deadline as part of the agency's commitment to help communities recover from the costs associated with the pandemic. FEMA is maximizing its flexibilities and authorities to ensure Public Assistance projects are closed out in a way that addresses challenges efficiently and effectively.

Applicants and recipients with projects obligated on or before April 1, 2025 will now have until **June 30, 2025** to submit all required documentation. Projects obligated after April 1, 2025 will be due for closeout 90 days after obligation. However, FEMA encourages applicants to continue working toward closing their projects.

FEMA will continue to work closely with applicants to ensure all eligible projects are obligated and closed out.
