We are seeking organizations or communities ready to advance a local or regional economic development strategy or transformative project but have struggled to find the resources to bridge the gap between planning and implementation.

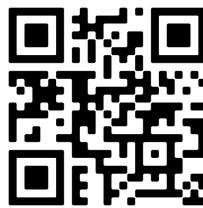

Acceleration Through Collaboration

Over the course of the 2.5-year (30 month) fellowship, selected host organizations will receive technical assistance, planning, and capacity-building support from an ERC Fellow. Fellows will help communities connect to resources, identify and advance innovative, locally-driven collaborative initiatives to build stronger, more resilient, and inclusive economies.



Who are the Fellows?

Fellows will be highly trained early to mid-career professionals from diverse backgrounds and disciplines and will be matched with host projects that align with their specific expertise and regional knowledge. Hosts will have the opportunity to interview and participate in the fellow selection process.

There is no cost to an organization or community to host a fellow. Fellows will be paid and overseen by IEDC.
