

From the War Zone to the Home Front 2

Supporting the Mental Health of Veterans and Families



Free, all-new, 9-part series of live, interactive, online trainings for community primary care and mental health physicians, psychologists, nurses, and clinical social workers.

Presented by the Red Sox Foundation and Massachusetts General Hospital Home Base Program, in collaboration with the VA's National Center for PTSD, this online series is a continuation of the 2012 War Zone series that attracted close to 6,000 clinicians nationwide. 88% of participants said they know more and feel better prepared to address the mental health needs of returning Iraq and Afghanistan veterans and their families.

From the War Zone to the Home Front 2 includes nine free, [CME/CE-certified, one-hour educational sessions](#) that can be viewed live or on-demand. Faculty includes renowned national experts from Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard Medical School, the VA's National Center for PTSD, Duke University, Dartmouth Medical School, and more. The series contains all-new content on many aspects of working with veterans and their family members, including:

- Diagnostic and treatment strategies for comorbid PTSD and TBI
- Research and insights on veteran suicide, substance abuse, sleep problems, and more
- An overview of updates to diagnostic criteria for PTSD in the new DSM-5
- Guidance on dealing with complicated grief in veterans and military families
