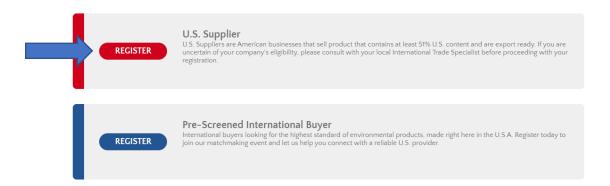
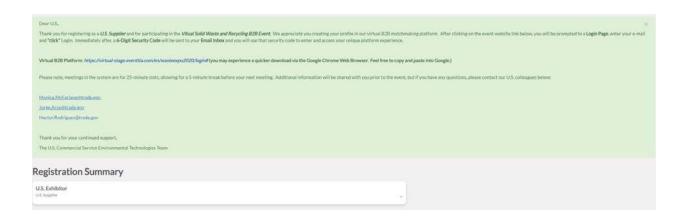
Registration Process for Virtual B2B Waste/Recycling Matchmaking Event: For U.S. Suppliers

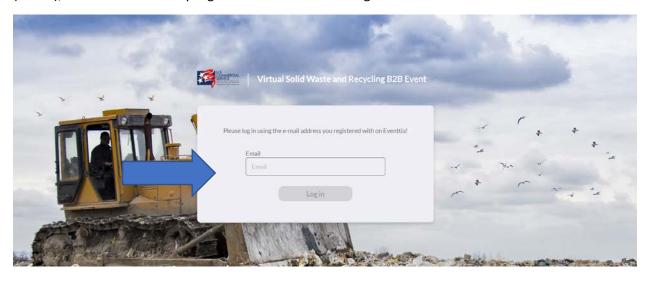
After you register, you will be taken directly to the screen shown below and are ready to access the matchmaking system.



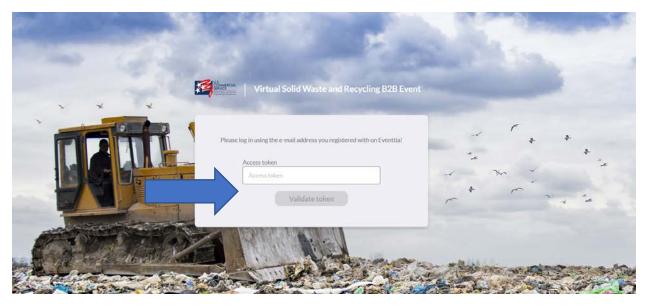
How to Access the Virtual B2B Matchmaking Platform

Step 1: After clicking on the above event weblink, the registrant will be prompted to the Login Page (below), enter the e-mail they registered with and click "Log in."

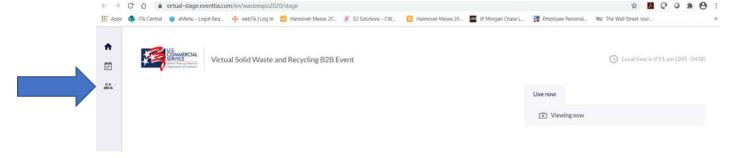


<u>Step 2:</u> Shortly thereafter (please allow 1-2 minutes), Monica McFarlane will send you a 6-Digit Security Code to gain access to the online platform (be sure to check your Spam Folder).

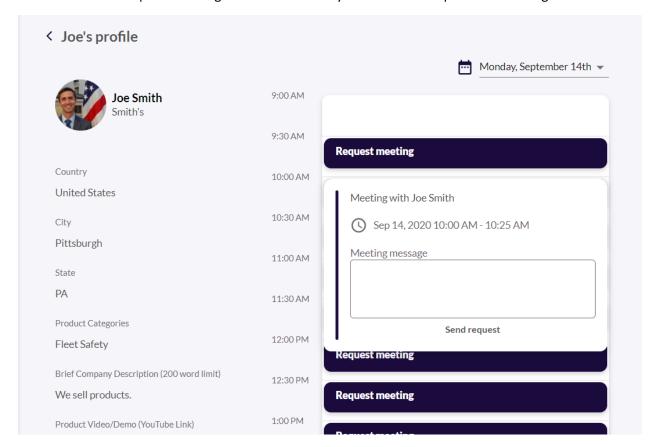


Step 3: After entering the code, click "Validate token" and you will have access to the platform where you can select the Attendees icon on the left to begin searching for two types of meetings – B2B with

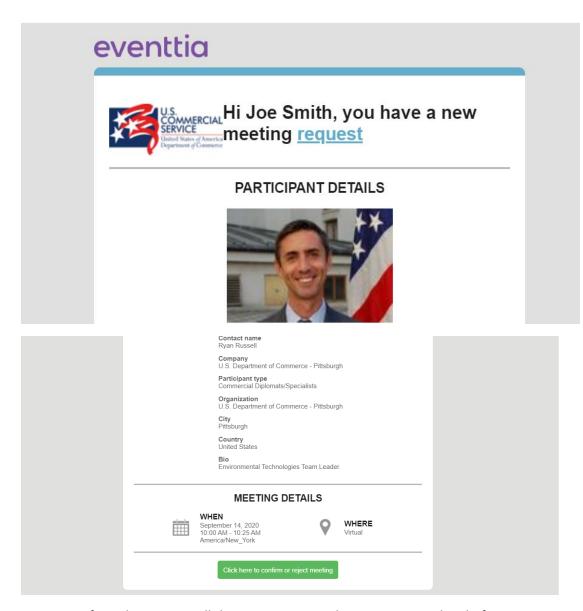
international buyers and B2G with our international colleagues. You can filter the results by country, product type, etc. to identify the best opportunities for your company.



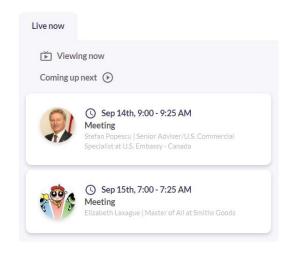
<u>Step 4:</u> When viewing a profile, you will see the times that a potential buyer (B2B) or Commercial Specialist (B2G) is still available to meet according to your time zone. Once you find a suitable time, you can click on the "Request Meeting Button" and enter your reason to request the meeting:



<u>Step 5:</u> The recipient will receive an email notifying them of the request and offering the opportunity to accept or decline the meeting directly from the email. International buyers can send meetings request to you as well. Same guidance applies to accepting meetings.



Step 6: Confirmed meetings will then appear in your home screen on the platform.



<u>Step 7:</u> When the date and time comes for your meeting, the option to "Join" the confirmed meeting will appear. This will launch the video chat function enabling you to see and speak with the other participant and take notes.
