IMPORTANT – READ BEFORE ATTENDING

- Vaccines, including boosters, provide additional protection against COVID-19 variants and help prevent severe illness and hospitalization.
- ***Who is eligible?** Veterans, spouses, caregivers and CHAMPVA recipients under the authority of the SAVE LIVES Act (SLA) - must have had eligibility established previously.
- Boosters are for adults whose last Moderna or Pfizer vaccine was more than 5 months ago or 2 months ago for the J&J/ Janssen vaccine.
- **3rd and 4th doses are for individuals with Immunocompromised conditions ONLY.** If you are unsure of your immune status, you should consult with your provider or review your condition. - **YOU MUST BRING YOUR CDC CARD** from your previous COVID-19 vaccine(s),

- Vaccine will be offered based on clinical need and vaccine inventory.
