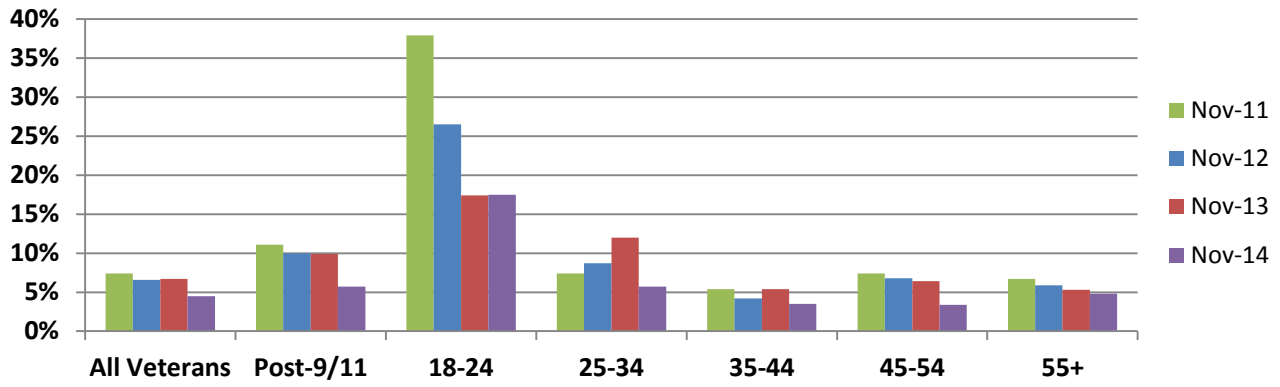

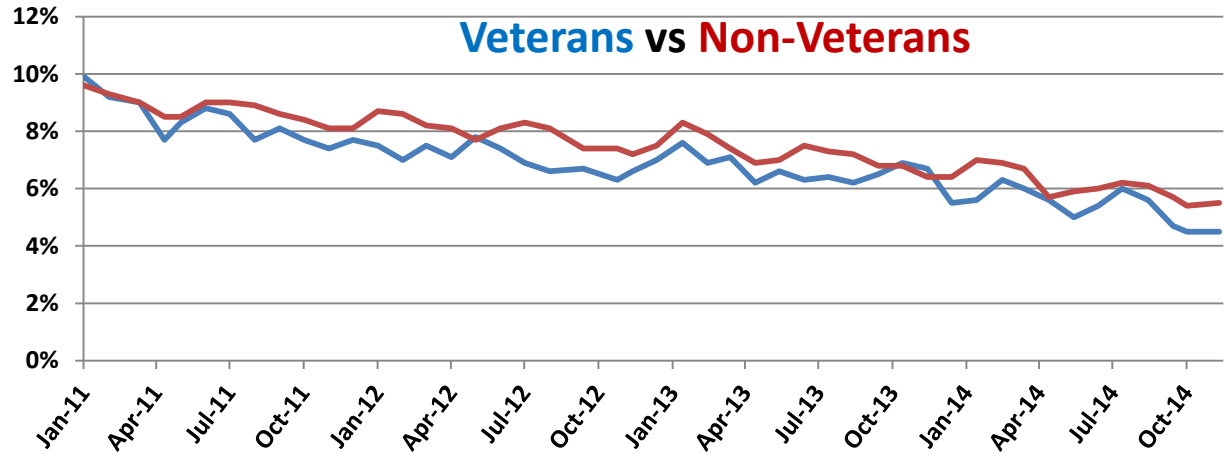

Year-Over-Year Comparison



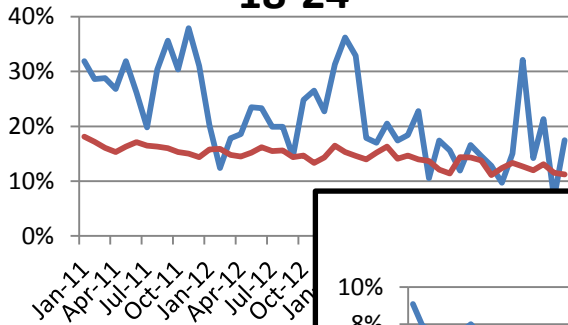
Veterans vs Non-Veterans



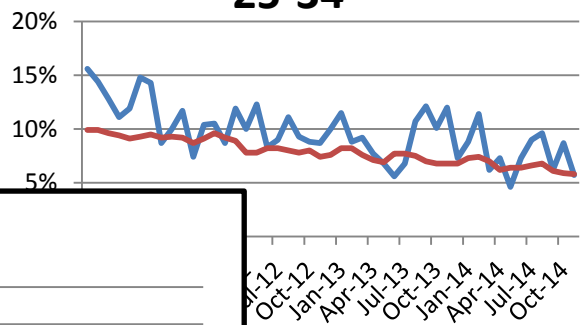

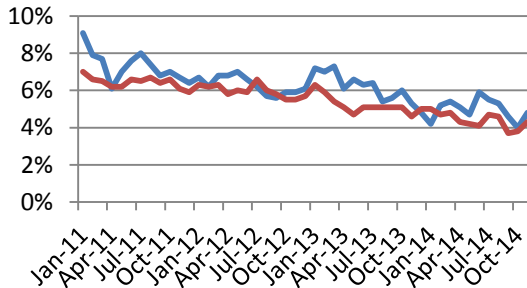

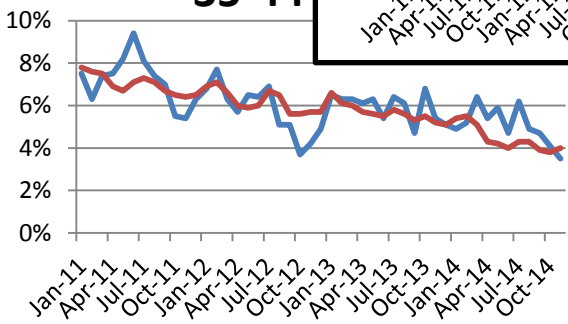
