




STANDING ORDER

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002(h) and unless otherwise ordered by the Court, after 70 days following an order for relief under chapter 13 or the date of an order converting a case to chapter 13, all notices required by Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002(a) may be mailed only to the debtor; the trustee; all indenture trustees; creditors that hold claims for which proofs of claim have been filed; creditors, if any, that are still permitted to file claims because an extension was granted under Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002(c)(1) or (c)(2); and parties in interest expressly requesting notice.


