

The Evolution of Enrollment Manager

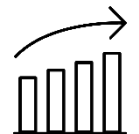

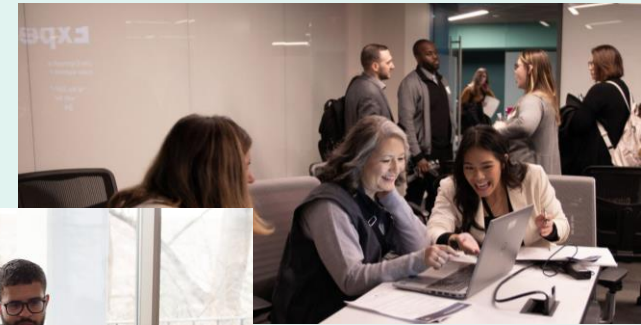

Celebrating One Year with Enrollment Manager

4.9 Million Enrollment Certifications and Counting!

Four months after Enrollment Manager launched, one million enrollments certifications were submitted through Enrollment Manager. Today, we celebrate over 4.9 million enrollments submitted!



A look back: In June 2023, VA celebrated our one million milestone with Edward “Ed” Sivells, a SCO at Tidewater Community College, who submitted the millionth enrollment certification.

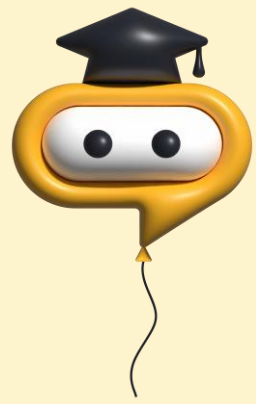

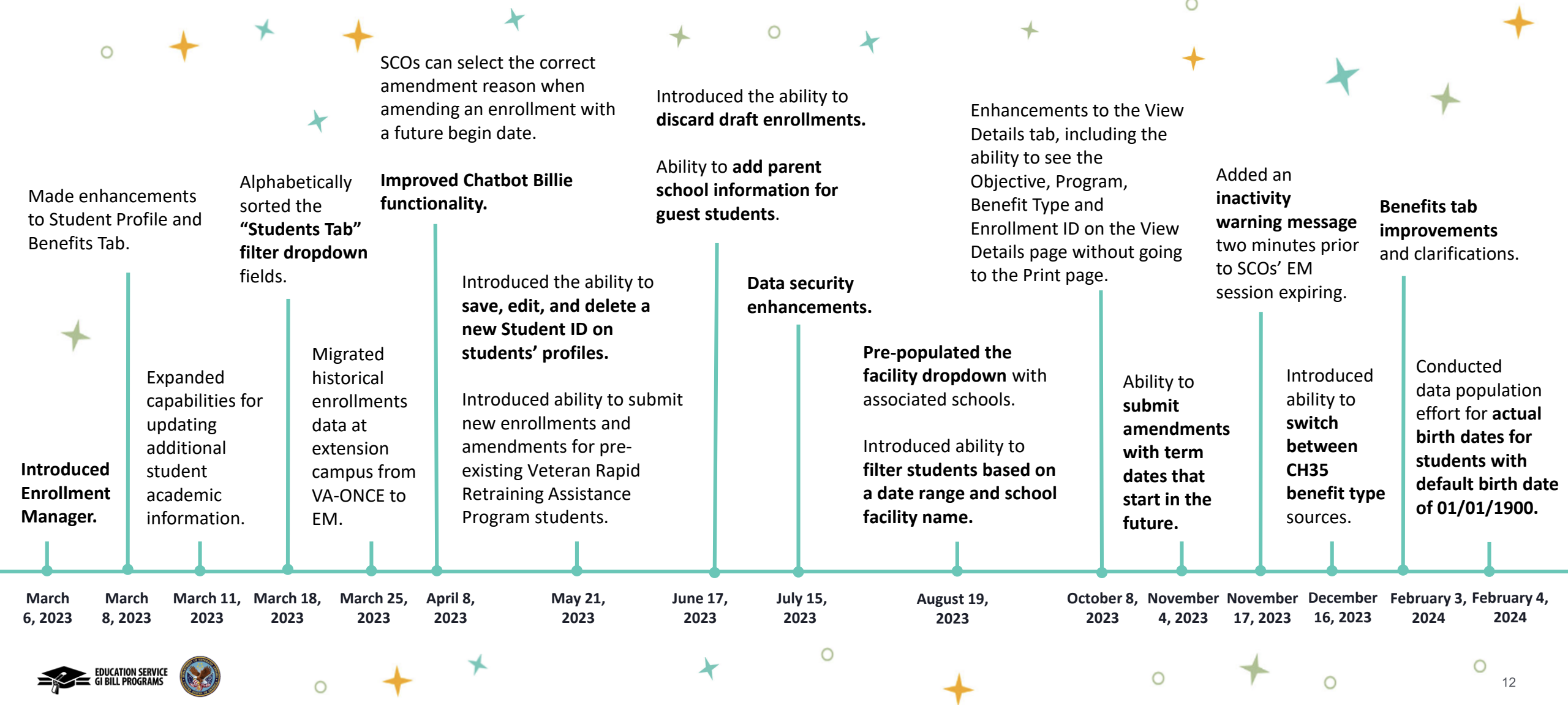

Timeout Warning Notification

On November 17, VA updated Enrollment Manager to display a warning message prior to system timeout

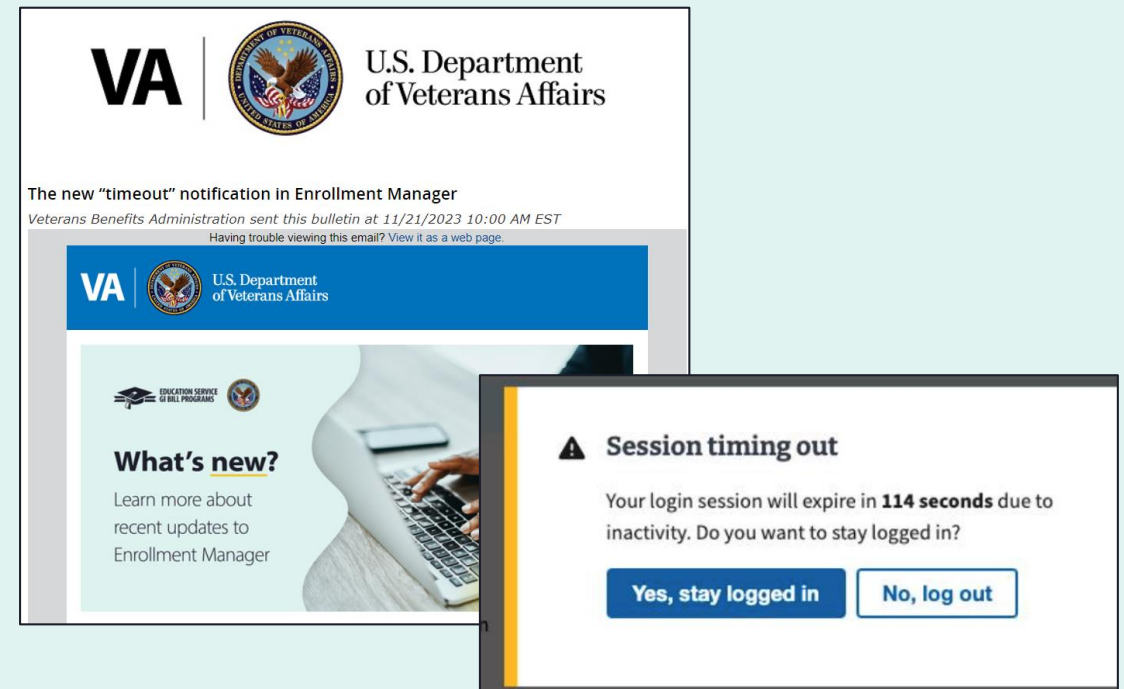


SCOs Asked, VA Listened

Now SCOs have a two-minute warning prior to the system timing out, giving them the option to stay logged in.

Birth Date Data Population in Enrollment Manager



On February 4, VA began the process to populate birth dates that previously defaulted to 1/1/1900

SCOs Asked, VA Listened

When transitioning from VA-ONCE to EM, some students' birth dates defaulted to 01/01/1900 in the Claimant database.

Four New VBA Remarks

On October 8, VA released 4 new VBA remark options were released to cover instances when more information is required



SCOs Asked, VA Listened

VBA remarks options expanded to encompass additional scenarios that SCOs may encounter when submitting enrollment certifications



System Updates and Timely Communications

If one of the below new VBA Remarks is selected, the **ability to add Custom Remarks** will become available for SCOs to provide additional information

Dual Degree Program

Custom Remark: Enter name of second degree not selected during certification

2

Tuition and Fees in a Foreign Currency

Custom Remark: Enter name of foreign currency charged and amount

3

Incarcerated Students

Custom Remark: Enter itemized costs, i.e., "Books = \$1000, Equipment, \$300"

4

Compliance Survey

Custom Remark: Enter the email of the compliance survey specialist

Once a student is accessed, there are six different tabs which provide unique and useful information. Below is a glimpse into key information found in each tab:

1 Enrollments Tab

- ✓ All student enrollments and corresponding statuses
- ✓ Add and amend an enrollment

2 Student Info Tab

- ✓ Biographical-Info subtab
- ✓ Contact-Info subtab
- *These are non-editable*

3 Programs Tab

- ✓ Previous and current programs by facility
- ✓ Active program defaults to top of list

4 Benefits Tab

- ✓ Switch benefit type/source of entitlement
- ✓ View percentage benefit level of remaining entitlement

5 Notes Tab

- ✓ All notes previously added to student's enrollment(s)
- ✓ Ability to add additional notes that apply student and not a specific enrollment period

6 History Tab

- ✓ All activity pertaining to Student and enrollments listed chronologically
- ✓ Filters for seamless searching

Tips for Student Search and Identity Verification

We understand that searching for and correctly identifying students is an essential work activity. Below are tips for locating and verifying the identify of a student in EM:



Tips to Find Students in EM

If you are unable to locate a student in EM even when you are certain they are in the system, **widen your search through the following:**

- ✓ Search for a student without the Date of birth field **only for Search all students*
- ✓ Use 01/01/1900 in the Date of birth field
- ✓ Remember to search by both maiden and married surnames



Indicators for Verifying Student Identity

Once you have found a student, there are **several indicators you can use to confirm the student's identity:**

- ✓ Date of birth
- ✓ Previous schools
- ✓ Email
- ✓ Mobile or home phone number
- ✓ Mailing address
- ✓ SSN on previous enrollments
