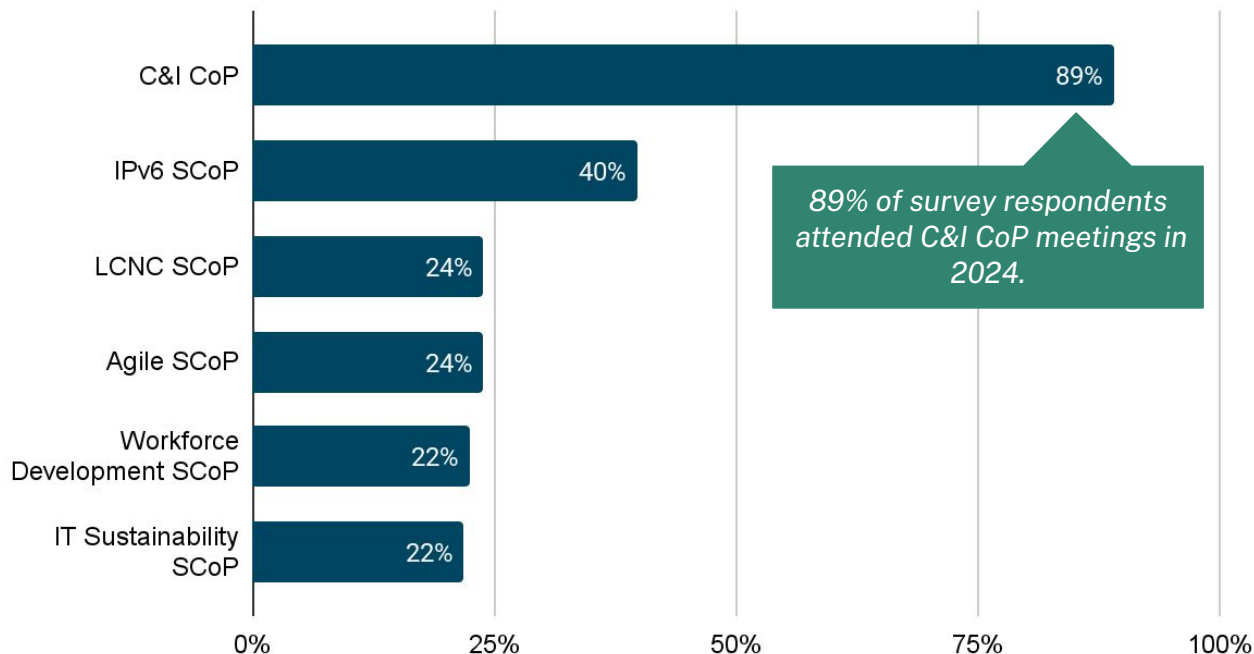

- The Annual Survey was live from October 2, 2024 to December 6, 2024
- Distributed to members of the Cloud & Infrastructure Community of Practice (C&I CoP) and its Subcommunities of Practice (SCoPs):
 - Agile SCoP
 - IPv6 SCoP
 - IT Sustainability SCoP
 - Low Code No Code SCoP
 - Workforce Development SCoP
- The survey contained 14 questions
- Received 201 responses, with representation from over 21 agencies

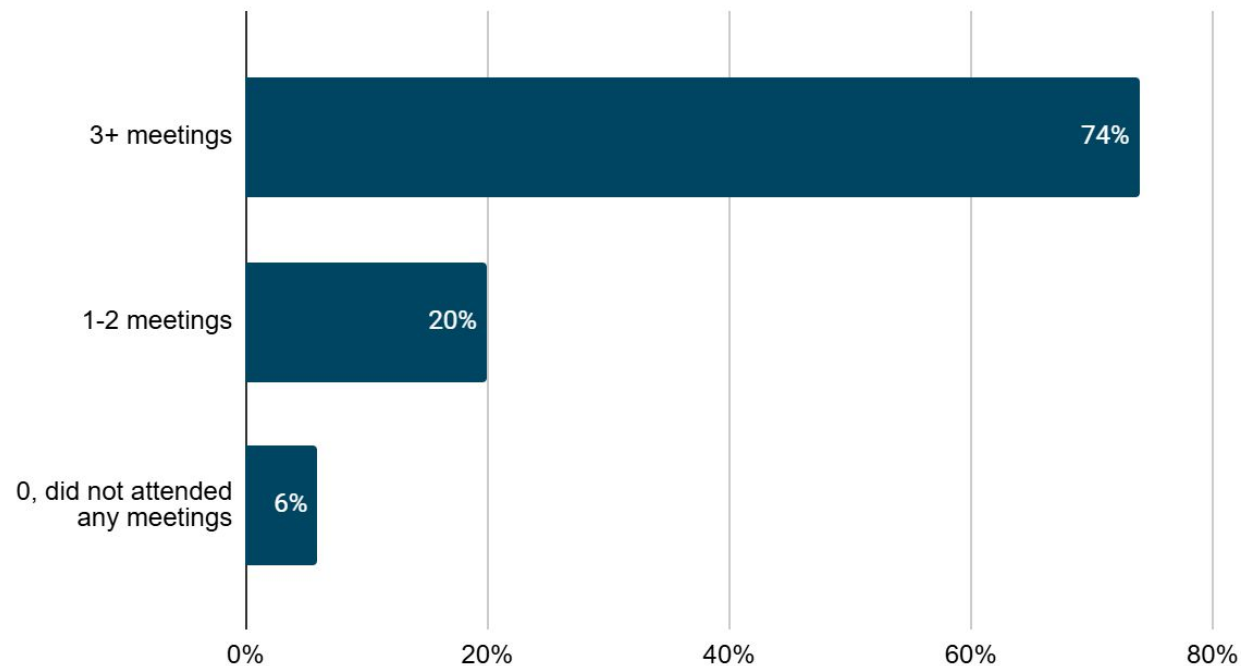
CoP and SCoP Membership

Which of our communities did you participate in during 2024?



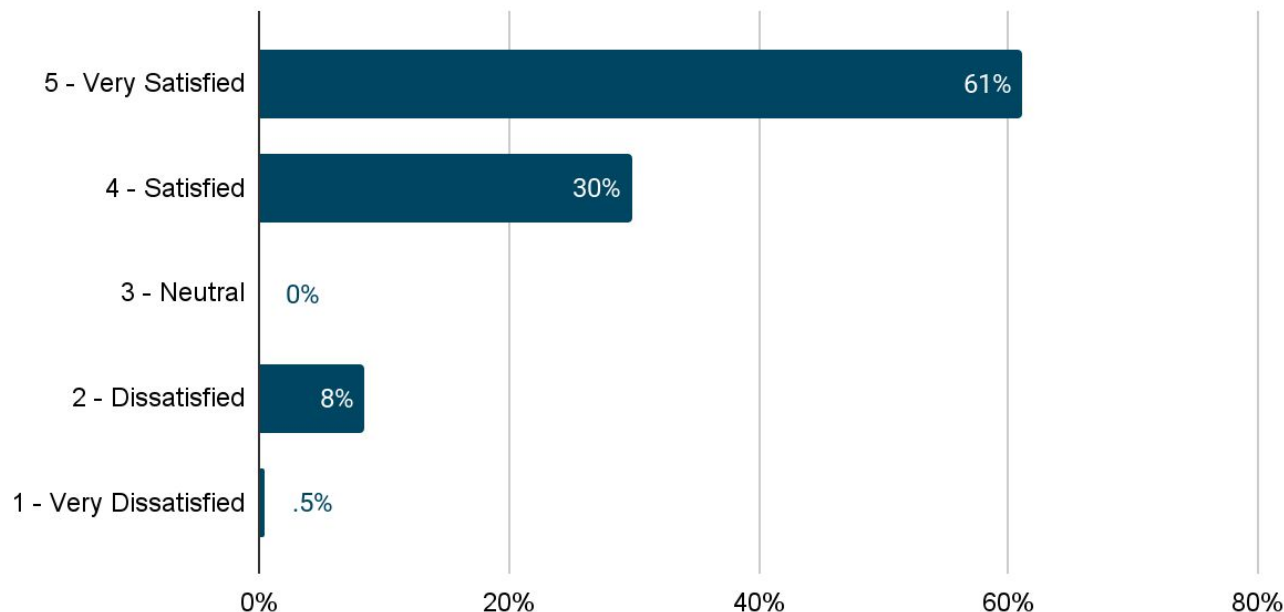
Meeting Participation

How many CoP/SCoP meetings did you attend in 2024?



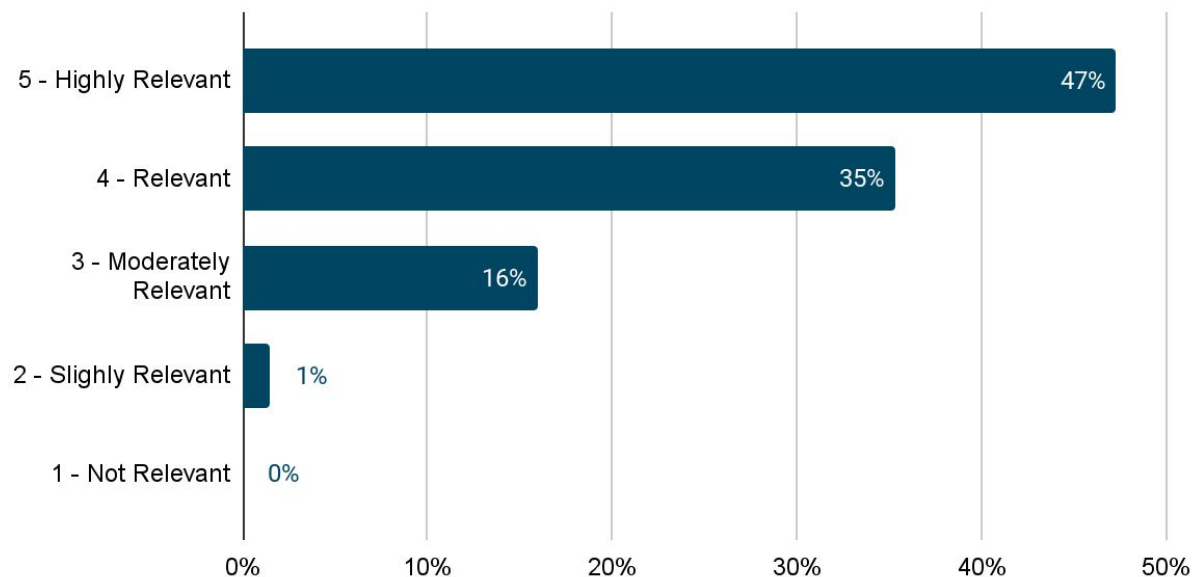
Meeting Feedback

Please rate your overall satisfaction with the CoP and/or SCoP meetings.



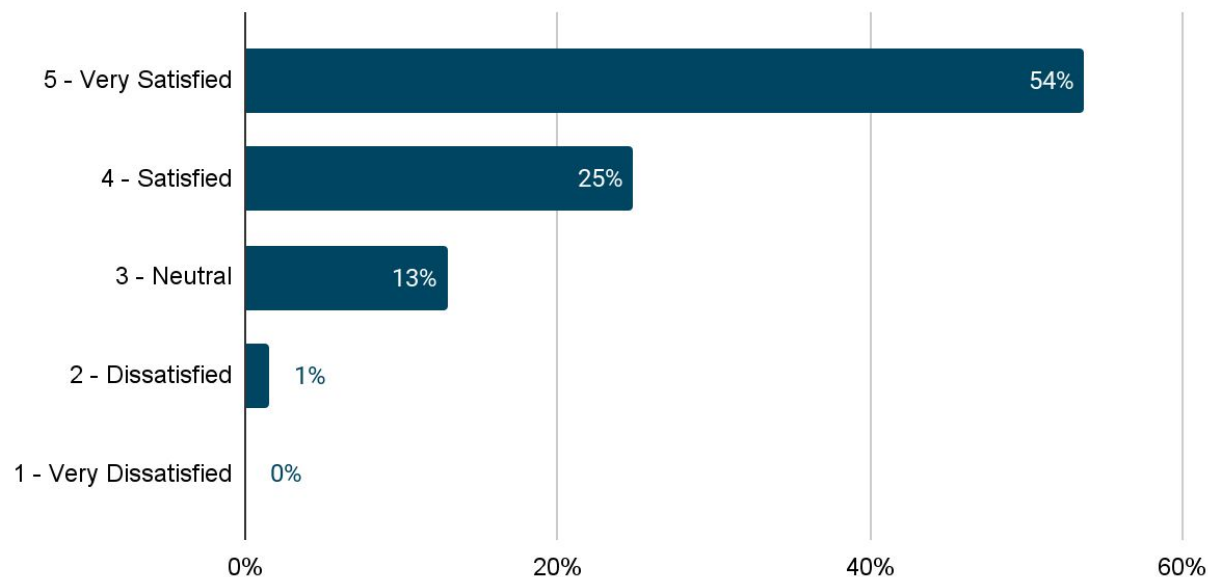
Meeting Feedback

The topics covered at the CoP/SCoP meetings are relevant to my current work.



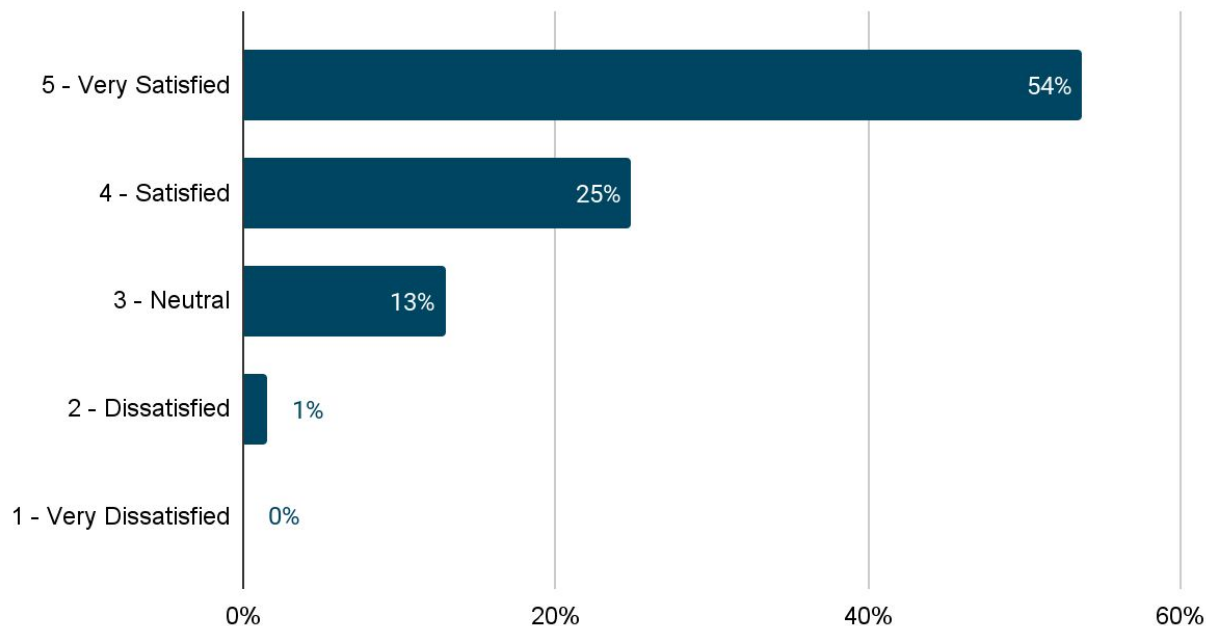
Training

Please rate your overall satisfaction with the types of training courses offered.



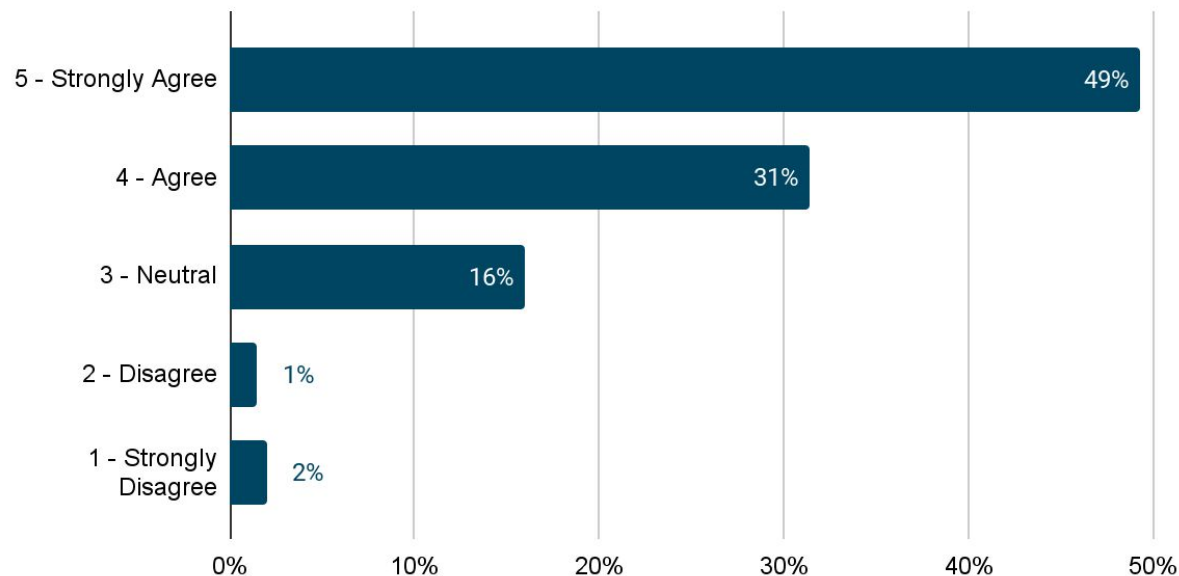

Please rate your satisfaction with quality of training provided



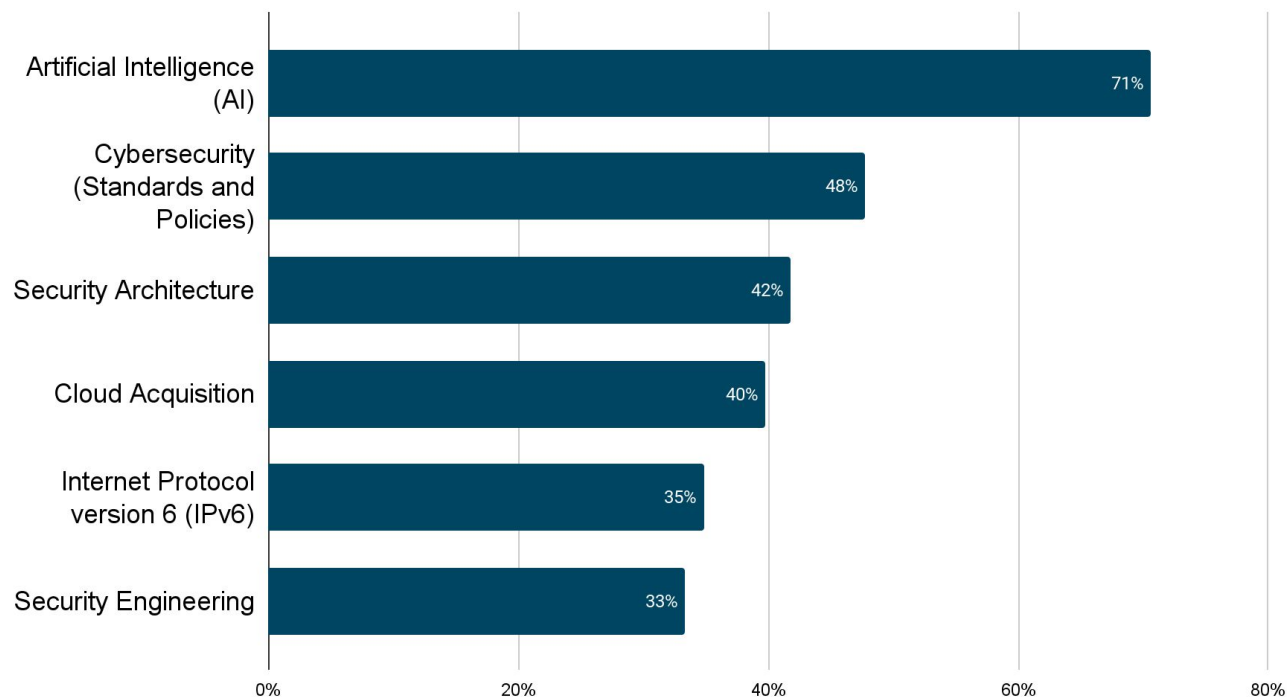
Networking Opportunities

The CoP provides an opportunity to network and collaborate with other agencies.



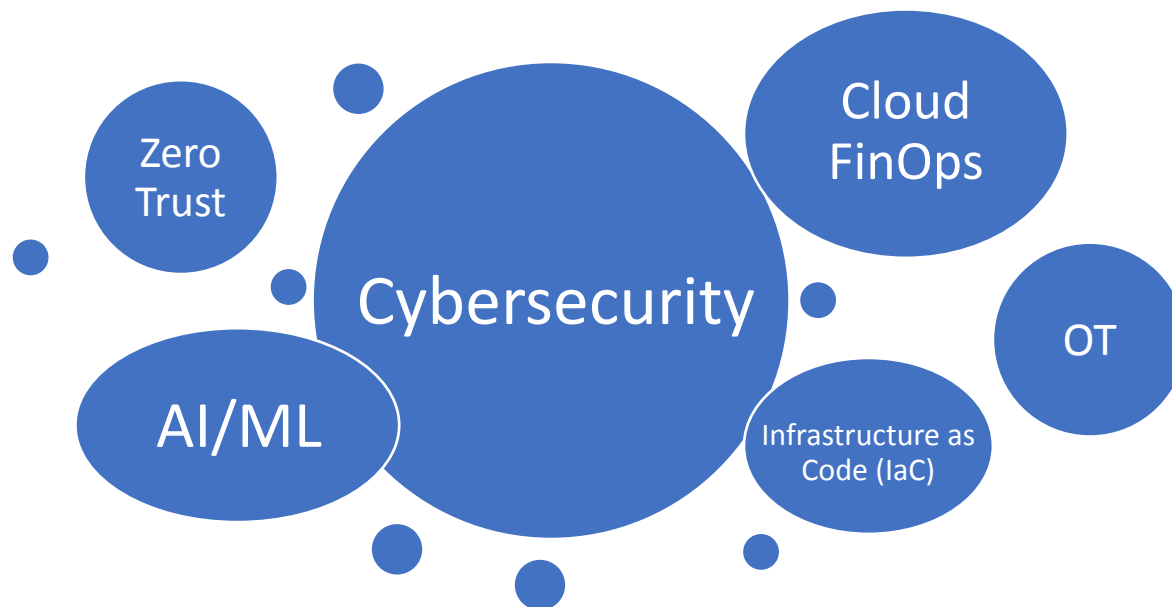
Community Interest

Which areas of IT Modernization are you most interested in discussing in 2025?



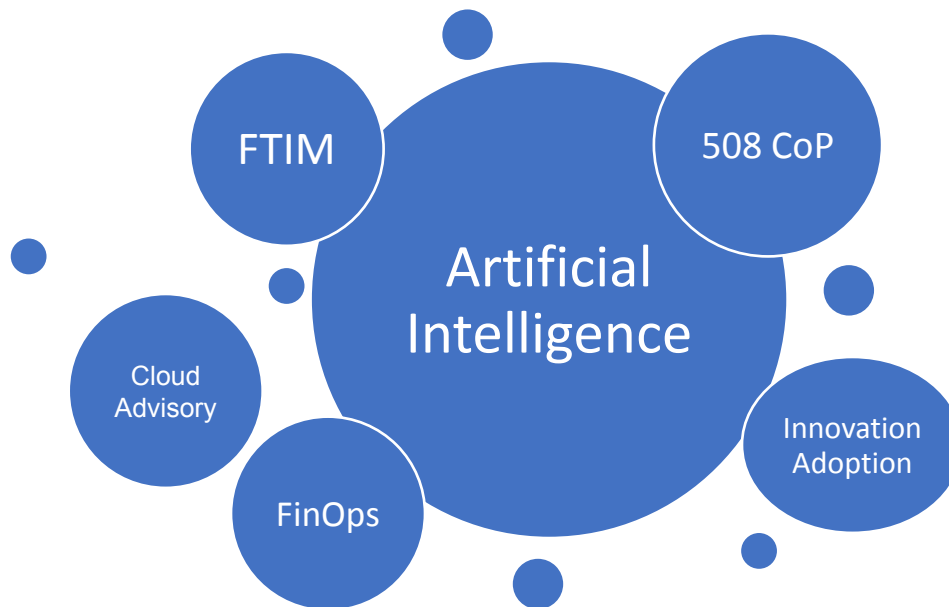
Additional Focus Areas

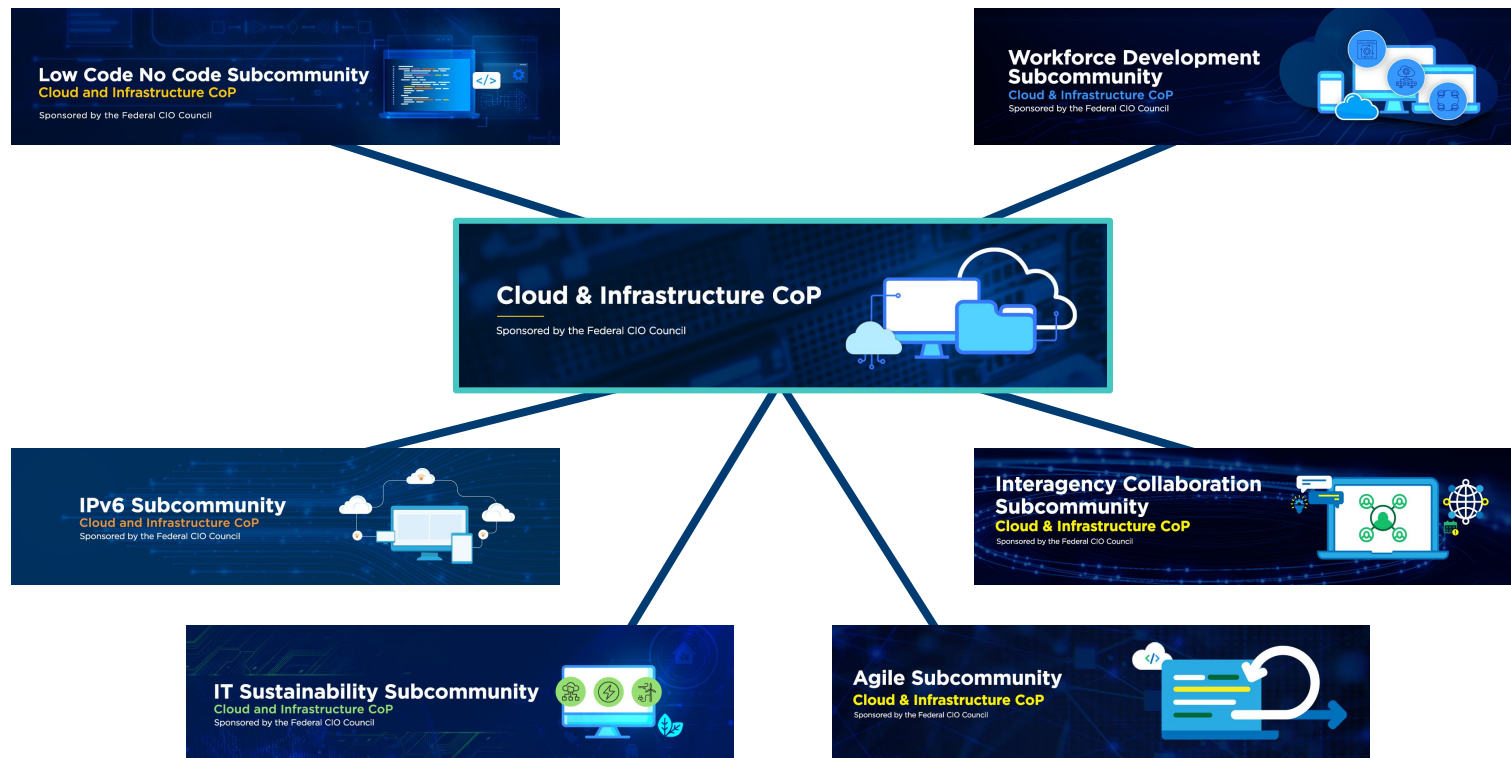
