

Refresher Training

Refresher training is a course at the elementary or secondary level to review or update material previously covered in a course that has been satisfactorily completed. Under some education programs, the term also means training in a program of education in which the eligible individual is already qualified, provided that the program pursued is training to permit the eligible individual to update knowledge and skills and to be instructed in the technological advances which have occurred in the eligible individual's field of employment during and since their period of active military service. Eligible individuals pursuing "refresher training" are not limited to "refresher courses" at the elementary or secondary level.

When refresher training is certified to VA, the need for the training must be justified and included in the student's record maintained by the school. Suitable documentation can include test results, a written requirement from the specific school department or instructor, etc.
