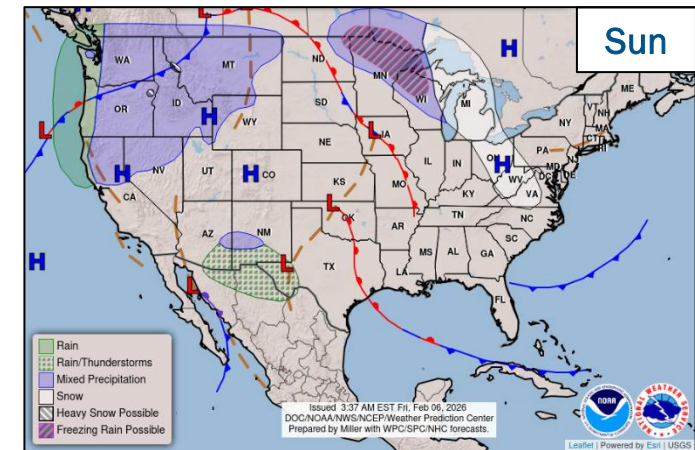
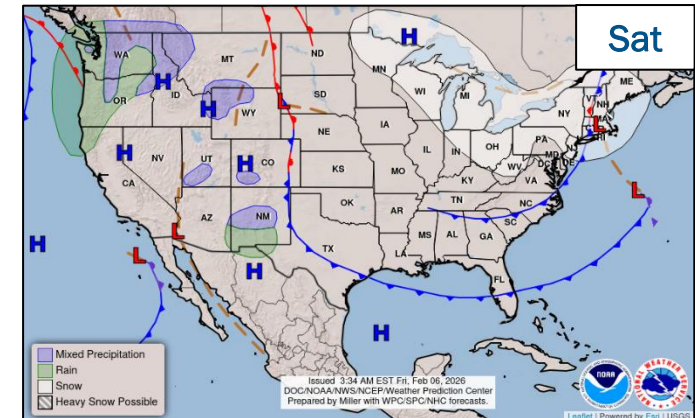
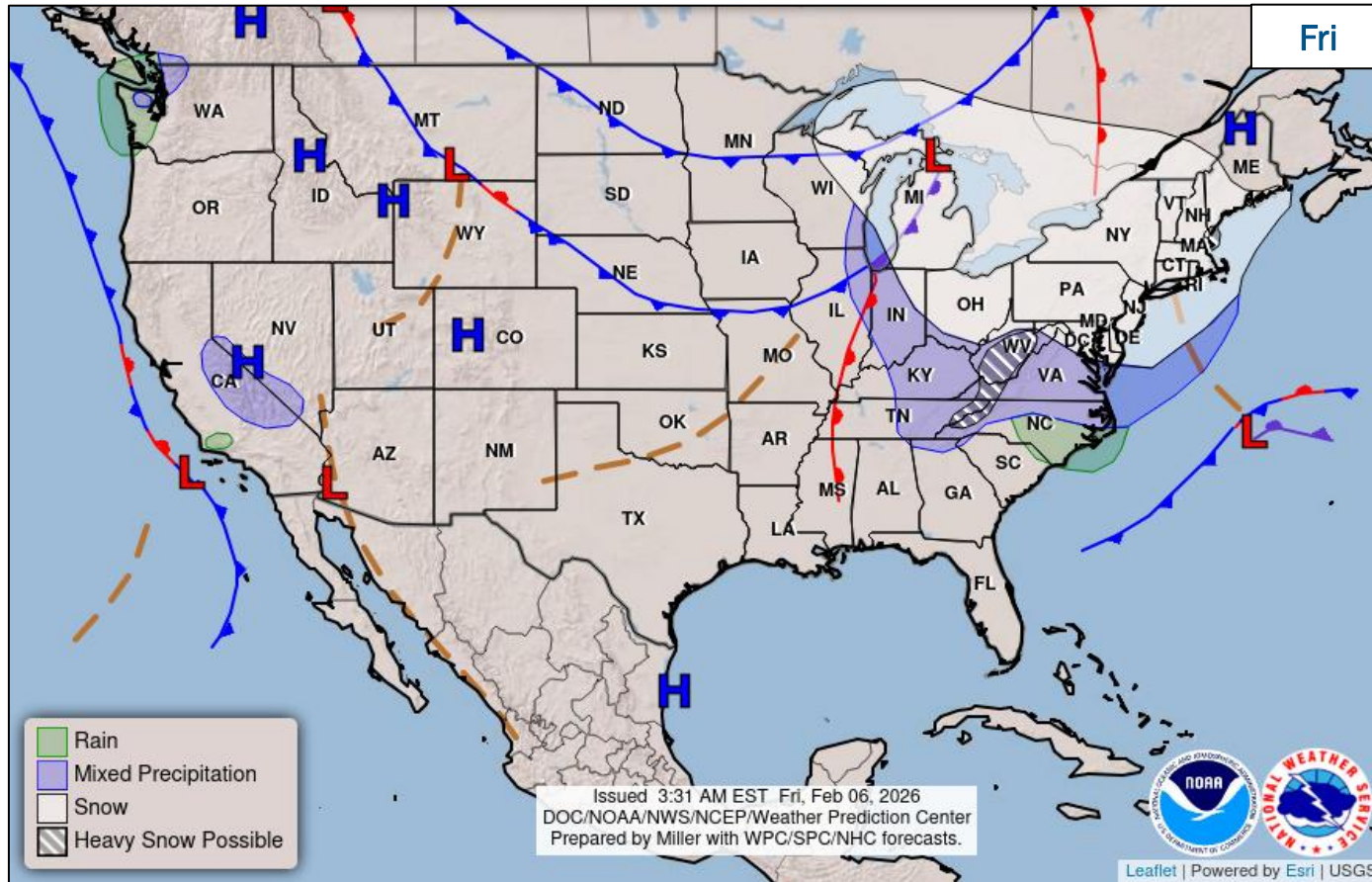

# National Weather Forecast

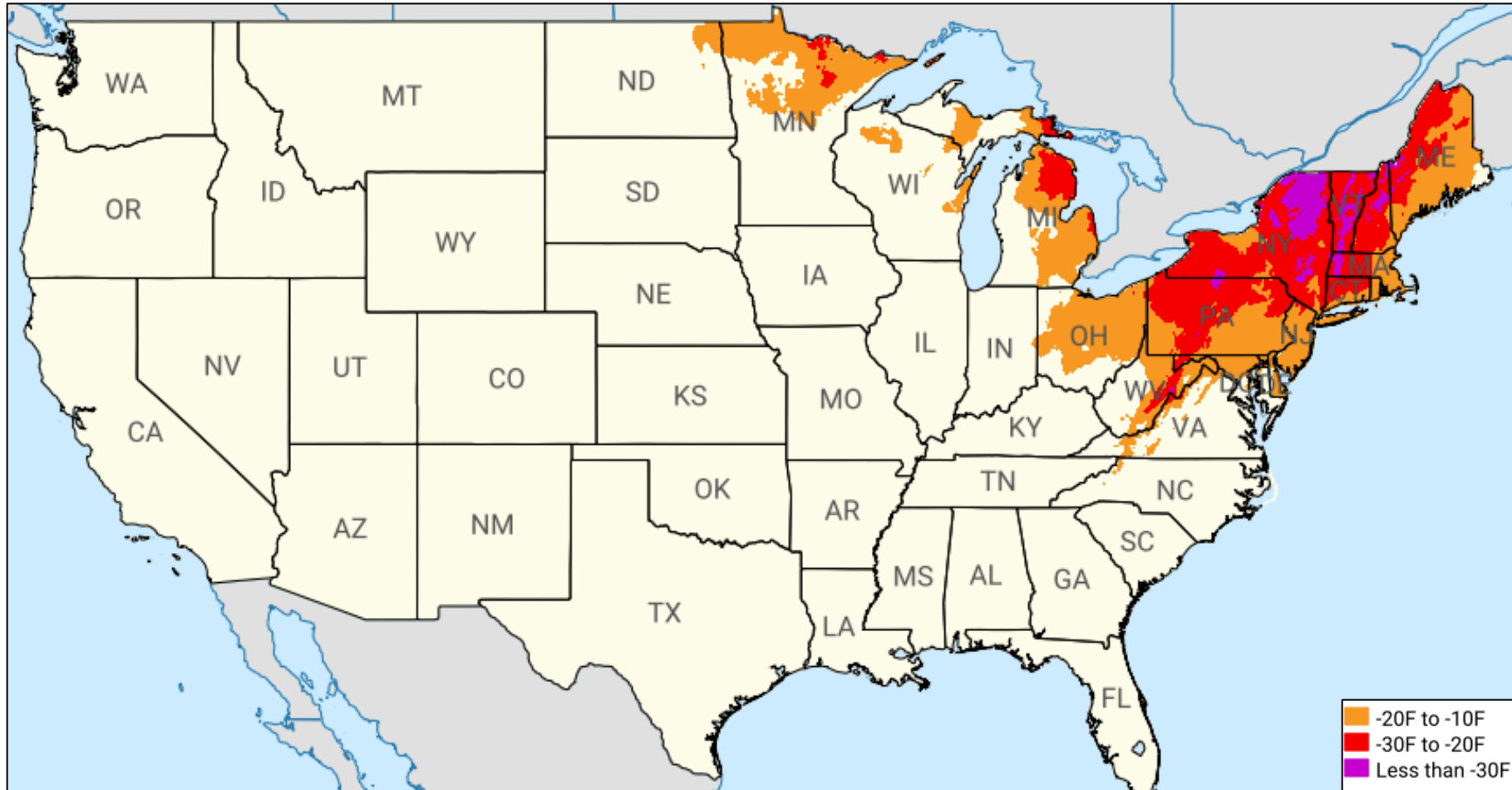

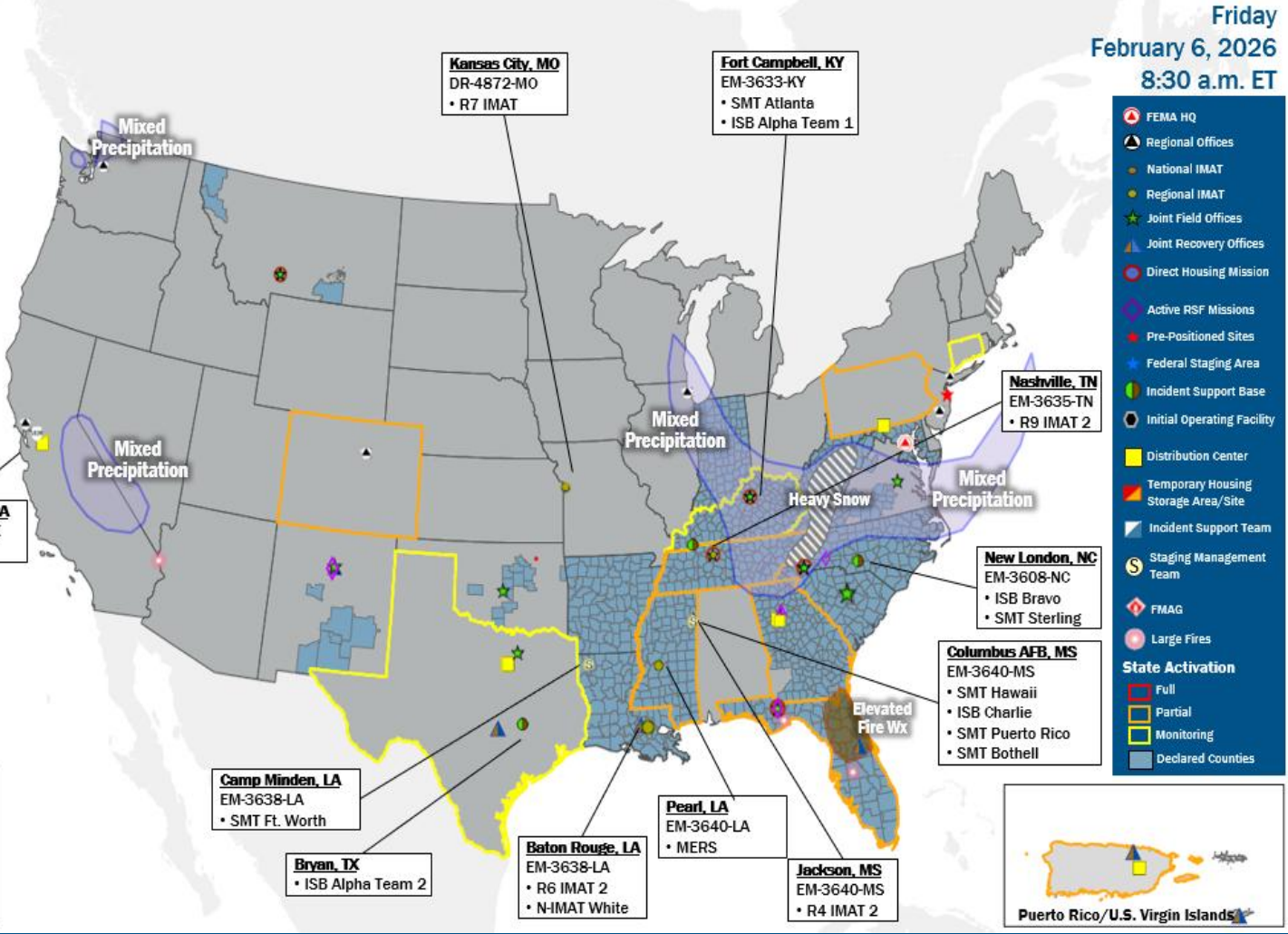

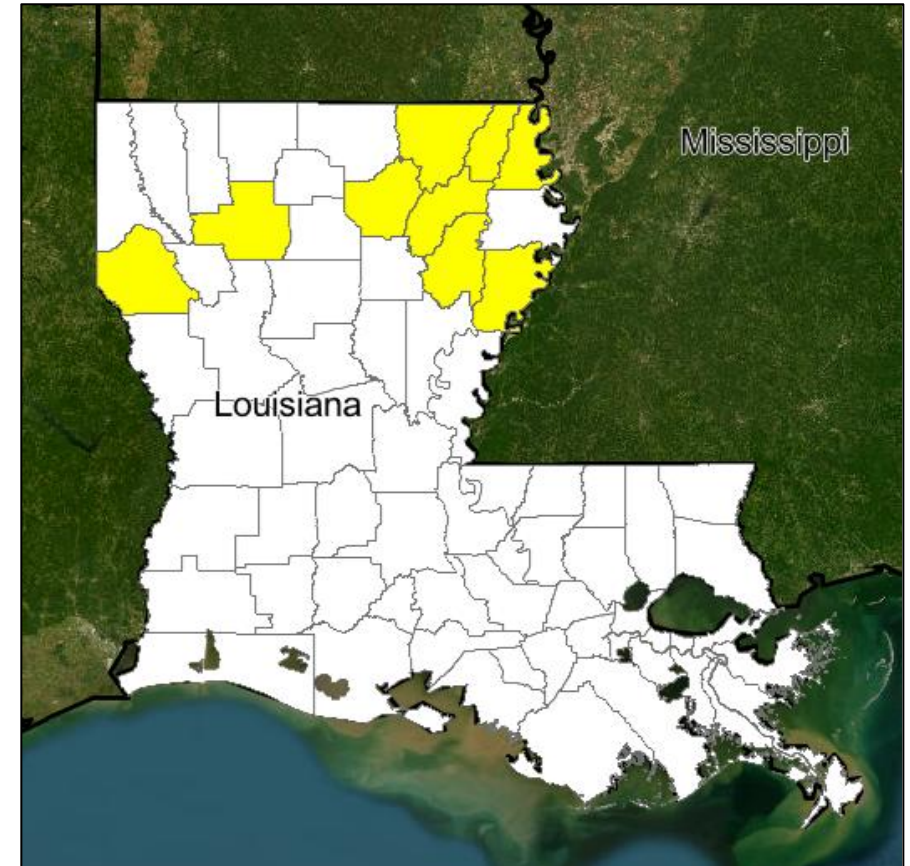
