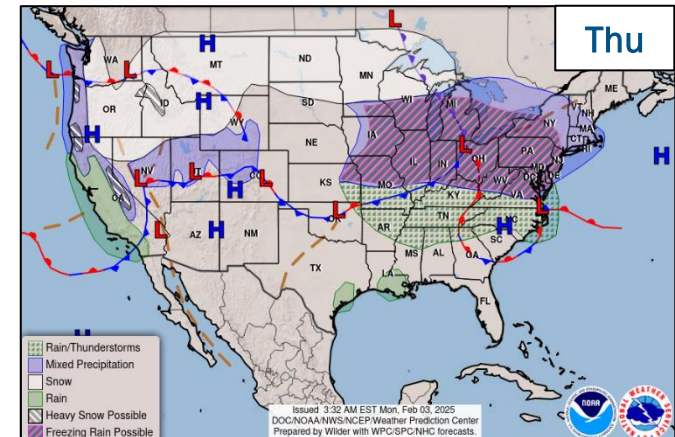

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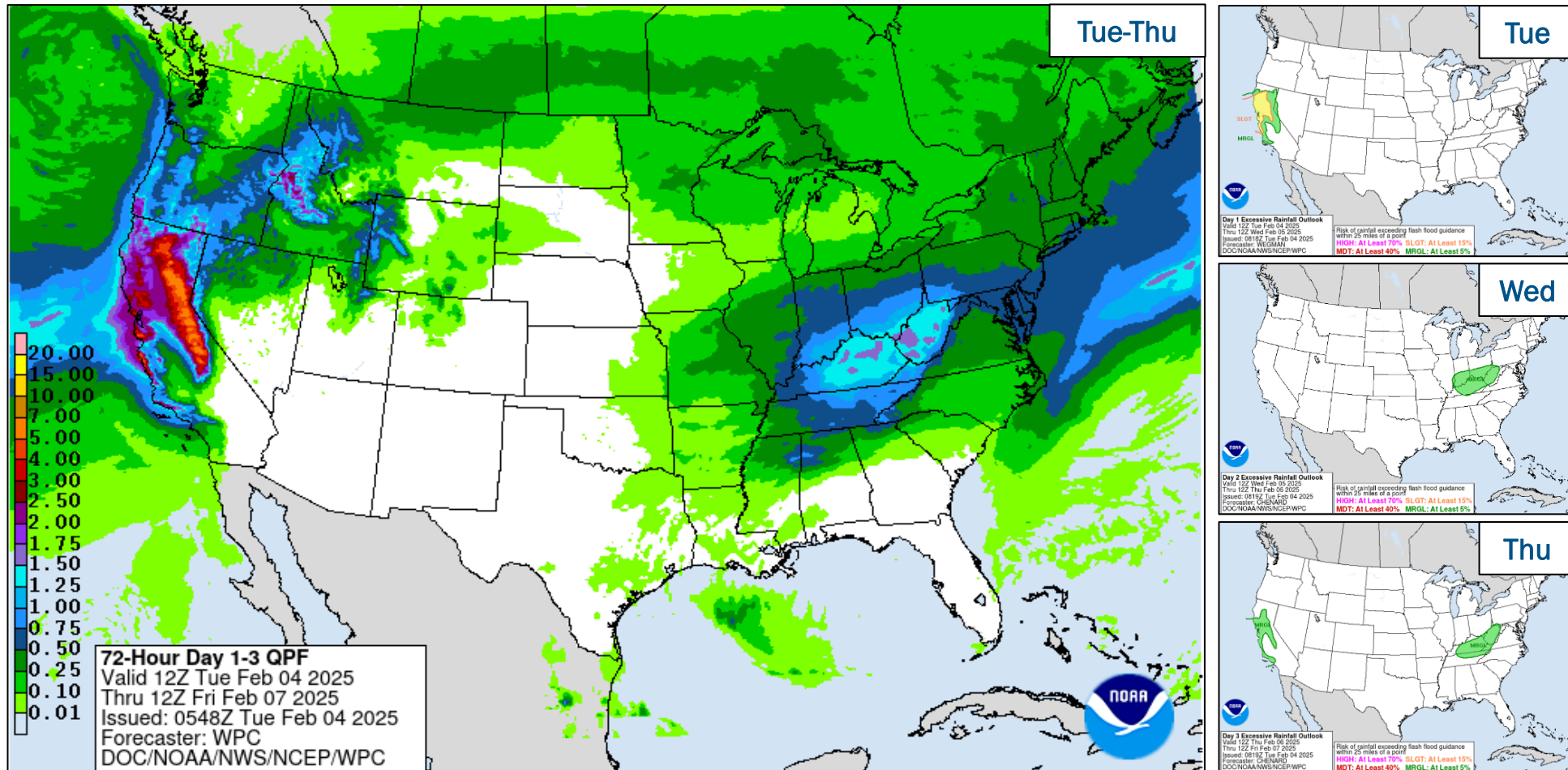
National Weather Forecast

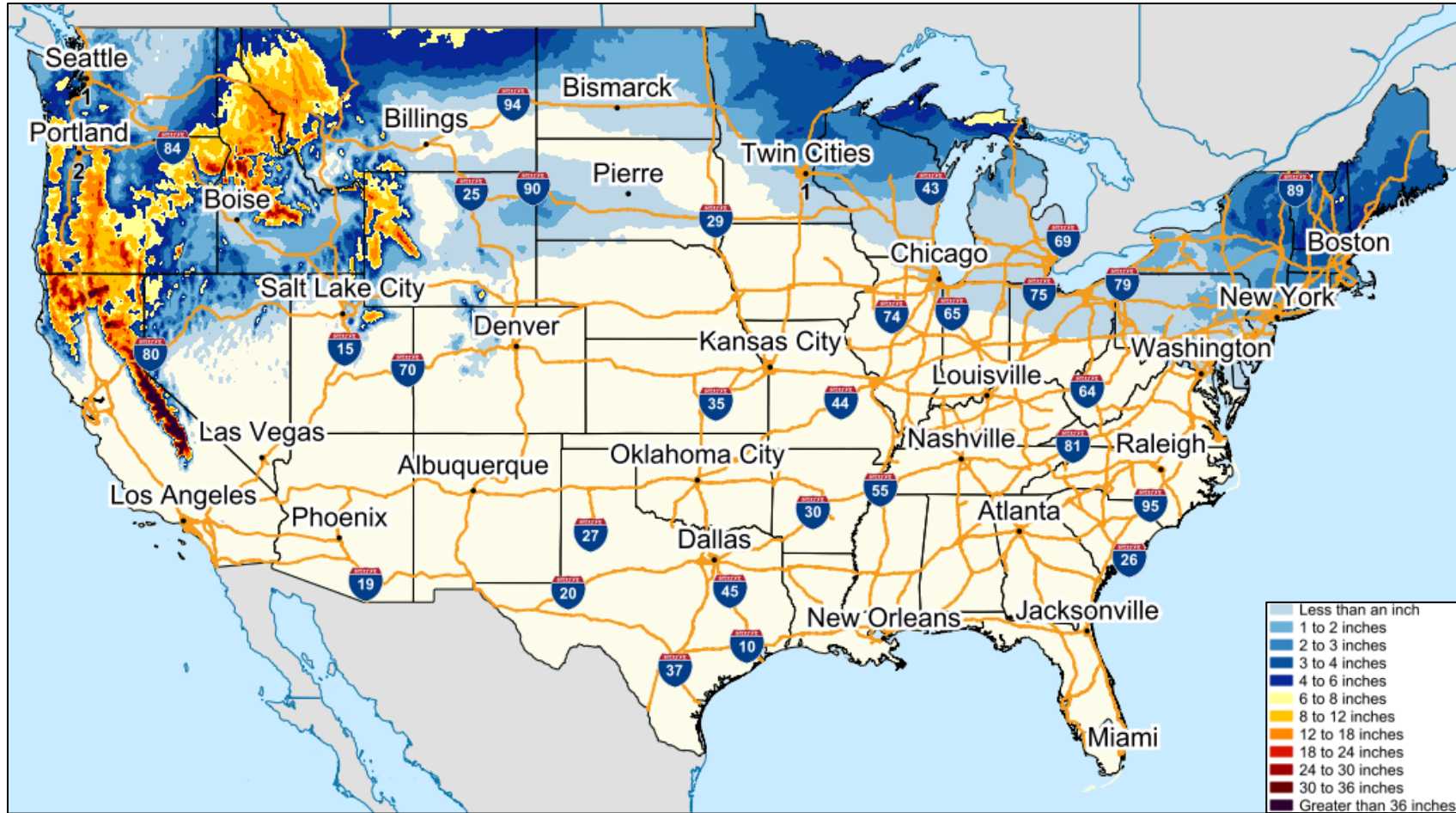
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



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Snowfall Forecast



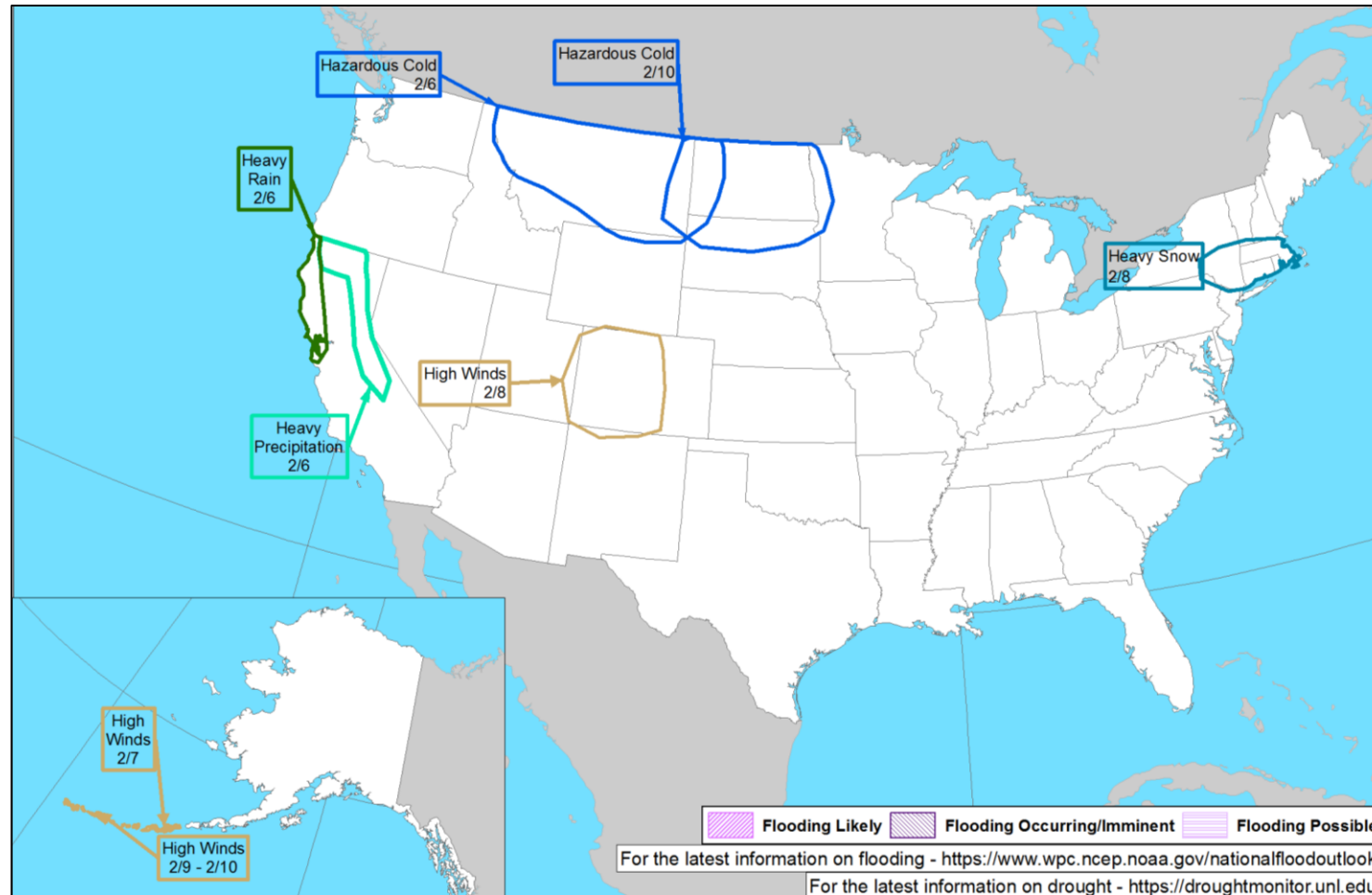
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Ice Accumulation Forecast

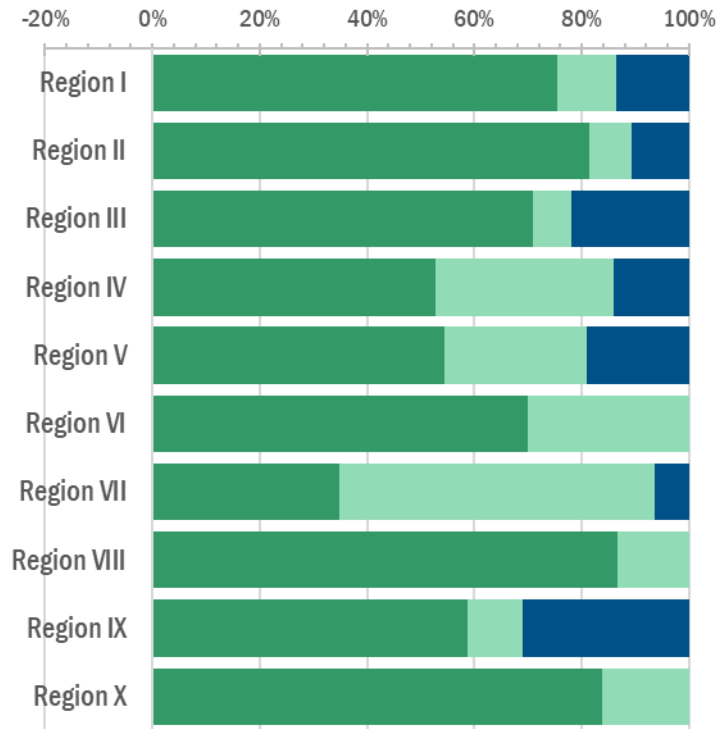


Public Assistance (PA) Grant Program Activity – per Region

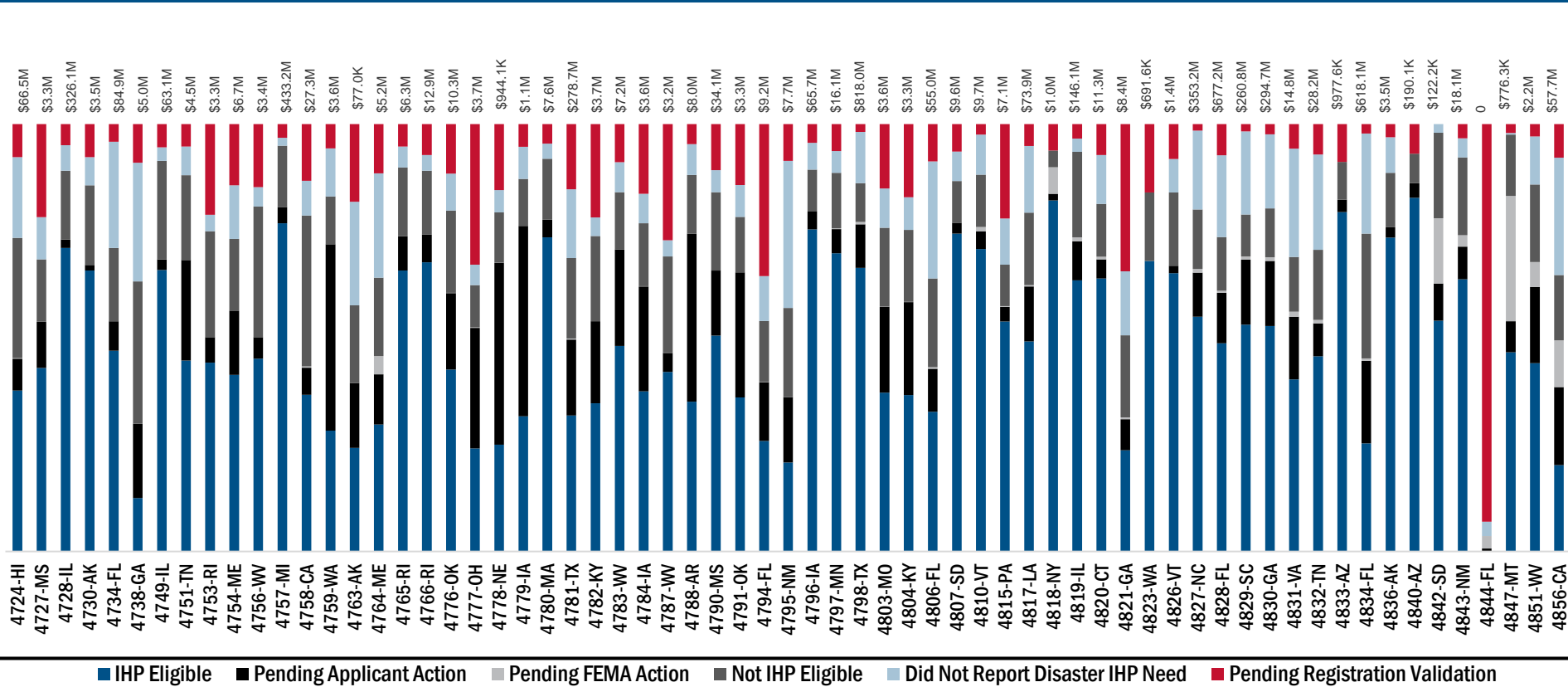

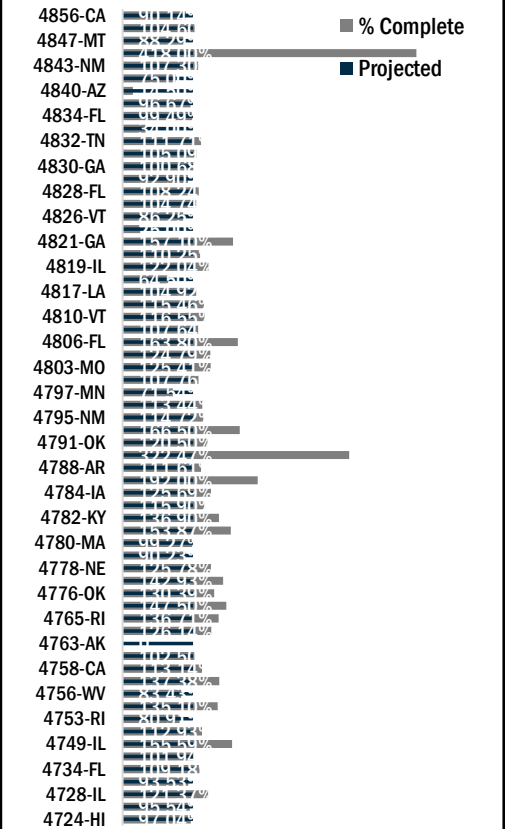

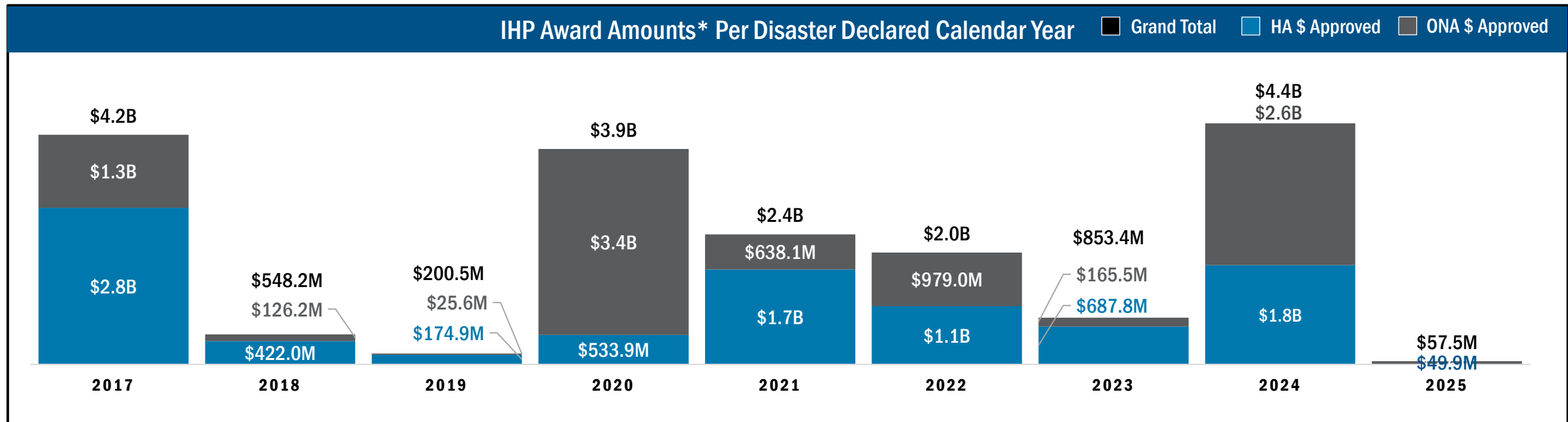
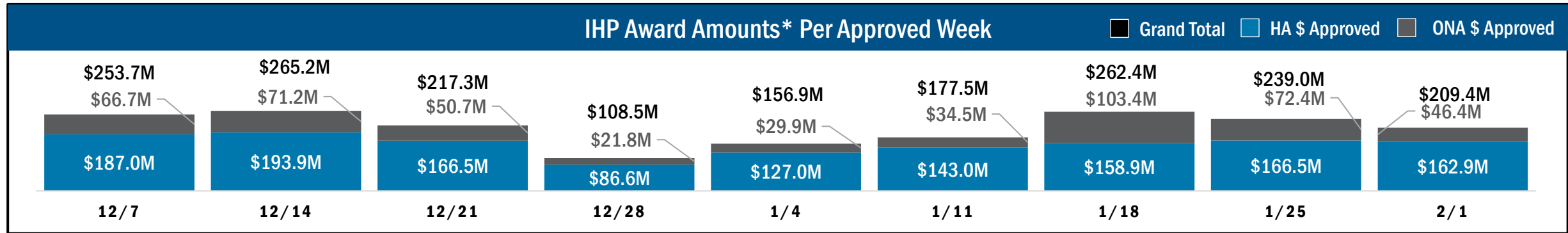
Registrations in Active Declarations

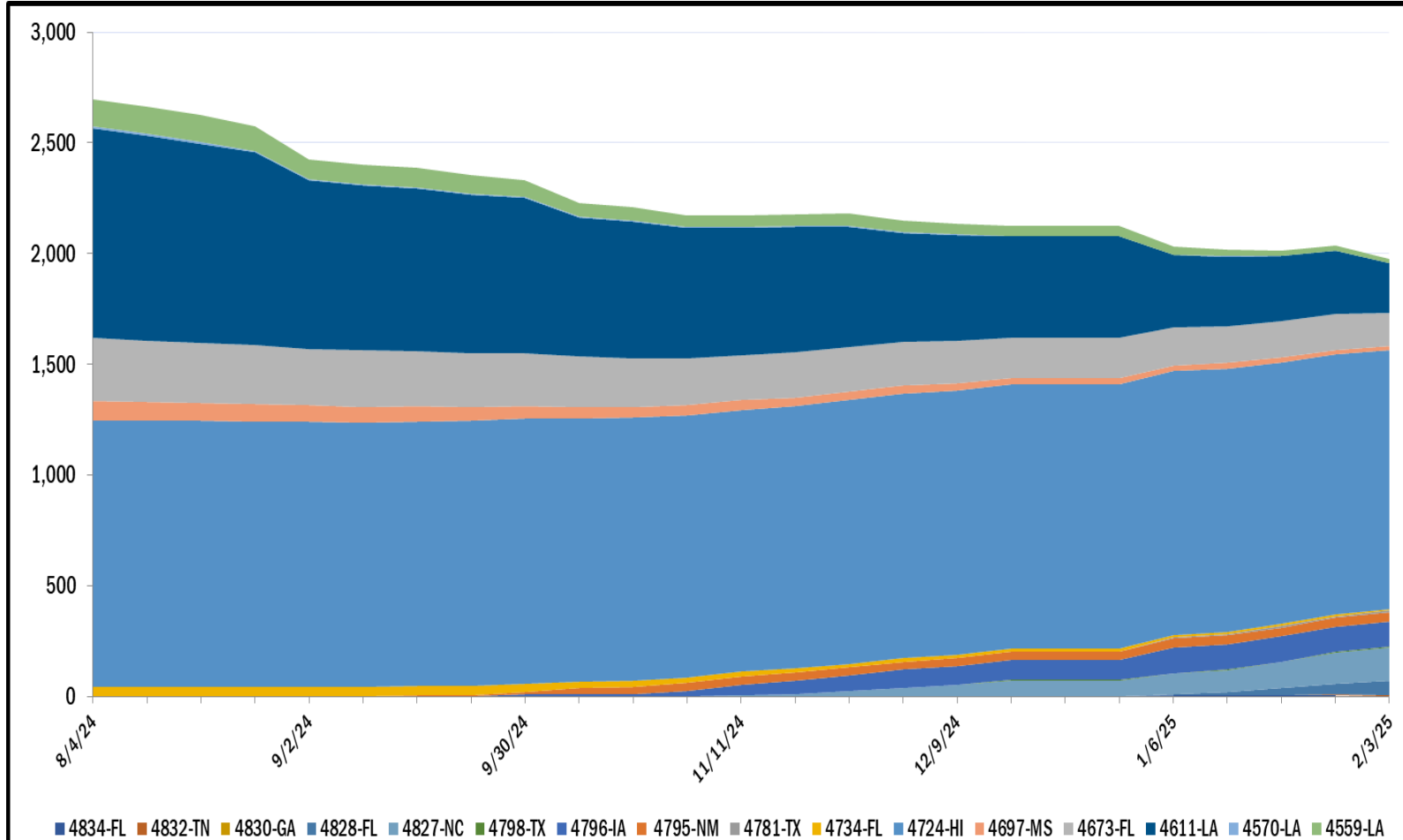

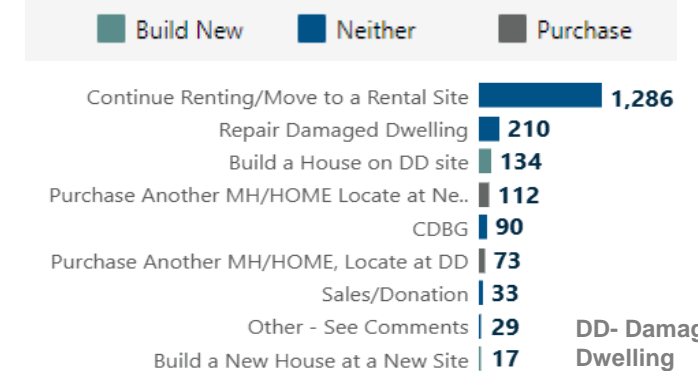
