Joint stock company for performing energy activity natural gas transmission NOMAGAS Skopje in state ownership (short name NOMAGAS JSC Skopje) is now informing all interested entities that it plans to build the gas pipeline section between the Gevgelija (MK) - Evzoni (GR) border crossing to Negotino in North Macedonia. The section is part of the gas interconnection pipeline between Greece (GR) and North Macedonia (MK).

The interconnector will be approximately 67 kilometers long, and the construction is financed by European Investment Bank (EIB) and is subject to EIB's Guide to Procurement. Estimated total value excluding VAT is: 83 653 000.00 EUR. The duration of the project execution contract is set to be 34 months. Time limit for receipt of tenders or requests to participate is February 1, 2024, at 12:00 PM Skopje local time.
